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

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Introduction

A HUMAN BEING has two parts of life, a physical life and a spiritual life. Most people are focusing on their physical life. Many people are aiming on their spiritual life. Ancient Chinese wisdom teaches that everyone and everything is made of Shen Qi Jing (神氣精). "Shen" includes soul, heart, and mind. "Qi" means energy. "Jing" means matter. Shen Qi Jing includes the physical life and the spiritual life. Therefore, both physical life and spiritual life are very important. In this book, Tao Classic of Longevity and Immortality: Sacred Wisdom and Practical Techniques, I intend to serve humanity with sacred Tao wisdom and practical techniques to balance and develop both lives. Eventually, human beings can reach their greatest potentials in both lives: longevity, immortality, and attaining Tao.

What are the most important things in human life? You would agree with me that the most valuable things for a human being are good health and happiness. Almost every human being would love to have a long life. However, longevity is meaningless without quality. The quality of physical life depends on the evolution of the spiritual life.

Immortality is the highest achievement for one's physical and spiritual journeys. Immortality is hard to believe because it is simply not easy to encounter an immortal. There are legends of some Taoist saints, Buddhas, and other saints in history who lived for hundreds or thousands of years. Most of us have not seen these kinds of saints or Buddhas. Therefore, immortality seems just to be in legends or in realms of fantasy.

Yet in this book I will tell you otherwise. I will share Tao secrets, wisdom, knowledge, and practical techniques that make longevity and immortality possible and achievable. If you have already read my previous *New York Times* bestsellers, *Tao I*¹ and *Tao II*,² you would agree with me that Tao Normal Creation and Tao Reverse Creation are the most profound wisdom, philosophy, and science of all lives, including countless planets, stars, galaxies,

and universes. These two creations have unlimited levels of secrets, wisdom, knowledge, and practical techniques to help you reach longevity, immortality, and an even higher spiritual achievement: reach Tao. However, it is a lifelong or even many-lives-long study and practice to comprehend and achieve immortality and reach Tao. If you determine to pursue this, you would receive more and more "aha" or "wow" realization moments on this journey.

First, I would like to share wisdom from the foremost wise man Lao Zi (or Lao Tzu), the author of *Dao De Jing*³ (or *Tao Te Ching*). *Dao De Jing* is a fundamental text for both philosophy and religion. It is the ancient classic to learn Tao wisdom and practice. It has been studied and practiced by philosophers and Taoists in China for more than two thousand years. It is ancient wisdom for modern times.

Tao Normal Creation

Dao Sheng Yi (道生一)

Dao (Tao) is the Source. Tao is the Ultimate Creator. "Sheng" means create. "Yi" means oneness. Oneness is named Hun Dun Yi Qi (渾沌一氣). "Hun Dun" means blurred, formless. "Yi" means oneness. "Qi" means energy. "Hun Dun Yi Qi" means the oneness of blurred energy. "Dao Sheng Yi" means Tao creates Hun Dun Yi Qi, the Oneness condition. See figure 1.

Yi Sheng Er (一生二)

"Er" means two. "Yi Sheng Er" means Oneness creates Two: Heaven and Earth. Within the oneness of blurred energy there is the mixture of two types of Qi (energy): Qing Qi (清氣) and Zhuo Qi (濁氣). Qing Qi is clean and light energy. Zhuo Qi is unclean or heavy energy. This Oneness condition has waited for Qi Hua (氣化), which is the transformation of Qi. When Qi Hua occurs, Qing Qi rises to form Heaven. Zhuo Qi falls to form Mother Earth. Heaven is the physical manifestation of Yang. Mother Earth is the physical

manifestation of Yin. Yin and Yang are parts of the oneness of Tao. A human being lives between Heaven and Earth. Therefore, a human being lives within the Yin Yang world.

Er Sheng San (二生三)

"San" means three. "Er Sheng San" means Two creates Three: Oneness, Heaven, and Mother Earth.

San Sheng Wan Wu (三生萬物)

"Wan" means ten thousand. In Chinese, "ten thousand" represents innumerable. "Wu" means thing. "San Sheng Wan Wu" means Three creates everything. Oneness plus Heaven and Mother Earth create countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes and everything.

I called the process described in these four phrases of Lao Zi "Tao Normal Creation" and explained it in detail in my *Tao I* and *Tao II* books. Tao and One belong to the Wu World. This "Wu" means *emptiness* or *formlessness*, which is the Creator and Ultimate Source. Two, Three, and Wan Wu belong to the You World. "You" means *existence with forms*.

How are human beings and countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes created? The Wu World creates the You World. This is the answer that billions of people have searched for since creation. This is the great answer from the greatest wisdom man, Lao Zi.

Lao Zi also explained the immortality path in *Dao De Jing* through the phrases "Ren Fa Di, Di Fa Tian, Tian Fa Dao, Dao Fa Zi Ran (人法地, 地法天, 天法道, 道法自然)."

Ren Fa Di (人法地)

There is an ancient statement, "Ren Wei Wan Wu Zhi Ling (人為萬物之靈)." "Ren" means human being. "Wei" means is. "Wan Wu" means all things, including countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes. "Zhi" means their. "Ling" means soul, spirit. "Ren Wei Wan Wu Zhi Ling" means human beings are the

leading soul of all things. "Fa" means follow. "Di" means Mother Earth. "Ren Fa Di" means human beings follow the principles and laws of Mother Earth. For example, there is a weather law on Mother Earth. In the summer it is very hot in some parts of Mother Earth. People need to dress in summer clothes. If you were to wear winter clothes during summer heat, you could get sick or even die. In one sentence: Human beings must follow the laws of Mother Earth. This is Ren Fa Di.

Di Fa Tian (地法天)

"Di" means Mother Earth. "Fa" means follow. "Tian" means Heaven. "Di Fa Tian" means Mother Earth follows the principles and laws of Heaven.

The Shen Qi Jing of Heaven is purer than the Shen Qi Jing of Mother Earth. The sacred wisdom of Di Fa Tian is that after a human being's Shen Qi Jing transforms to Mother Earth's Shen Qi Jing, it then further transforms to Heaven's Shen Qi Jing. This is the second step of immortality. This is another level of sacred Tao wisdom and practice that Lao Zi revealed to humanity.

Tian Fa Dao (天法道)

Dao (Tao) is the Source and Ultimate Creator. "Tian" belongs to the You World, which is the existence world with forms. Tao is the Wu World. "Tian Fa Dao" means from the You World return to the Wu World. This is the third step of immortality. It further transforms Heaven's Shen Qi Jing to Tao's Shen Qi Jing. As the Source and Ultimate Creator, Tao has the purest Shen Qi Jing.

Dao Fa Zi Ran (道法自然)

Dao is the Source. In this phrase, "Fa" can be interpreted as yes. "Zi Ran" means nature. "Dao Fa Zi Ran" means Tao is nature or follow nature's way. Dao Fa Zi Ran is the state of immortality. Whatever your action, whatever your behavior, whatever your speech, and whatever your thought—all are completely melding with nature or completely following all of the universal principles and laws. Immortality is to live forever. This is the highest achievement for one's physical

life as well as for one's spiritual life. Immortality is the physical life and spiritual life joining as one. It is very difficult to believe in or even comprehend immortality if you do not have sacred spiritual wisdom. In *Dao De Jing*, Lao Zi released this profound sacred wisdom together with practice methods to reach immortality.

Although *Dao De Jing* is the most captivating masterpiece, it is the most difficult to comprehend. Many people have spent their entire lives dedicated to the study of *Dao De Jing* to limited benefit, just to gain a basic understanding.

Let me explain in a simple way. I called the immortality pathway "Tao Reverse Creation." As I mentioned earlier, all things are made of Shen Qi Jing. A human being is made of Shen Qi Jing. Mother Earth is made of Shen Qi Jing. Heaven is made of Shen Qi Jing. Tao is the Creator of Shen Qi Jing. However, there are enormous differences in the quality, frequency, and vibration of the Shen Qi Jing among them. In order to achieve longevity and immortality and then return to Tao, human beings must transform their Shen Qi Jing to Mother Earth's, Heaven's, and Tao's Shen Qi Jing to reverse the Tao Normal Creation process.

Tao Reverse Creation

The immortality path of Tao Reverse Creation can be explained through the phrases "Wan Wu Gui San, San Gui Er, Er Gui Yi, Yi Gui Dao (萬物歸三, 三歸二, 二歸一, 一歸道)."

