

Sordid Story of Girls' Shame Causes Klan At Shreveport to Plan Protestant Refuge

TILIES oftame bloom from mud-L banks

From the depths of degradation and despair may spring high and holy projects.

Two poor little Louisiana girls, dragged down and debauched by an unnatural and inhuman mother, are to be the agents whereby their native state is to secure a splendid Protestant home of refuge which in years to come will shelter and protect other juvenile unfortunates and afford them an opportunity to remedy lives which have been wrecked almost before they have properly begun.

Here's the sordid story which called attention to the lack of a Protestant home for girls in the great State of Louisiana and which caused the hundred per cent Americans of Shreveport Klan Number 2 to start a campaign for the erection of a \$75,000 girls' home which will be given to their commonwealth.

Preacher Starts Probe

A young minister joined the Klan a few weeks ago and determined to actively practice Klankraft when it came to aiding the properly constituted authorities in enforcing the laws.

There came to him a rumor that in a small oil town near Shreveport a woman was selling whiskey and prostituting her two daughters, one aged sixteen and the other aged fourteen, in their own home.

The preacher donned overalls, posed as an oil worker and started to investigate for himself.

He called at the woman's home and bought whiskey. He asked her about her daughters. She said that her eldest daughter was leading an immoral life and that she would be glad to introduce her to him. She said that the youngest girl was in school but that she would have her meet him later in the evening for immoral purposes.

The minister having secured this evidence went to the sheriff in Shreveport and had the woman arrested. She was sentenced to jail on charges of pandering and of bootlegging.

Plan Protestant Home

And then the two young girls, having no place to go and nobody to take care of them, were sent by the court to the Home of the Good Shepherd, a Roman Catholic institution.

The Shreveport Klan then and there discovered that there was not a Protestant Home for girls in the entire state.

Klansmen at once determined to build such a home and plan to raise \$75,000 for such an institution which the Klan will complete and turn over to the State with the one proviso that it be conducted by Protestants and on Protestant principles.

Klans in Western States Are Growing

The Knights of the Ku Klux Klan is at present experiencing an unparalleled growth in the northwestern states and membership will still further increase during the coming summer, according to Fred L. Gifford of Portland, Oregon, Grand Dragon for that Realm. Mr. Gifford was a visitor at the Imperial Palace May I on official business.

The Klan in the Western States has a great mission of Americanism to perform," Mr. Gifford says. "The rapid growth of the Japanese population and the great influx of foreign laborers, mostly Greeks, is threatening our American institutions, and Klans in Washington, Oregon and Idaho are actively at work to combat these foreign and un-American influences.'

Klans in the state of Oregon are rested up after their recent sweeping victory at the polls in the cause of good government, at which time they put patriotic Americans into public office. During the coming summer there will be a great increase in Klan membership in these States. Thousands of Americans are anxious to enroll themselves in this great patriotic order and the very best of the Western citizenship will be

In Portland, Oregon, Luther Powell Klan Number I, is making plans for the erection of a magnificent new Klavern which they will themselves own. Other Klans in the western states are also preparing to construct their own buildings.

In Seattle the Klan has prospered under the vicious attacks launched against them by their enemies and the membership of Seattle Klan No. 4 is increasing more rapidly than ever in its history.

Klans at Spokane, Walla Walla, Yakima, and Vancouver in Washington, and Boise, Pocatello and Twin Falls in Idaho all report large increases in membership. Many new Klans are being established in Idaho which is rapidly becoming one of the banner states of the country.

Texas Klan Outlines An Educational Program

Constructive and educational programs for the benefit of the membership have caused a wonderful attendance record to be established by Wichita Falls Klan No. 195, Realm of

This Klan has purchased an ideal building site for the sum of \$14,000 and is going to at once erect thereon a \$35,000 Klavern paid for and owned by Klansmen.

