






The Freemasons have been around for thousands of years. My daddy said that the first Freemasons were stonemasons. They built great temples.

FAMOUS FREEMASONS

GEORGE WASHINGTON



George Washington is the most famous Freemason. He was a general during the American Revolutionary War and the first President of the United States.

BENJAMIN FRANKLIN



Benjamin Franklin was a Freemason for over 60 years and served as a Grand Master. He is one of the most famous Founding Fathers and signers of the Declaration of Independence. Brother Franklin was an inventor, publisher, and politician.

PAUL REVERE



Paul Revere said that serving as Grand Master of Massachusetts was the "greatest happiness" of his life. Brother Revere was a famous silversmith, but he is known for his midnight ride through Lexington before the American Revolution when he warned, "The British are coming!"

SAMUEL ADAMS



Samuel Adams was a patriot during the American Revolutionary War anda Freemason. He is famous for organizing the Boston Tea Party. Brother Adams was a politician, philosopher, and one of the Founding Fathers of America.

JAMES MONROE



James Monroe was an American Revolution Officer, Lawyer, and politician. He served the White House in different roles before he was elected the 5th President of the United States. Brother Monroe was a member of several Masonic lodges and was known to visit lodges while he was President.

ANDREW JACKSON



Andrew Jackson was an American General and politician. He was elected to Congress as a U.S. Representative and Senator and the 7th President of the United States. Brother Jackson was an active Freemason who served as the Grand Master of Tennessee.

DAVY CROCKETT



Davy Crockett was an American hero. He was one of the defenders of the Alamo. Brother Crockett was a pioneer, trapper, politician, and Freemason whose courage and fortitude created an American legend for the ages.

STEPHEN F. AUSTIN



Stephen F. Austin was known as the Father of Texas. He was Texas's first Secretary of State after it gained independence from Mexico. Brother Austin was elected one of the first Worshipful Masters in Texas.

SAM HOUSTON




Sam Houston was a hero of the Texas Revolution and the first President of Texas. He famously told his army before the Battle of San Jacinto, "Remember the Alamo." Brother Houston accepted Santa Anna's surrender.

THEODORE "TEDDY" ROOSEVELT



Theodore Roosevelt was an American soldier and politician. He was the leader of the Rough Riders during the Spanish-American War and later was elected as the 26th President of the United States. The Teddy Bear is named after him. Brother Roosevelt became a Freemason during his first year as President.

FRANKLIN D. ROOSEVELT



Franklin Roosevelt was an American politician who was the only person to be elected President of the United States four times. He led America through the Great Depression and most of World War II. Brother Roosevelt was an active Freemason belonging to several lodges and appendant bodies.

HARRY S. TRUMAN



Harry Truman was Franklin Roosevelt's Vice President and became the 33rd President of the United States. As President, he ended World War II by accepting Japan's surrender. Brother Truman is the second President to serve as a Grand Master in Freemasonry. He was also honored as a 33rd-degree Scottish Rite Mason.

BUZZ ALDRIN



Buzz Aldrin was a Korean War Veteran and United States Astronaut. He was the first Mason to walk on the Moon. The Grand Master of Texas approved Brother Aldrin's request to open a Representation of the Grand Lodge of Texas on the Moon and establish Masonic Territorial Jurisdiction there. He is active as a Freemason.