Wan Wu Gui San (萬物歸三)

"Gui" means return. A human being is in the Wan Wu layer of the You World. Tao wisdom, knowledge, and messages are encoded in the human body. When you do Xiu Lian (修煉) practice, you will unlock the code to connect with Tao, in order to return to Tao. "Xiu" means purification. "Lian" means practice. "Xiu Lian" is purification practice to purify our Shen Qi Jing to the next level. The Xiu Lian process takes us through our entire spiritual journey and physical journey.

"Wan Wu Gui San" means all things return to Three. Countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, including human beings, return to Three, which is Hun Dun Yi Qi plus Heaven and Mother Earth. It is the reverse of San Sheng Wan Wu, *Three creates everything*, in Tao Normal Creation.

San Gui Er (三歸二)

"San Gui Er" means *Three returns to Two*. Hun Dun Yi Qi, Heaven, and Mother Earth return to Heaven and Mother Earth. It is the reverse of Er Sheng San, *Two creates Three*.

Er Gui Yi (二歸一)

"Er Gui Yi" means *Two returns to One*. The Shen Qi Jing of Heaven and Mother Earth join as one to go back to Oneness. It is the reverse of Yi Sheng Er, *One creates Two*.

Yi Gui Dao (一歸道)

"Yi Gui Dao" means the Shen Qi Jing of the Hun Dun Yi Qi condition goes back to Tao Source. It is the reverse of Dao Sheng Yi, Tao creates Hun Dun Yi Qi, the Oneness condition.

You may have noticed that my books and my teaching have become more and more simple. They directly come to the point. In Chinese, it is called Da Dao Zhi Jian (大道至簡). "Da" means big. "Dao" means the Way. "Zhi" means extremely. "Jian" means simple. "Da Dao Zhi Jian" means the big Way is extremely simple. I hope the simplicity of my teaching can make your longevity and immortality journey simpler as well.

The longevity and immortality journey is everyone's spiritual journey and physical journey. There is a renowned saying by Confucius: "Dao Bu Yuan Ren, Ren Zi Yuan (道不遠人, 人自遠)," which means Tao (the Way) is not far from a human being. A human being is far from Tao. Tao is in a human being and in every aspect of our lives. Tao is the universal principles and laws. However, a human being is far from Tao because a person's Shen Qi Jing blockages prevent that person from following the universal laws and principles of Tao.

Every aspect of life also has its Xiao Dao (小道, small way and principles). The whole universe has its Da Dao (大道, big way and principles). Why can people not see Tao? Because of Shen Qi Jing blockages. Shen includes soul, heart, and mind. Soul blockages include all kinds of negative karma. Heart blockages include greed (貪, tan), anger (嗔, chen), and lack of wisdom (癡, chi). Mind blockages include negative mind-sets, negative beliefs, negative attitudes, ego, attachments, and more. Qi blockages are energy blockages, which occur between the cells. Jing blockages are matter blockages, which occur inside the cells. In one sentence, Shen Qi Jing blockages are the pollution in one's spiritual journey and physical journey. On the Tao journey, the first step is to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages.

In summary, longevity and immortality are possible and achievable. However, serious purification and practice are musts. All of the sacred wisdom and practical techniques presented in this book will empower you on your Tao journey.

Open your heart and soul. Learn the sacred wisdom of longevity and immortality. Purify your Shen Qi Jing, which is your soul, heart, mind, and body. Practice. Practice. Practice.

Apply the secrets, wisdom, knowledge, and practical techniques in every aspect of your life.

Enlighten your soul, heart, mind, and body.

Follow the path of Tao Reverse Creation: Wan Wu Gui San, San Gui Er, Er Gui Yi, Yi Gui Dao, Dao Fa Zi Ran or Ren Fa Di, Di Fa Tian, Tian Fa Dao, Dao Fa Zi Ran.

Finally, you could reach longevity and immortality.

1. Tao Source sacred wisdom

To understand the wisdom, knowledge, and practical techniques contained within the new Tao Classic that is the core of this book, it is first essential to understand some important Tao terms and fundamental knowledge.

What is Tao?

Tao is the Source. Tao is the Ultimate Creator. Tao is immortality. Tao is the universal laws, rules, and principles. In *Dao De Jing*, Lao Zi explained that Tao is the blurred condition. Within the blurred condition there is Shen Qi Jing. The Shen Qi Jing of Tao is the purest and formless Shen Qi Jing.

The nature of Tao

The nature of Tao consists of ten essential qualities that are required for any serious Tao practitioner. I have explained these ten greatest qualities in detail in my book with Adam Markel, *Soul Over Matter.*⁴

Why does a person need to study and reach Tao?

Millions of people wish to have good health and happiness. Millions of people wish to have longevity. Millions of people are dreaming of immortality. Tao is immortality. Tao is the Source and Ultimate Creator. To study and practice Tao is to reach good health, happiness, longevity, and immortality.

Xiu Xian Cheng Dao (修体成道) is an ancient wisdom and practice since creation. "Xiu" means purification, including purification of Shen Qi Jing. "Xian" means saint. "Cheng" means to reach. "Dao" means immortality, the Source, or Ultimate Creator. "Xiu Xian Cheng Dao" is to purify your Shen Qi Jing to become a saint in order to finally reach Tao, which is immortality. To study and practice Tao can transform all our life.

All life includes:

- boosting energy, stamina, vitality, and immunity
- healing the spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical bodies
- transforming all kinds of relationships
- transforming finances
- · opening spiritual channels
- increasing wisdom and intelligence
- enlightening the soul, heart, mind, and body
- bringing success in every aspect of life
- prolonging life and moving toward immortality.

Wisdom of karma

To reach longevity and immortality, the first step is to heal our spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical bodies. I cannot emphasize enough the ancient wisdom that everyone and everything is made of Shen Qi Jing. Sickness is due to Shen Qi Jing blockages. These blockages result directly from one's negative karma.

What is karma, then? Karma is the record of one's services in all lifetimes, including this lifetime and past lifetimes. Karma includes positive karma and negative karma. Positive karma means that a person and that person's ancestors have offered love, care, compassion, sincerity, honesty, generosity, kindness, and more to others. Positive karma brings good health, happiness, blessed relationships, flourishing finances, and a good life.

Negative karma is the mistakes a person and that person's ancestors have made in this lifetime and past lifetimes, including killing, harming, taking advantage of others, cheating, stealing, and more. Negative karma is the root cause of sickness, relationship and financial challenges, lack of wisdom, and failure in any aspect of life. For instance, if you suffer knee pain in this life, you and your ancestors might have hurt others' knees in previous lifetimes or even in this lifetime. If you are depressed, you and your ancestors might have caused others to experience depression.

In one sentence:

What you are suffering in the spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical bodies is due to the suffering that you and your ancestors have caused to others in their spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical bodies.

Billions of people worldwide believe in karma. Billions of people have not yet realized this sacred wisdom and truth. I am delighted to share the truth of this sacred wisdom and practice.

In one sentence:

Karma is the root cause of success and failure in every aspect of life.

Shen includes soul, heart, and mind. Soul blockages are negative karma. Because ancient wisdom teaches that the heart houses the mind and soul, it is vital to remove heart blockages for healing all life. Heart blockages include impurities, selfishness, greed, anger, and lack of wisdom in actions, behaviors, speech, and thoughts. Mind blockages include negative mind-sets, negative beliefs, negative attitudes, ego, and attachments. Ego is one of the greatest blockages in life. A renowned spiritual father in history, Wang Yang Ming (玉陽明), said, "Ego is the biggest enemy in one's spiritual journey and physical journey." To purify the ego, humility is the answer. Greatest humility is the fifth of the Ten Da natures bestowed by Tao Source.

Three key steps to accomplish longevity and immortality

In ancient wisdom, all sickness in the spiritual body, mental body, emotional body, and physical body is caused by "lou ti (滿體)." "Lou" means *leak*. "Ti" means *body*. A leaky human body is like a cup with cracks. Fill the cup with water and the water gradually leaks out. A leaky human body is an unhealthy body that gradually leaks its Shen Qi Jing. To heal all sickness, the leaky body must be repaired, transformed, and filled.

A human being's body has two major parts: spaces and organs. The major spaces include:

- seven Soul Houses
- San Jiao: the pathway of Qi and bodily fluid
- Wai Jiao: the biggest space in the body, located in front of the spinal column from the neck to the tailbone, plus the space in the back of the head
- Jing Channel
- Qi Channel
- · Shen Channel.