Wichita Falls Klan each week has some special educational subject presented for discussion. Some of the subjects which will be discussed are printed here as a suggestion for other Klans:

"The Constitution of the United ; "The Magna Carta" "Immigration"; "The Public Schools" "State and Church"; "The History of the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan"; "The State and the School" "The Monroe Doctrine"; "The Revolutionary War,"; "Abraham Lincoln"; "George Washington"; "American Statesmen"; "The Catholic Church" "Our Congress.

These lectures are generally delivered by local Klansmen specially assigned to the subject. They are followed by a general discussion.

Realm of Oklahoma is Making Progress

Reports at the Imperial Palace from Klans in the Realm of Oklahoma indicate that the realm is forging ahead under its new state administration. From all sections of Oklahoma come reports of large classes being naturalized and great crowds are attending open air addresses by various speakers concerning Klan principles.

Oklahoma was recently entirely reorganized. Its four provinces were redistricted into three provinces and an entirely new administration installed. This administration is now functioning one hundred per cent and the results, even in the period of six weeks, are remarkable.

The new Grand Dragon for the Realm of Oklahoma is one of the best known business men in the state. With his three Great Titans he has adopted a policy of working with and co-operating with the Klans of the realm for the benefit and growth of this great order.

Oklahoma will naturalize 20,000 new Klansmen during the present year, so state officials confidently expect.

Alabama Klans Will All Parade on May 22

The Realm of Alabama is planning a state wide celebration on the night of Tuesday, May 22. Thousands of Klansmen in full regalia will parade in every city and town in Alabama where a Klan exists. Fiery crosses will burn in all four corners of the state.

The general turn out of all Alabama Klansmen is ordered by the Grand Dragon of the Realm and the occasion will be an eventful one.

One of the biggest parades ever staged in the history of the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan will take place at Birmingham, where Klans from all parts of Province Number 1 will gather and march. Thousands of Klansmen are expected to be in line.

Klan Komment

Following a protest of the membership of Daniel Morgan Klan Number 48, Spartanburg, South Carolina, the city council at that city on April 28 stopped a local moving picture theater from showing "The Pilgrim," a film in which Charlie Chaplin appears in the role of a minister. The film was suppressed by the council on the grounds that it ridiculed the Protestant

Lincoln Klan No. 11, Realm of Nebraska, made their first public appearance April 19, when twenty-five of their members in full regalia visited the First Christian Church at Havelock. Their leader made a brief address outlining the Christian and patriotic aims of this order.

Despite the opposition of Mayor Hosey of Fort Wayne, Ind., who said that he would not permit a Klan parade, members of the Fort Wayne Klan in full regalia and headed by a brass band paraded the town in full force April 28. Permission to parade was given by the chief of police.

The Klan at Springfield, Ill., the birthplace of Abraham Lincoln, is one of the livest and fastest growing organizations in the country. The Klan plans to naturalize a class of between 500 and 1,000 new members in a special ceremonial in the near future.

An illuminated airplane carrying a flery cross hovered over Klansmen of Washington, Ind., when they paraded in full regalia April 28. Announced plans of Mayor McCarty to stop the parade did not materialize.

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Ex-Member Tries to Start Outlaw Klan

J. C. Hopkins, who a year ago was banished from Wyandotte Klan No. 5, Realm of Kansas, has applied to the charter board of the State of Kansas for the issuance of a charter to an organization which he wants to call "The Ku Klux Klan of Kansas.

Hopkins is evidently trying to start this outlaw organization with the idea that he can embarrass or harm the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan and also of course for pecuniary reasons.

The Ku Klux Klan of Kansas, should a charter be granted such a body, has nothing to do with the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan and it is doubtful if it has a legal right to use any name similar to that of the national organization.

Fuller Who Fought Klan Now Retracts

Alfred C. Fuller, president of the Fuller Brush Company, has had a change in heart.

A few weeks ago he was actively attacking the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan and giving out newspaper interviews to the effect that any Klansman in the employ of his company would be discharged.

