PROPOSED BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens
and residents of the State of California, have this day voluntarily
associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit
church corporation under Title XII, part IV of Division 1 of the
Civil Code of the State of California, AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name of the said corporation shall be

THE ROSICRUCIAN FELLOWSHIP NON-SECTARIAN CHURCH

SECOND: That the purposes for which it is formed are;

To organize, establish and conduct an international
association of Christian Mystics and spiritual, ecclesiastical,
non-sectarian church to carry on, disseminate and perpetuate the
teachings of the principles of Rosicrucian Philosophy and spirit-
ual concepts as given to its members and offered to the world by
Max Heindel in his book entitled "The Rosicrucian Cosmo-Conception
or Mystic Christianity", and other supplemental writings of said
Max Heindel and his wife Augusta Foss Heindel, under the spirit-
ual leadership of Augusta Foss Heindel or such other person or
persons as may be chosen by "The Central Ecclesiastical Council"
in the manner provided in the By-Laws.

As the church organization of Rosicrucian disciples, pro-
bationers and students, beneficiaries of all properties, both real
and personal, and of every nature and description, held or
owned by The Rosicrucian Fellowship, a California corporation, as
secular trustee thereof, to investigate and cause, by all legal
means, all said properties that have been, may now or hereafter
be a part of the said trust estate to be used exclusively by the
said Rosicrucian Fellowship for the adovation, teaching and dis-
semination of the principles of the Christian Religion, as inter-
preted by the Rosicrucian Philosophy as set forth in and through

1 the books and writings of Max Heindel and Mrs. Max Heindel
2 (Augusta Foss Heindel);

3 To promote to the fullest extent possible the spiritual
4 purposes of the Rosicrucian Philosophy; to cherish the ideals of
5 the founders of the Rosicrucian Fellowship; to assist and guide
6 students to the end that they may become faithful and deserving
7 probationers; to assist, aid and guide the probationers in
8 spreading the teachings of the Rosicrucian Philosophy to the
9 world and to aid and encourage probationers to become disciples;

10 To assemble, congregate and establish Rosicrucian minis-
11 ters, disciples, probationers and students in ecclesiastical
12 churches, temples and centers all over the world, to consecrate
13 ministers, to conduct religious exercises and to promote the
14 objects and purposes of this corporation; and to issue and revoke
15 charters to such ecclesiastical churches, and centers.

16 To print, publish, sell or otherwise distribute and dis-
17 pose of "The Rosicrucian Cosmo-Conception or Mystic Christianity"
18 and other books and writings of Max Heindel and Augusta Foss
19 Heindel;

20 To exercise all of the powers herein set forth, or any of
21 them, not only in the State of California, but also in other
22 States and Nations and to have one or more churches, temples or
23 centers outside of said State of California;

24 In addition to the business, objects and purposes herein-
25 before set forth, to do any and all things necessary, suitable,
26 useful, expedient or convenient for the carrying on of any of
27 said business or for the accomplishment of any object or purpose
28 or the exercise of any power hereinbefore set forth or which at
29 any time shall appear to be beneficial to the corporation in con-
30 nection therewith, and to do any and all of the things above set
31 forth, either alone or jointly with others, and either as prin-
32 pal for its own account or as the agent, factor, or broker of

1 others, and to the same extent and as fully as a natural person
2 might or could do in the State of California or elsewhere.

3 The purposes and objects expressed in the several clauses
4 hereinbefore set forth shall be construed both as objects and
5 purposes and also as powers, and the statements contained in each
6 clause shall in nowise be limited or restricted by reference to or
7 inference from the terms of any other clause.

8 This corporation is a corporation which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

9 THIRD: That the place where the principal business of said
10 corporation is to be transacted is in the County of San Diego,
11 State of California.

12 FOURTH: That the number of directors of this corporation
13 is five and the names and residence of those appointed and who are
14 to act in the capacity of directors until the selection of their
15 successors and who are to be members of "THE CENTRAL ECCLESIASTICAL
16 COUNCIL", which shall have final authority to resolve all problems
17 in aid to and furtherance of spiritual purpose for which this corporation
18 is founded, are as follows:

24 FIFTH: That the name of the existing non-incorporated
25 association which is being incorporated along with other individual
26 disciples, probationers and students of the Rosicrucian
27 Philosophy, sciences, principles and religion as founded and
28 expressed by Max Heindel and Mrs. Max Heindel (Augusta Foss
29 Heindel) is THE ROSICRUCIAN PROBATIONERS ASSOCIATION.

30 SIXTH: The authorized number, and qualifications of its
31 members, the different classes of membership, the property, voting
32

1 and other rights and privileges of each class of members are and
2 shall be as set forth in the by-laws of this corporation.