Step One: Bu Lou Zhu Ji (補漏築基), fulfill the leaky body and build a foundation

"Bu" means fulfill. "Lou" means leak, referring to the body. "Zhu" means to build. "Ji" means foundation. "Bu Lou Zhu Ji" means fulfill the leaky body and build a foundation. It includes healing all sickness in the spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical bodies by removing all layers of Shen Qi Jing blockages. To study and chant the new Tao Classic is to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages in the spaces and organs. You are actually repairing and fulfilling your leaky body in the spaces and organs simultaneously. You are purifying your spaces and organs.

Step Two: Ming Xin Jian Xing (明心見性), enlighten the heart to see one's own true nature, Yuan Shen (元神), which is one's Tao nature

Ming Xin Jian Xing is the second major step to reach longevity and immortality. "Ming" means enlighten. "Xin" means heart. "Jian" means to see. "Xing" means nature of Tao, the Divine, Buddha, and saints. "Ming Xin Jian Xing" means enlighten the heart to see one's own true nature. It is the pathway that one must go through to accomplish longevity and immortality.

Enlighten your heart to see your Yuan Shen, your Tao nature. Every human being has his or her true nature, called Yuan Shen (元神). It is the nature of Tao, the nature of Buddha, the nature of saints in all realms.

Why can't most people see their own true nature? It is because of Shen Qi Jing blockages. Ming Xin is to clear Shen Qi Jing blockages, and then Jian Xing is to have a realization of one's Tao nature. Everyone has both a Shi Shen (識神), one's reincarnated soul, and a Yuan Shen, the true nature of one's self. Yuan Shen is hidden in the area of the Ming Men acupuncture point (located on the lower back directly behind the navel). Shi Shen is located in the heart and is in charge of one's life. If one reaches Ming Xin, one has removed many Shen Qi Jing blockages. One can then see the Yuan Shen. Yuan Shen is the true boss of one's life. In ancient wisdom, Ming Xin Jian Xing is to reach the saints' level.' To meld Shi Shen with Yuan Shen is to reach Tao. It is the highest achievement of Tao practice.

Many saints are recognized by the various religions. Saints have enlightened souls, hearts, minds, and bodies. There are countless Buddhas, holy

saints, Taoist saints, lamas, gurus, kahunas, and more. They reside in the fourth dimension. Human beings are in the third dimension. A human's Shen Qi Jing has much lower frequency, vibration, and quality than a saint's. So, to become a saint, one has to learn from the saints' example: offer service to others to make others healthier and happier. When one serves, Heaven will uplift one's soul, heart, mind, and body according to the level of the service. Service can be given in every aspect of life through Shen Kou Yi (身中意). "Shen" means *action*. "Kou" means *speech*. "Yi" means *thought*. We have shared the Ten Da qualities above. They are the greatest natures of Tao, the greatest principles to follow in action, speech, and thought to provide the greatest service.

Step Three: Bao Yuan Shou Yi, Shen Qi Jing He Yi (抱元守一, 神氣精合一), hold, focus, and meld with Tao, soul heart mind body join as one

Bao Yuan Shou Yi is the final step to reach Tao, to become a Buddha or a highest saint in other spiritual realms. They are the same. This is the highest achievement in one's spiritual journey and physical life. What is Bao Yuan Shou Yi? "Bao" means hold. "Yuan" means original, and specifically Yuan Shen, Yuan Qi, and Yuan Jing, which are the Shen Qi Jing of Tao. "Shou" means focus. "Yi" means Oneness. Tao creates Oneness. "Bao Yuan Shou Yi" means hold and focus on your Yuan Shen, Yuan Qi, and Yuan Jing and meld with Tao.

Let's use Tao Normal Creation and Tao Reverse Creation in figure 1 to explain this process.

Tao Normal Creation is Tao → One → Two → Three → Wan Wu.

Tao Reverse Creation is Wan Wu \rightarrow Three \rightarrow Two \rightarrow One \rightarrow Tao.

I would like to remind you of the sacred wisdom that Heaven and Mother Earth belong to the You (existence) World. The number one law in the You World is Yin Yang law. The You World is the Yin Yang world.

Tao and Oneness are the Wu (emptiness, formless) World. In the Wu World, the law is Bao Yuan Shou Yi, Oneness. If you are in the Yin Yang world, you have not reached Tao or become immortal because of the dual nature of Yin and Yang. To reach Tao and become immortal, you must apply the immortal law. It is the Wu World law, Bao Yuan Shou Yi, to become Oneness.

Zhong (中): the core of life

The Chinese character 中 (zhong) represents the core of life. For a human being, it is the fundamental area for Tao practice. It is located at "Kun Gong Ming Men Wei Lü Hui Yin Zu Gen Zhong (坤宮命門尾間會陰足跟中)," which means Kun Temple, Ming Men acupuncture point, sacrum, perineum, plus the heels of the feet. Everyone and everything has a Zhong. A human's Zhong is Ren Zhong (人中). Mother Earth's Zhong is Di Zhong (地中). Heaven's Zhong is Tian Zhong (天中). Tao's Zhong is Dao Zhong (道中).

Zhong is the number one area for all kinds of spiritual practitioners to reach Tao, because the core of a human being, Mother Earth, Heaven, and Tao can be joined as one in one's Zhong.

In chapter five of *Dao De Jing*, Lao Zi revealed a sacred statement for the Tao practice of Zhong: "Duo Yan Shu Qiong, Bu Ru Shou Zhong (多言數窮, 不如守中)." "Duo" means *much*. "Yan" means *talk*. "Shu Qiong" means *end*. "Bu Ru" means *not as good as*. "Shou" means *focus*. "Zhong" means *core of life*. "Duo Yan Shu Qiong, Bu Ru Shou Zhong" means *endless talking is not as good as focusing on the Zhong*. This sacred teaching and practice has been the key guidance for humanity to do Tao practice to achieve longevity and immortality.

2. Practice

Studying Tao wisdom and doing Tao practices are the Yin and Yang to achieve longevity and immortality. To only study the wisdom without practice will not yield any results. I teach and emphasize the Four Power Techniques to lead you to do Tao practices chapter by chapter.

The Four Power Techniques are:

Body Power. Body Power is to use hand and body positions to purify and to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages in order to heal, rejuvenate, prolong life, and move forward on the pathway of immortality. One example is to grip your left thumb with your right hand effortlessly. Then place both hands on your lower abdomen, below the navel.

Soul Power. Soul Power⁵ is to say *hello* to the inner souls of your body, including the souls of the spaces, systems, organs, cells, cell units, DNA, and RNA, as well as to outer souls, including saints, healing angels, archangels, ascended masters, lamas, gurus, all kinds of spiritual fathers and mothers, the Divine, and Tao Source, to invoke their power for healing, rejuvenation, and life transformation.

Mind Power. Mind Power is creative visualization. The most important wisdom is to visualize golden or rainbow light radiating in your body to transform your health, relationships, finances, and more.

Sound Power. Sound Power is to chant or sing the new Tao Classic. You can follow me to chant the new Tao Classic accompanied by beautiful Tao music. The recording will guide you in the proper pronunciations and the best melody for each of the one hundred forty-six lines. My singing will bless and empower your longevity, immortality, and Tao journey every time you listen or chant to it. 3. How to use this book

This book has three parts and nineteen chapters:

Part I: Tao Natures

In eleven chapters, you will learn how to use the Ten Da Tao Natures to heal and to develop and enlighten the key spaces in the body.

Part II: Tao Body

In two chapters, you will learn further how to heal and how to develop and enlighten the organs of your body.

Part III: Attain Tao

In six chapters, you will learn how to join your Shen Qi Jing as one and meld with Tao. Teachings include:

- how to form and grow the Jin Dan until it reaches the size of your body
- the state of achieving immortality and reaching Tao.

Each chapter contains three sections:

- 1. text of Tao Classic in Chinese and Pinyin with English translation
- 2. sacred wisdom of the Tao Classic
- 3. practice: Use the Four Power Techniques to practice the sacred wisdom.

Figures are provided to guide the practice step by step. Note that the chanting in each chapter always starts from the beginning of the Tao Classic, because it is important to activate each Soul House before starting to learn the new practice. In this way, you can keep your practice consistent to receive optimum benefits.

To help you practice the entire Tao Classic, you will find the complete text in the appendix at the end of this book.