Now Mr. Fuller has backed down. Since Klansmen of the nation were informed of his attitude through the columns of the Imperial Night-Hawk, for some reason or the other Fuller has changed his mind.

To the head of the Klan in the State of Connecticut, G. H. Abercrombie, secretary of the Fuller Brush Company, has written saying that Mr. Fuller wished a retraction published and says:

"Mr. Fuller is writing you direct on the matter and has drafted a letter, which I believe adequately states our true present and future attitude in this

regard.
"I trust you will see your way clear to have Mr. Fuller's letter given such publicity as will go a long way toward relieving the feeling that exists in many quarters over this situation.

"March 21, 1923. To the King Kleagle of Connecticut and Rhode

"Dear Sir: Certain statements concerning the Ku Klux Klan Island. have been attributed to me, and certain ones I have made personally. Regardless of this, however, I wish to state that my present attitude and future policy in this regard is absolutely a neutral one. I wish here also to make the definite statement that any member of our organization belonging to the Klan will not be discharged. This is and will be our attitude concerning such a condition, regardless of previous statements. The Fuller Brush Company has never concerned itself as to whether its employees belonged to any particular sect, creed, religion, fraternity or political party. Such has been its policy in the past and such will be its policy in the future. Furthermore, the Company believes in the absolute independence of thought on religious, fraternal and political matters on the part of the people connected with it. Work and loyalty to our organization are our chief interests—not the nature

of one's beliefs. 'Yours very sincerely, "(Signed) THE FULLER BRUSH CO. "By Alfred C. Fuller, "President."

So, you see, Mr. Fuller did not mean all that he said.

Imperial Kloncilium in Special Session

A meeting of the Imperial Kloncilium was held at the Imperial Palace Wednesday, May 2. Fifteen members were present, including Imperial Wizard Dr. H. W. Evans and Emperor Colonel William J. Simmons. The meeting was on special call of the Imperial Wizard for the purpose of selecting committees. No other business was transacted. The Kloncilium adjourned to meet July 31 and quarterly thereafter except on special call.

The states of Connecticut, Georgia, Louisiana, Alabama, Oklahoma, North Carolina, New York, Texas, Arkansas and Indiana have representation on the Imperial Kloncilium.

It would be well for Klansmen to carefully check the disposition of such funds and be sure that Protestant institutions receive their proper proportion of the money donated for charitable

The Tri-State American, a newspaper of Memphis, Tenn., recently analyzed the Charity Community Fund of that city and found that while Catholic Jewish and Negro institutions were allotted \$121,000, the Protestant institutions, including both the Young Men's Christian Association and Young Women's Christian Association, were to receive only \$56,000. One Protes tant institution, The American Christian Home, received no allotment a all. The Convent of the Good Shepher and St. Peters Orphanage, Catholic institutions, were to receive between them \$76,898—\$20,000 more than the Protestant total.

Be Klannish, Morally, Spiritually and Physically.

American Citizens Must Awake to Needs of Public Schools

N TREATING of the subject of our 1 Public Free Schools, the only purpose will be to draw men closer to these institutions, which are the sure foundations of our civilization, dependable upon the attitude which red-blooded American citizens assume toward them.

What, specifically, is education? Webster says, "Education is, properly, a drawing forth, implying not so much the communication of knowledge as the discipline of the intellect, the establishment of the principles and the regulation of the heart." This is the ideal attitude toward education, the ultimate goal which every honest American would like to see realized.

Education is as old as the ages. Men have been educating the rising genera-tion from time immemorial. It comes as a natural sequence to progress, and if we would court progress we must improve, revise and above all support our institutions of learning

Instinctively our prehistoric forefathers must have taught the youth of their generation the safest, easiest way of existence. To be sure, there was no motivating idea of progress, no tangible idea, back of these teachings. These potential qualities lay dormant, awaiting unfoldment. We progress slowly, step by step.