Finally, I strongly suggest that you study my *Tao I* and *Tao II* books before you continue in this book. Those two earlier books will help you build fundamental knowledge and prepare your body with basic *Tao* training. In that way, you can get much better results when you study this book.

I wish you a joyful and successful longevity, immortality, and Tao journey!

Tao Natures




Figure 2. Seven Soul Houses with associated Ten Da Tao Natures




Figure 3. Seven Soul Houses, San Jiao, Wai Jiao, Ming Men point, Lower Dan Tian, and Wei Lü with associated Ten Da Tao Natures

In Part I, I will teach you how to use the Ten Da Tao Natures to heal, develop, and enlighten the major spaces in your body, including the seven Soul Houses, San Jiao, Wai Jiao, Ming Men, Lower Dan Tian, and Wei Lü (figures 2 and 3). The leaky body includes all sickness in the spiritual, mental, emotional, and physical bodies. Shen Qi Jing blockages in these major spaces can cause many sicknesses. To purify and clear these spaces is one of the keys to fulfilling the leaky body, which is to heal and prevent all kinds of sickness.

Each Soul House also has its unique significance for the soul journey. Each one is directly related to your spiritual standing. The higher the Soul House in which your soul resides, the higher your spiritual standing in Heaven. The soul journey is to uplift your soul to reside in higher and higher Soul Houses within your body.

The Qi Channel is the most important energy channel in the body. It is the key for healing all kinds of sicknesses. The Jing Channel is the most important matter channel in the body. It is the key for rejuvenation. The Shen Channel is the most important channel for the soul, heart, and mind. It is the key for longevity and immortality.

Ming Men is divided into the Ming Men acupuncture point and Ming Men area. The Ming Men area is the area inside the lower back between the kidneys. The Ming Men acupuncture point is the point on the lower back directly behind the navel. The Ming Men acupuncture point is the core of the Ming Men area. The Ming Men area is the hub of Shen Qi Jing of the five Zang (Yin) organs, which are the liver, heart, spleen, lungs, and kidneys, and the six Fu (Yang) organs, which are the gallbladder, small intestine, stomach, large intestine, urinary bladder, and San Jiao (the pathway of Qi and bodily fluid).

The Lower Dan Tian is located in the lower abdomen, centered 1.5 cun below the navel (one cun equals approximately 0.3 cm) and 2.5 cun inside the body. It is about the size of a fist. The Lower Dan Tian is one of the foundational energy centers of the body.

The Wei Lü is the tailbone or sacrum. It is another key area in the body for foundational energy.

Sacred Wisdom

嘿嘿嘿 Hei Hei (First Soul House)

Hei Hei Hei is a sacred and secret Tao mantra to develop the first Soul House. The first Soul House is a fist-sized space just above the perineum, which is the region between the genitals and the anus (figure 4). At the physical level, this area is the generator of energy and life. It is the engine that produces the driving force to generate and propel energy through the remaining six Soul Houses and the entire body. At the spiritual level, the first Soul House is the generating source of energy and light. It is the beginning of the soul journey. Each human being's soul has experienced many lifetimes in order to progress on its journey. If one's soul sits in the first Soul House, the soul is still at the beginning stage of its journey. To do practice for the first Soul House is to uplift the soul's standing in Heaven and to remove significant physical and emotional blockages in life.

嘿金丹 Hei Jin Dan

"Jin" means gold. "Dan" means light ball. Ancient wisdom says, "Jin Guang Zhao Ti, Bai Bing Xiao Chu (全光照體, 百病消除)." "Jin" means gold. "Guang" means light. "Zhao" means to shine. "Ti" means body. "Bai" means one hundred. In this context, one hundred represents innumerable. "Bing" means sickness. "Xiao Chu" means to remove. "Jin Guang Zhao Ti, Bai Bing Xiao Chu" means golden light shines in the body, all sickness is removed.

When you chant Hei Hei Hei, Hei Jin Dan, you gather the Shen Qi Jing from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Tao, and Oneness to form the first Soul House Hei Jin Dan. "Hei" is a sacred mantra. "Hei Jin Dan" is a golden light ball.

In this new Tao Classic, each Soul House and several spaces, as well as various organs, has its own sacred mantra. These sacred mantras create Jin Dans (golden light balls) in their associated areas.

I would like to share with you that I have trained Tao Master Teachers and Grandmaster Teachers to transmit Tao Jin Dans to the Soul Houses, important spaces, and key organs in the body. You can receive Jin Dan transmissions from these certified Tao Masters to accelerate your physical journey and your soul journey. It would take much longer, even an entire lifetime, to form a Jin Dan solely with self-practice.

大光明 Da Guang Ming

"Da" means greatest. "Guang" means light. "Ming" means transparent and bright. "Da Guang Ming" means greatest light and transparency.

大光明金丹 Da Guang Ming Jin Dan

"Da Guang Ming Jin Dan" means greatest light and transparency golden light ball. When you chant *Da Guang Ming, Da Guang Ming Jin Dan*, you gather Shen Qi Jing from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Tao, and Oneness to form Da Guang Ming Jin Dan.

我在道光中 Wo Zai Dao Guang Zhong

"Wo" means I. "Zai" means to be in. "Dao Guang" means Tao light. "Zhong" means within. "Wo Zai Dao Guang Zhong" means I am inside Tao light.

道光在我中 Dao Guang Zai Wo Zhong

"Dao Guang Zai Wo Zhong" means Tao light is inside me.

通體透明 Tong Ti Tou Ming

"Tong" means whole. "Ti" means body. "Tou Ming" means bright and transparent.

"Tong Ti Tou Ming" means the whole body is bright and transparent in the Tao light.

Deeper wisdom of Da Guang Ming

Da Guang Ming, greatest light, is the fourth of the very important Ten Da qualities of Tao. In fact, all forms of spiritual practice aim to develop a light body. In one sentence:

To do spiritual practice is to transform the physical body to a light body.

In my book *Soul Over Matter*, four sacred phrases have been extracted from the sacred wisdom of Da Guang Ming:

Si Da Guang Ming (四大光明) Wo Zai Dao Guang Zhong (我在道光中) Dao Guang Zai Wo Zhong (道光在我中) Tong Ti Tou Ming (通體透明)

The fourth of the Ten Da natures of Tao is greatest light and transparency. I am inside Tao Source light.

Tao Source light is inside me.

The whole body is completely light and transparent.

To transform the physical body to a light body is a very slow and long process. It takes hours of practice a day for decades to make a little progress. In addition, light bodies have different frequencies and vibrations. For a Tao practitioner, there are unlimited frequencies and vibrations of light body to be attained, including Mother Earth light's frequency and vibration, Heaven light's frequency and vibration, countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes light's frequency and vibration, and Tao Source light's frequency and vibration. Therefore, remember that the light body has unlimited layers. Tao is bigger than biggest. As Tao practitioners, we need to practice with our full Shen Qi Jing in

order to reach Tao. In ancient wisdom there are sacred phrases to explain how to practice:

Yong Xin Song Nian (用心誦念) Yong Xin Xiu Lian (用心修 煉) Xiu Xin Yang Xing (修心養性)

Yong Xin Song Nian

"Yong" means to use. "Xin" means heart. "Song Nian" means to chant. "Yong Xin Song Nian" means use the heart to chant. Using the heart yields hugely different results than not using the heart. In our book Soul Mind Body Science System, Dr. Rulin Xiu and I have stated that Shen includes soul, heart, and mind. In quantum science, soul is information or message. Heart is the receiver. Mind is the processor. Qi is energy, which is the mover. Jing is matter, which is the transformer.

A mantra is a message or information. Heart is the receiver. Opening the heart is the key to processing the message. If one opens the heart only ten percent, then the person can receive only ten percent of the benefits. If one opens the heart fifty percent, the person can receive fifty percent of the benefits. If one opens the heart fully, the person will receive full benefits. Therefore, the sacred wisdom is that when a person chants a mantra with full concentration and greatest honor, respect, and appreciation, then the person could receive full benefits from the chanting. So, when you chant every sacred phrase in this new Tao Classic, use your heart to chant.

There is another ancient phrase, "Shi Ban Gong Bei (事半功倍)." "Shi" means things. "Ban" means half. "Gong" means results. "Bei" means double or multiple. "Shi Ban Gong Bei" means half the effort can yield double or multiple results. For example, if you chant for ten minutes absentmindedly, you would receive a little benefit. If you use the heart to chant for five minutes, you could receive twice, thrice, or even more times the benefits. This is the ancient wisdom of chanting.

Yong Xin Xiu Lian

"Xiu Lian" means purification practice. "Yong Xin Xiu Lian" means use the heart to do purification practice. What is purification? Purification is to purify our Shen Kou Yi, which are our actions, speech, and thoughts. Everything we do is through Shen Kou Yi. How do we know we are doing the right things? In one sentence:

To serve others by teaching and serving them to have good health and happiness and transforming blockages in any aspect of their lives is the highest Xiu Lian practice.

Xiu Xin Yang Xing

"Xiu" means to purify. "Xin" means heart. "Yang" means nourish and transform. "Xing" means nature. "Xiu Xin Yang Xing" means purify the heart, nourish and transform one's nature. Some people have the nature of love. Through Xiu Xin Yang Xing, their love can be developed deeper. Some people have the nature of compassion. Through Xiu Xin Yang Xing, their compassion can also be developed deeper. Some people can be somehow selfish. Through Xiu Xin Yang Xing, selfishness can be transformed to generosity. Some people can be mean. This can be transformed to kindness. Purifying the heart can transform one's nature.

Another ancient wisdom is Jiang Shan Yi Gai, Ben Xing Nan Yi (江山易改, 本性難移). "Jiang Shan" means rivers and mountains. "Yi" means easy. "Gai" means to change or to transform. "Ben" means original. "Xing" means nature of a human being. "Nan" means difficult. "Yi" means to transform. "Jiang Shan Yi Gai, Ben Xing Nan Yi" means it is easier to change and transform rivers and mountains than one's nature. To transform the nature of humanity and wan ling (all souls) is the biggest, highest transformation. Therefore, to chant and do spiritual practice, one must be patient and persistent. A Tao practitioner must have the courage, patience, persistence, and dedication to do spiritual practice. For any success in any aspect of life, persistence is a key. Finally, persistence will bring success.

Da Guang Ming is one of the highest achievements of all transformation. When you have blockages in health, relationships, finances, intelligence, or any aspect of life, your frequency and vibration are low. Da Guang Ming will increase your frequency and vibration to transform your health and build a light body. It also transforms your relationships and finances to a light body. In one sentence:

To transform health, relationships, finances, intelligence, and success, and to reach Ming Xin Jian Xing, longevity, and immortality are to transform the normal body to the greatest light body.

I am inside Tao Source light. Tao Source light is inside me.

This is to invoke Tao Source light, which carries Tao Shen Qi Jing that can transform our own Shen Qi Jing. Tao Source is the Ultimate Creator. Tao Source Shen Qi Jing is the purest Shen Qi Jing. When you chant, "I am inside Tao Source light. Tao Source light is inside me," you are actually invoking Tao Source to transform your Shen Qi Jing blockages. The secret wisdom is that Tao Source light transforms your Shen Qi Jing in a fast way, to serve others. To serve is to make others happier and healthier.

Tao Source transforms us. We must remember to serve more. The more we serve, the more transformation we will receive from Tao Source. Therefore, chant more.

Practice

Apply the Four Power Techniques:

1. Body Power




Figure 4. First Soul House Jin Dan Practice: front view and side view

Two body positions can be used for the practice: sitting position (figure 4) and standing position. The sitting position is for Yin practice. The standing position is for Yang practice. Yin practice is mainly to create water energy and Yang practice is to create fire energy. Yin and Yang energy joining as one is called Yin Yang He Yi (陰陽合一).

Please also follow this principle of Yin Yang balance: Chant once in the sitting position. Then chant once in the standing position. Continue to alternate the sitting and standing positions. Or you can practice entirely in the sitting position. In this case, do your next practice entirely in the standing position.

Always alternate sitting and standing positions in your practice. This is the sacred principle of Yin Yang balance to achieve the best results.

Here is the sitting position: Sit up straight. Raise the tip of your tongue so that it gently touches the roof of your mouth. Hold your left thumb firmly with your right hand and place both hands over your first Soul House at the bottom of your abdomen.

Here is the standing position: Stand with your feet shoulder-width apart. Bend your knees slightly. Tuck in your abdomen and pelvis. Hold your arms and hands in front of you as though you were holding a ball at the level of your navel. Keep your back straight. Tuck in your chin slightly. Imagine there is a string on the top of your head pulling you gently upward.

2. Soul Power

Say hello to inner and outer souls:

Dear Tao Source.

Dear Heaven and Mother Earth,

Dear countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes,

Dear Bao Yuan Shou Yi Chang Shou Yong Sheng Dao Jing (Tao Classic of Longevity and Immortality),

I love you, honor you, and appreciate you.

Please purify and remove my Shen Qi Jing blockages for healing, rejuvenation, transformation of relationships and finances, increasing intelligence, and flourishing in every aspect of my life.

Please bless my spiritual practice for longevity and immortality and develop my first Soul House and my Da Guang Ming, greatest light.

Please bless me to achieve longevity and immortality.

I am extremely honored and grateful.

Thank you. Thank you. Thank you.

3. Mind Power

Visualize a Tao Source Jin Dan (golden light ball) shining and rotating in your first Soul House and then radiating through your entire body (figure 4). The

light is cleansing Shen Qi Jing blockages in your first Soul House and then getting stronger and brighter as the Jin Dan grows to the size of your body.

4. Sound Power

Chant the first stanza (chapter one) of the Tao Classic of Longevity and Immortality:

Hei Hei Hei
Hei Jin Dan
Da Guang Ming
Da Guang Ming Jin Dan
Wo Zai Dao Guang Zhong
Dao Guang Zai Wo Zhong
Tong Ti Tou Ming

Chant aloud or silently at least ten times—the more times the better. If you want to accelerate your healing and your Tao journey, you can chant for a half hour or even one to two hours for this and each Soul House. There is no time limit. To chant aloud is Yang chanting, which creates fire energy. To chant silently is Yin chanting, which creates water energy. Alternate chanting aloud and chanting silently to maximize the benefits.

哼全丹 Heng Jin Dan

When you chant Heng Heng Heng, Heng Jin Dan, you gather Shen Qi Jing from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Tao, and Oneness to form the second Soul House Jin Dan. It is called Heng Jin Dan.

大感恩 Da Gan En

"Da" means greatest. "Gan En" means gratitude. "Da Gan En" means greatest gratitude.

大感恩金丹 Da Gan En Jin Dan

"Da Gan En Jin Dan" means greatest gratitude golden light ball. When you chant Da Gan En Jin Dan, you are gathering Shen Qi Jing from Tao Source and Oneness, which are the Wu World, as well as from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, which are the You World, to form Da Gan En Jin Dan.

道生德養 Dao Sheng De Yang

Dao is the Source and Ultimate Creator. "Sheng" means create. "De" means virtue. De is the Shen Kou Yi of Tao. "Shen" means action. "Kou" means speech. "Yi" means thought. "Yang" means nourish. "Dao Sheng De Yang" means the Source and Ultimate Creator creates everyone and everything, and De nourishes them.

栽培賜慧 Zai Pei Ci Hui

"Zai Pei" means to cultivate. "Ci" means bestow. "Hui" means wisdom and intelligence. "Zai Pei Ci Hui" means the Source and Ultimate Creator cultivates and bestows wisdom and intelligence on everyone and everything.

道恩永存 Dao En Yong Cun

Dao is the Source and Ultimate Creator. "En" means glory. "Yong Cun" means forever or everlasting. "Dao En Yong Cun" means the glory of the Source and Ultimate Creator remains in our hearts and souls forever.

Deeper wisdom of Da Gan En

In our lives there are many people who have helped us physically or spiritually. We should always show our gratitude to them. For instance, parents raise their children. Children should have gratitude for their parents. Teachers in kindergarten, elementary school, middle school, high school, and university teach students. Students should express gratitude to their teachers.

The Divine and Tao Source have bestowed appropriate wisdom and blessings to every soul's physical life and spiritual journey. We should appreciate and be grateful to them. Gratitude is one of the Tao natures that every human

being and every soul should have. For our good health, happiness, harmonious relationships, and financial and business flourishing, we need to show our gratitude to the Divine, Tao Source, and anyone who has helped us on our spiritual or physical journeys.

The four-line sacred mantra of *Da Gan En* can transform our lives further and enhance every aspect of our lives:

Ba Da Gan En (八大感恩) Dao Sheng De Yang (道生德養) Zai Pei Ci Hui (栽培賜慧) Dao En Yong Cun (道恩永存)

The eighth of the Ten Da Tao Natures is greatest gratitude.

Tao Source creates all things, De nourishes them.