And so it is as late as the Nineteenth century that America has anything resembling a system of public education. Since that time we have made rapid strides toward realizing our ideal. but there remains much to be desired in the method and vision of the educators and people of our country.

Are We Gaining?

We have noted with pride the evolution of the schools of our fathers, wherein was taught the elements of education-loyalty to God and to our flaggrow and expand into well-equipped, modern public schools. But the question arises, are the improved facilities really improvements over the methods of our fathers? Are we gaining more of spiritual development and real benefits? Like all other questions involving change there is much to be said on both sides. The mere fact that our census indicates an ever decreasing percentage of illiteracy shows that we are advancing in a certain mental realm. But the important question, the thing that most concerns us is: Are our children developing Christian character? Are the right principles being brought to bear on their lives?

If we rest content with the material progress attained, if we are willing merely to rest on our laurels in the attainment of splendid buildings and large enrollment of pupils, and remember the good we have accomplished in the past in only a material way, we must of necessity fall far short of our educational ideal. Indifferent compliancy on our part toward our present school system means destruction, retrogression, and ultimate moral degeneration. It is our attitude that counts-what do we expect, what do we most want for our children?

In our mad chase after the material things of this life we seem to have lost sight of the most important of all things, education as defined by Webster. Our attitude toward this important question might be compared to that of the Romans who were so engrossed in materialism that they were unable to discern the ultimate benefits of learning because, directly, it advanced neither their material possession, nor the political power of their country. And yet, "the wealth of the world, both material and spiritual, is in the possession of the nation which spends most on its schools.

System Needs Revision

Our public school system as a whole is sadly in need of revision. In a land where, theoretically at least, democracy reigns supreme, should not equal privileges of acquiring an education obtain everywhere? And yet the facilities of the rural schools, with a few encouraging exceptions, remain in a state of neglect. Their importance in the scheme of our national life seems to have been as yet unrealized. This can point to but one thing: destructive lethargy on the part of public sentiment as a whole. That a few of the people are beginning to realize the vast importance of the rural schools is shown by the improvements in the rural school methods, brought about by seven states in the Union. Our rural schools are merely the weakest links in our chain of educational facilities, there are other weaknesses as saliently visible if we only look for them.

It is a self-evident fact that our public schools are the greatest wealth producers in the world. They finish and equip our youth mentally with that power and purpose so necessary to success along any line. But do we realize this? Apparently not, if we count the number of our poorly paid or under paid instructors. It is diffi-

cult for one to give the best that is in him if he is continually worried or harrassed with financial troubles. We must raise our standard higher, for progression is the law of life.

Must Have Broad Vision

"The need of the present age is the national realization that the schools should produce an educated democ-To meet this need we must be willing to do our part in every way, and not only put into action our moral support, but be willing to pay a sufficient tax to maintain our schools at the highest standard. We must look beyond the personal and selfish limitations, wherein lurks a deep-seated danger. We must have a vision beyond our own fireside, and know that we are priviledged to have a part in the establishment, through proper education, of real fraternity, white supremacy. Klannish in all good works, we shall inevitably bring to pass that great day, the final recognition of the brotherhood of

Here is a typical instance showing how the news columns of a paper can be prostituted when its policy is controlled in its counting house.

The Kansas City Post recently carried an eight-column headline in box car letters "Klan Threats Blamed in Suicide." If the end of the world had come they could have used no larger type.

Some Sensation

Here is the story they "smeared"

on page one. Kirksville, Mo., April 9-Threats by secret organization and signed 'Ku Klux Klan' are blamed by relatives for the suicide here yesterday of ThomasHenderson, 26-year-old-farmer. Henderson shot himself with an oldfashioned muzzle loading pistol.

"Shortly before taking his life, Henderson said he had received a threatening letter and that it bore no signature except the words 'Ku Klux Klan.' Members of his family say they know no reason for any person or organization threatening Henderson.

"Henderson was a member of a family that had lived in this section

many years. Imperial Representative George C. McCarron for the State of Missouri at once sent special investigators to Kirksville with the determination to find out who sent the man the note.