Tao Source cultivates and bestows wisdom and intelligence.

The glory of Tao Source should remain in our hearts and souls forever.

Practice

Apply the Four Power Techniques:

1. Body Power

Sit or stand as in the practice in chapter one. Remember to alternate sitting and standing positions in your practice in order to achieve the best results.

2. Soul Power

Say hello to inner and outer souls:

大謙卑 Da Qian Bei

"Qian Bei" means humility. "Da Qian Bei" means greatest humility.

大謙卑金丹 Da Qian Bei Jin Dan

"Da Qian Bei Jin Dan" means greatest humility golden light ball. 柔弱不爭 Rou Ruo Bu Zheng

"Rou" means gentle. "Ruo" means soft. "Bu" means do not. "Zheng" means compete. "Rou Ruo Bu Zheng" means be gentle and soft, do not compete. In ancient spiritual wisdom, a gentle and soft nature always overcomes a strong and harsh nature. For example, gently dripping water can wear through a stone to create a hole.

持續精進 Chi Xu Jing Jin

"Chi Xu" means persistent. "Jing Jin" means improve, advance. "Chi Xu Jing Jin" means improve and advance persistently.

失謙卑 Shi Qian Bei

"Shi" means lose. "Qian Bei" means humility. "Shi Qian Bei" means lose humility.

跌萬丈 Die Wan Zhang

"Die" means fall. "Wan" means ten thousand. In Chinese, "wan" represents countless, innumerable. "Zhang" is a Chinese measuring unit of length that equals 3.3 meters. "Die Wan Zhang" means fall down very deeply. Here it implies tremendous failures, obstacles, and loss in every aspect of life.

Deeper wisdom of Da Qian Bei

Da Qian Bei, greatest humility, is the fifth of the Ten Da Tao Natures. Humility benefits life and prevents disasters and challenges. Ego is one of the biggest blockages in every aspect of life. When you succeed financially or in business, or when you are in a powerful position, such as a government official or a

world leader, congratulations for your success. Be aware that it is also a time when your ego could grow very easily. Use the greatest humility to contain your ego.

An ancient statement can help you understand why humility is important: Mo Shi Zai Ren, Cheng Shi Zai Tian (謀事在人, 成事在天). "Mo" means planning, marketing, organizing, controlling, developing, and more. "Shi" means thing. "Zai" means depend. "Ren" means human being. "Cheng" means success. "Tian" means Heaven. "Mo Shi Zai Ren, Cheng Shi Zai Tian" means planning, marketing, and developing anything depend on a human team, but success depends on Heaven's team.

A human team and Heaven's team are the Yin team and the Yang team. A human team is in the You World. Heaven's team is in the Wu World. When you reach success in business, in politics, or in any aspect of life, remain humble. Then Heaven's team will continue to bless you with further flourishing. If you grow ego, you will lose the blessings from Heaven's team. You could learn a serious lesson.

Why do some businesses flourish more and more? Why do some businesses get smaller and smaller and even go bankrupt? Why are some country and world leaders always honored by people, while some are not? People have not realized the sacred wisdom that humility cultivates one's good health and happiness. Modern medicine and many other healing modalities have not realized the wisdom that ego is one of the major causes of sickness.

Therefore, humility is the key for continued success in business, health, social and all kinds of relationships, and every aspect of life. To chant the few sacred phrases of Da Qian Bei is to remind you to remain humble and to avoid ego. Your life will be blessed.




Figure 6. Third Soul House Jin Dan Practice: front view and side view




Figure 8. Fifth Soul House Jin Dan Practice: front view and side view

Da Kuan Shu is great wisdom and practice to reach Ming Xin Jian Xing. Everyone has experienced some challenges, including anger, depression, anxiety, worry, sadness, fear, and all kinds of other emotions and issues. We can have challenges between husband and wife, and with relatives, colleagues,

countries, and religions. We can have physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual challenges. One of the most important and most effective ways to overcome all kinds of challenges is through forgiveness.

I forgive you. You forgive me. Bring love, peace, and harmony.

This is a vital practice to remove anger and all other unbalanced emotions to bring love, peace, and harmony to your life. Why is a person not able to forgive others? The reason is Shen Qi Jing blockages. There is great wisdom that humanity should know. Suppose for example that colleague A treats colleague B inappropriately. B could react very angrily to A. However, if you have deep spiritual wisdom or the ability to see past lifetimes, you would understand that B had treated A in the same inappropriate way in one or more past lifetimes. With this knowledge, which is called the Law of Karma, you would react differently.

We can expand this wisdom to relatives, countries, and religions. The same principle applies. The Law of Karma is the root principle for all life. To purify and remove Shen Qi Jing blockages of all physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual challenges, the key is to forgive. I understand that it can be hard to forgive someone who hurt or harmed us. However, to truly forgive each other is the key to self-clear our own negative karma and to purify all Shen Qi Jing blockages with all kinds of emotions. It is easy to say. It is difficult to do. It is why one of the highest qualities for a true spiritual being is the ability to offer unconditional forgiveness. It is one of the highest spiritual principles and practices as well.

How can you forgive? Chant the four sacred phrases with your heart and soul. It will help you to:

- forgive more and more
- transform all kinds of emotions
- heal all kinds of sicknesses
- · transform all kinds of relationships and finances
- reach Ming Xin Jian Xing.

Sacred wisdom

嗡嗡嗡 Weng Weng Weng (Seventh Soul House)




Figure 10. Seventh Soul House Jin Dan Practice: front view and side view

Weng is a sacred and secret Tao mantra to develop the seventh Soul House. The seventh Soul House is located at the crown chakra on top of the head (figure 10).

嗡金丹 Weng Jin Dan

When you chant Weng Weng Weng, Weng Jin Dan, you gather Shen Qi Jing in a secret way from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Tao, and

Oneness to form the seventh Soul House Jin Dan, which is called Weng Jin Dan.

大圆滿 Da Yuan Man

"Da" means greatest. "Yuan Man" means enlightenment. "Da Yuan Man" means greatest enlightenment.

大圓滿金丹 Da Yuan Man Jin Dan

"Da Yuan Man Jin Dan" means greatest enlightenment golden light ball. When you chant Da Yuan Man Jin Dan, you are gathering Shen Qi Jing from Tao Source and Oneness, which are the Wu World, as well as from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, which are the You World, to form Da Yuan Man Jin Dan.

靈心腦身圓滿 Ling Xin Nao Shen Yuan Man

"Ling" means soul. "Xin" means heart. "Nao" means mind. "Shen" means body. "Yuan Man" means enlightenment. "Ling Xin Nao Shen Yuan Man" means soul, heart, mind, and body enlightenment.

人地天道神仙梯 Ren Di Tian Dao Shen Xian Ti

"Ren" means human being. "Di" means Mother Earth. "Tian" means Heaven. Dao is the Source and Ultimate Creator. "Shen Xian" means saints. "Ti" means stairs or levels. "Ren Di Tian Dao Shen Xian Ti" means the different levels of saints—Human saint, Mother Earth saint, Heaven saint, and Tao Source saint—are the stairs to greatest enlightenment.

服務修煉才可攀 Fu Wu Xiu Lian Cai Ke Pan

"Fu Wu" means service. "Xiu Lian" means purification practice. "Cai" means only. "Ke" means able to. "Pan" means to climb. "Fu Wu Xiu Lian Cai Ke Pan" means only through service and purification can one climb all of Heaven's enlightenment stairs step by step, from Human saint to Mother Earth saint, to Heaven saint, and finally to Tao Source saint.

Deeper wisdom of Da Yuan Man

Da Yuan Man, greatest enlightenment, is the tenth of the Ten Da natures of Tao. It is the last Tao nature required to reach Tao. The four-line sacred mantra of Da Yuan Man is:

Shi Da Yuan Man (十大圓滿) Ling Xin Nao Shen Yuan Man (靈心腦身圓滿) Ren Di Tian Dao Shen Xian Ti (人地天道神仙梯) Fu Wu Xiu Lian Cai Ke Pan (服務修煉才可攀)

The tenth Da Tao Nature is greatest enlightenment.

Soul, heart, mind, and body enlightenment

Levels of Ren Xian, Di Xian, Tian Xian, and Tao Xian

Only through service can greatest enlightenment be achieved.

A human being is made of Shen Qi Jing: soul, heart, mind, and body. To reach greatest enlightenment is to enlighten soul, heart, mind, and body.