He discovered that the newspaper article was absolutely false and that circumstances surrounding the man's death had been deliberately colored so as to afford ammunition for a sensational attack on the Klan.

Facts in Case

The true facts in the case are: Henderson was a negro, though the article did not say so.

He was a plasterer and not a farmer. He had never received a threatening letter of any kind, much less a note

signed "Ku Klux Klan." The man did not commit suicide but child in the country. accidentally shot himself.

Henderson's wife who witnessed the home drunk and was "fooling" with a school stage. Collegiate training is

NEVER mind about telling the shot gun (not a pistol). By accident truth. Just tack "K. K. K." he struck the gun against the wall as he staggered about the room. It exploded and tore away half of his skull.

This typical case of distorting the truth on the part of an anti-Klan newspaper is set forth here merely to show just how low some sheets can sink in their efforts to discredit an organization whose ideals are of the highest and whose principles are patriotism of the purest.

Oregon School Law is Praised by Templar

Leonidas P. Newby, Grand Master of the Knights Templar in the United States, chairman of the board of directors of the Methodist International College at Rome and a member of the Educational Board of the Methodist Episcopal Church, heartily approves the Oregon compulsory school bill which eliminates parochial schools and sectarian education of children in that

Mr. Newby recently declared the Oregon school bill in his estimation was a distinct progressive step in the promotion of true American education and he advocates the adoption of kindred educational laws in every state

Sectarian Education is Bad

From his position, both as an educator and a leader in one of the extensive sectarian collegiate organizations, Mr. Newby looks upon the Oregon school bill as one of the best guarantees to education which is productive of good citizenship.

"I do not believe that the mind of the child should be developed along sectarian lines," he declares. "The place for the young mind is in the public schools. We must teach every boy and girl in this country first to be a good American citizen, and the basis of this teaching is the public school system.

"The function of the sectarian school lies in the training of the child after he has passed through the high school stage of education, and not before. Popular education is distinctly an American education and it should be made to give its groundwork, its foundation of future citizenry, to every

given them after they have approached the period of mental determination.

Must Teach Patriotism

"Sectarianism is a bad thing," declares the Templar head. Religious convictions are a thing apart from education which is so vital to the production of good citizens. After the child has received a groundwork in the fundamental love of country and government, then is time for him to choose the future educational course.

"I mean no inference against any creed. A man may be Protestant, Jew, Catholic, Mohammedan, any one of the 209 faiths which flourish within the nation, but he must be an American above it all.

Mr. Newby says that the Methodist schools with which he is connected receive no tax support, and he declares that the Oregon system established a method where the functions of the public schools are supported by all of the people, and where all benefit

Six Thousand Arkansas Klansmen Hold State Meeting in Driving Rain Storm

RIVING rain, which almost assumed the proportions of a cloudburst, failed to dampen the enthusiasm of 6,000 loyal Arkansas Klansmen, who gathered near Little Rock for their annual state convention on Friday, April 27.

The meeting, which was held in the open air Friday night amid the meadows of a model stock farm, ten miles from the city, attracted a huge crowd of Klansmen who journeyed to the spot in automobiles, braving the rain.

From start to finish the session was held in a torrential downpour, the speakers and their audience becoming literally wringing, sopping wet. Enthusiasm ran high, however, and Imperial Wizard Dr. H. W. Evans was cheered to the echo when he spoke, exalting the principles of the Knights of the Ku Klux Klan and praising the Klansmen of Arkansas for their loyalty and spirit of progressiveness.

The Grand Dragon of the Realm of Arkansas and other Klan officials also spoke briefly and the crowd, wet to the skin, stayed to hear them. The meeting concluded with the serving of an old fashioned barbecue.

It is estimated that between 12,000 and 15,000 Klansmen were in Little Rock Friday, April 27, the weather preventing a large proportion of them from attending the night meeting beneath the fiery cross.