In my book *Soul Mind Body Science System*, I shared four sacred phrases to express the sacred wisdom and truth of the relationships among soul, heart, mind, and body:

Ling Dao Xin Dao (靈到心到) Xin Dao Yi Dao (心到意到) Yi Dao Qi Dao (意到氣到) Qi Dao Xue Dao (氣到血到)

Ling Dao Xin Dao

"Ling" means soul or spirit. In quantum science, soul is information or message. "Dao" means arrive. "Xin" means heart. "Ling Dao Xin Dao" means the soul message arrives at the heart. The heart is the receiver of the message.

Xin Dao Yi Dao

"Yi" means consciousness. It can be expressed as thought. "Xin Dao Yi Dao" means the heart passes the message to the brain. The brain is the processor of the message.

Yi Dao Qi Dao

"Yi Dao Qi Dao" means the consciousness passes the message to the energy (Qi). Energy is the mover.

Qi Dao Xue Dao

"Xue" means *blood*, which represents matter. "Qi Dao Xue Dao" means *the energy passes the message to the matter*. Matter is the transformer.

Ling Dao Xin Dao, Xin Dao Yi Dao, Yi Dao Qi Dao, and Qi Dao Xue Dao explain the relationships among Shen Qi Jing. This is the sacred wisdom and practice that Dr. Rulin Xiu and I released to humanity and wan ling (all souls) in the *Soul Mind Body Science System* book. Enlightenment follows the same process. These relationships can be expressed as:

- Ling (soul, spirit, information) content of message
- Xin (heart, core of life) receiver of message
- Nao (mind, consciousness) processor of message
- Qi (energy) mover of message
- Jing (matter) transformer of message.

Jing is the transformer. From the soul, the message or information goes to the heart, then to the mind, next to the energy, and finally to the matter. After the matter transforms the message, the transformed message will be given as feedback to the soul. The soul will then give a new message. This is the sacred process in the whole body. The sacred enlightenment process is for the soul to reach enlightenment first, next the heart, then the mind, and finally the body, which includes energy and matter.

To reach Ming Xin Jian Xing is to reach the saints' level. To reach the saints' level is to have a saint's soul, heart, mind, and body. Saints have the following layers or levels:

- Ren Xian (Human saint)
- Di Xian (Mother Earth saint)
- Tian Xian (Heaven saint)
- Dao Xian (Tao Source saint).

When one's soul, heart, mind, and body have completely melded with Tao as one, immortality has been reached. At the Ren Xian, Di Xian, and Tian Xian levels, a saint's Shen Qi Jing melds with Tao more and more, until finally one becomes a Dao Xian. Then this one has completely melded with Tao, which is immortality.

Practice

Apply the Four Power Techniques:

Sit or stand as in the practice in chapter one. Alternate sitting and standing positions in your practice for optimum results.

2. Soul Power

Say hello to inner and outer souls:

Dear Tao Source,

Dear Heaven and Mother Earth,

Dear Bao Yuan Shou Yi Chang Shou Yong Sheng Dao Jing (Tao Classic of Longevity and Immortality),

I love you, honor you, and appreciate you.

Please purify and remove my Shen Qi Jing blockages for healing, rejuvenation, transformation of relationships and finances, increasing intelligence, and flourishing in every aspect of my life.

Please bless my spiritual practice of longevity and immortality and develop my seventh Soul House and my Da Yuan Man, greatest enlightenment.

Please bless me to achieve longevity and immortality.

I am extremely honored and grateful.

Thank you. Thank you. Thank you.

3. Mind Power

Visualize a Tao Source Jin Dan (golden light ball) shining and rotating in the seventh Soul House and then radiating through the entire body (figure 10). The light is cleansing Shen Qi Jing blockages in your seventh Soul House and then getting stronger and brighter as the Jin Dan grows to the size of your body.

4. Sound Power

Chant silently or aloud the first seven stanzas of the *Tao Classic of Longevity and Immortality* (from chapters one through seven), and then repeat the seventh stanza (in **bold** below) ten or more times in each practice session. Remember that it is best to alternate silent and aloud (Yin Yang) chanting.

呦呦呦 You You (Ming Men)




Figure 11. Ming Men Jin Dan Practice

You is a sacred and secret Tao mantra to develop the Ming Men point and area, as well as to clear the Wai Jiao (figure 11).

呦金丹 You Jin Dan

When you chant You You, You Jin Dan, you gather Shen Qi Jing in a secret way from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Tao, and Oneness to clear the Wai Jiao and form a Ming Men Jin Dan, which is called You Jin Dan.

大慈悲 Da Ci Bei

"Da" means greatest. "Ci Bei" means compassion. "Da Ci Bei" means greatest compassion.

大慈悲金丹 Da Ci Bei Jin Dan

"Da Ci Bei Jin Dan" means *greatest compassion golden light ball*. When you chant *Da Ci Bei Jin Dan*, you are gathering Shen Qi Jing from Tao Source and Oneness, which are the Wu World, as well as from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, which are the You World, to form Da Ci Bei Jin Dan.

願力增強 Yuan Li Zeng Qiang

"Yuan Li" means willpower. "Zeng Qiang" means to increase and strengthen. "Yuan Li Zeng Qiang" means increase and strengthen willpower.

服務眾生 Fu Wu Zhong Sheng

"Fu Wu" means to serve. "Zhong Sheng" means humanity and all souls. "Fu Wu Zhong Sheng" means serve humanity and all souls.

功德無量 Gong De Wu Liang

"Gong De" means virtue. "Wu Liang" means immeasurable. "Gong De Wu Liang" means immeasurable virtue.

Deeper wisdom of Da Ci Bei

Da Ci Bei, greatest compassion, is the third of the Ten Da natures of Tao. The sacred four-line Tao Source mantra of Da Ci Bei is:

San Da Ci Bei (三大慈悲) Yuan Li Zeng Qiang (願力增強) Fu Wu Zhong Sheng (服務眾生) Gong De Wu Liang (功德無量)

The third of the Ten Da Tao Natures is greatest compassion. Increase and strengthen willpower.

Serve humanity and all souls.

Gain immeasurable virtue.

Compassion is a great quality for a spiritual being. Guan Yin, the Bodhisattva of Compassion, is a great example and spiritual mother for millions of people. She made most powerful vows (in the Lotus Sutra) to save sentient

beings from any life-threatening situations, such as fire, water, war, and sickness. When you call her name, her soul will instantly come to save you and bless you unconditionally.

One of many stories and legends about Guan Yin involves a fisherman who was fishing in the ocean. When a severe storm suddenly began, his boat capsized. The fisherman thought he was going to drown. He called Guan Yin, shouting "Guan Yin Jiu Ming (觀音救命)." "Jiu" means save. "Ming" means life. A huge wave swamped him and his boat, and he lost consciousness. When he awoke, he was lying safely on the shore. This is how Guan Yin saves people's lives. There are also many stories of people who received miraculous healing from incurable diseases when they chanted Weng Ma Ni Ba Ma Hong, which is Guan Yin's six-word mantra of enlightenment. That is why Guan Yin has been deeply honored by millions of people.

There are five sacred phrases to honor Guan Yin. They are:

Qian Shou Qian Yan (千手千眼) Da Ci Da Bei (大慈大悲) Jiu Ku Jiu Nan (救苦救難) Guang Da Yuan Man (廣大圓滿) Guan Shi Yin Pu Sa (觀世音菩薩)

One thousand spiritual hands, one thousand spiritual eyes Greatest compassion Save me and overcome all my challenges and sufferings Greatest enlightenment Guan Yin bodhisattva

"Qian" means thousand. In Chinese, a thousand represents innumerable. "Shou" means hands. "Yan" means eyes. "Qian Shou Qian Yan" can mean a thousand hands and a thousand eyes or uncountable hands and uncountable eyes. These hands and eyes of Guan Yin are spiritual hands and eyes. In her hands, she holds Fa Qi (法器). "Fa" means spiritual. "Qi" means instruments. Fa Qi can include swords, towers, balls, and many more. A Fa Qi carries high-dimension spiritual power to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages of a human being. Therefore, Guan Yin has been given thousands of spiritual hands and eyes to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages for health, relationships, finances, and every aspect of life. She has created countless miracle healings for all life.

"Da" means *greatest*. "Ci Bei" means *compassion*. "Da Ci Da Bei" means *greatest compassion*. Guan Yin is honored as the Bodhisattva of Compassion. Guan Yin's new name in this Soul Light Era is Ling Hui Sheng Shi. The Soul Light Era is a new universal era. It began on August 8, 2003 and will last at least fifteen thousand years. "Ling" means *soul*. "Hui" means *intelligence*. "Sheng" means *saint*. "Shi" means *servant*. "Ling Hui Sheng Shi" means *soul intelligence saint servant*. She is a bodhisattva, but she is humbly called a servant.

In my teaching, every Buddha, bodhisattva, holy saint, and healing angel, our beloved Divine, Tao, and Source are all unconditional universal servants. The purpose of life is to serve. To serve is to make others happier and healthier. Da Ci Da Bei is Guan Yin's nature. She is the great example and full embodiment of greatest compassion. "Jiu" means save. "Ku" literally means bitterness, sufferings. It also represents challenges. "Nan" means disasters and suffering. "Ku Nan" means all life challenges and sufferings. Jiu Ku Jiu Nan is to save people from all kinds of life challenges and sufferings. Guan Yin is one of the greatest beings of compassion. She serves us unconditionally. Therefore, billions of people have deeply honored and respected her. "Guang Da" means vast. "Yuan Man" means enlightenment or perfection. Guang Da Yuan Man is to honor Guan Yin's greatest enlightenment.

Therefore, to honor Guan Yin by chanting the five sacred phrases is to transform you to be more compassionate like Guan Yin. When you chant these five phrases, the Shen Qi Jing of Guan Yin will bless you to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages of compassion and to be more compassionate.

Remember to alternate silent and aloud (Yin Yang) chanting for best results.

大昌盛 Da Chang Sheng

"Da" means greatest. "Chang Sheng" means flourishing. "Da Chang Sheng" means greatest flourishing.

大昌盛金丹 Da Chang Sheng Jin Dan

"Da Chang Sheng Jin Dan" means *greatest flourishing golden light ball*. When you chant *Da Chang Sheng Jin Dan*, you are gathering Shen Qi Jing from Tao Source and Oneness, which are the Wu World, as well as from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, which are the You World, to form Da Chang Sheng Jin Dan.

道賜盈福 Dao Ci Ying Fu

Dao is the Source and Ultimate Creator. "Ci" means bestow. "Ying" means full or huge. "Fu" means good fortune and luck. "Dao Ci Ying Fu" means Tao Source bestows huge fortune, including Tao wisdom, health, longevity, happiness, good relationships, prosperity, luck, success, and more, to all aspects of life.

行善積德 Xing Shan Ji De

"Xing Shan" means offer kind service, including action, speech, and thought. "Ji De" means accumulate virtue. "Xing Shan Ji De" means offer kind service through action, speech, and thought to accumulate good virtue.

道業昌盛 Dao Ye Chang Sheng

Dao is the Source and Ultimate Creator. "Ye" means career. "Chang Sheng" means flourishes. "Dao Ye Chang Sheng" means Tao career flourishes.

Deeper wisdom of Da Chang Sheng

Da Chang Sheng, greatest flourishing, is the seventh of the Ten Da natures of Tao. The four-line sacred Tao mantra of Da Chang Sheng is:

Qi Da Chang Sheng (七大昌盛) Dao Ci Ying Fu (道賜盈福) Xing Shan Ji De (行善積德) Dao Ye Chang Sheng (道業昌盛) The seventh of the Ten Da Tao Natures is greatest flourishing. Tao Source bestows huge prosperity, luck, and success.

Offer kind service to accumulate virtue.

Tao career flourishes.

I would like to share a deep spiritual wisdom. The roots of a person's flour-ishing are positive karma from past lifetimes and personal effort in the current lifetime. If you have open spiritual channels, you may be able to see past lifetimes to understand this truth.

Financial success is due to positive karma from your ancestors and you from past and current lifetimes and great personal effort in the current lifetime.

Positive karma is accumulated through great service for humanity to make others healthier and happier and to transform their lives in a positive way. Karma in past lifetimes is recorded in one's Akashic Record book. It is the place to record a human being's and a soul's life. This positive karma can transform your financial flourishing in this lifetime and in future lifetimes. If you have great flourishing, congratulations. I wish for you to receive more. If you do not have great flourishing, how can you create it? The secret is to accumulate positive karma through Shen, Kou, and Yi (action, speech, and thought). To chant sacred Tao mantras is to accumulate positive karma. Your chanting can serve others and bring positive Shen Qi Jing of Tao to your life.

For example, a businessman in Los Angeles received one of my Tao calligraphies, "Dao Ye Chang Sheng (道業昌盛)," which means *Tao career flourishes*. He told me, "Since I received the 'Dao Ye Chang Sheng' Tao calligraphy, I have traced it and chanted for about ten minutes every day. Money comes without any effort. Everything is flowing. My company has grown from about a two-million-dollar business to sixty million dollars within two years. I absolutely give the credit to the 'Dao Ye Chang Sheng' calligraphy and mantra."

Because the "Dao Ye Chang Sheng" Tao mantra and calligraphy carry the Shen Qi Jing of Tao, his business received huge blessings from Tao Source. Chant these four sacred phrases to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages in your finances and business. Chant more to receive more benefits. Remember to use the heart to chant. Chant a minimum of ten minutes per day.

Dan Tian and then getting stronger and brighter as your Jin Dan grows to the size of your body.

Sacred wisdom

吁吁吁 Yu Yu Yu (Wei Lü)

Yu is a sacred and secret Tao mantra to develop the Wei Lü, which is the tailbone area (figure 13).

吁金丹 Yu Jin Dan

When you chant Yu Yu, Yu Jin Dan, you gather Shen Qi Jing in a secret way from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Tao, and Oneness to form the Wei Lü Jin Dan, which is called Yu Jin Dan.

大和諧 Da He Xie

"Da" means greatest. "He Xie" means harmony. "Da He Xie" means greatest harmony.

大和諧金丹 Da He Xie Jin Dan

"Da He Xie Jin Dan" means *greatest harmony golden light ball*. When you chant *Da He Xie Jin Dan*, you are gathering Shen Qi Jing from Tao Source and Oneness, which are the Wu World, as well as from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, which are the You World, to form Da He Xie Jin Dan.

三人同心 San Ren Tong Xin

"San" means three. "Ren" means human being. "Tong" means together. "Xin" means heart. "San Ren Tong Xin" means three people join their hearts together.

齊力斷金 Qi Li Duan Jin

"Qi Li" means the strength of three hearts joined together. "Duan" means cut. "Jin" means gold. "Qi Li Duan Jin" means the strength of three hearts joined together can cut through gold.

成功秘訣 Cheng Gong Mi Jue

"Cheng Gong" means success. "Mi Jue" means secret. "Cheng Gong Mi Jue" means the Tao secret wisdom of success.

Deeper wisdom of Da He Xie

Da He Xie, greatest harmony, is the sixth of the Ten Da natures of Tao. It is another essential quality for true success in one's life.

The four-line sacred Tao mantra of Da He Xie is:

Liu Da He Xie (六大和諧) San Ren Tong Xin (三人同行) Qi Li Duan Jin (齊力斷金) Cheng Gong Mi Jue (成功密訣)

The sixth of the Ten Da Tao Natures is greatest harmony. Three people join hearts together.

Their strength can cut gold. The secret of success.

To have a happy family, each family member must offer love, care, and compassion. Everyone needs to forgive each other and be in harmony. There is an ancient statement: Jia He Wan Shi Xing (家和萬事興). "Jia" means family. "He" means harmony. "Wan" means ten thousand, countless. "Shi" means things. "Xing" means flourishing. "Jia He Wan Shi Xing" means in a harmonized family everything is flourishing. Think about a very successful business. It must have a great harmonized team. Da He Xie represents great teamwork. Without Da He Xie, it is impossible to have great flourishing. To have great harmony, one must also have the other Ten Da natures.

The Ten Da are the natures of Tao, Buddha, saints, the Divine, countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Mother Earth, and human beings. Da He Xie is great teamwork, which is the key for success. Let us love one another and join as one to create greatest success in every aspect of our lives.

Practice

Apply the Four Power Techniques:

1. Body Power

Sit or stand as in the practice in chapter one. Alternate sitting and standing positions in your practice in order to achieve the best results.

2. Soul Power

Say hello to inner and outer souls:

Sacred wisdom

Now we are going to purify and remove Shen Qi Jing blockages within the most important Shen Qi Jing channels in the body.

Qi Channel

The Qi Channel is the major energy channel in a human body. It starts at the Hui Yin acupuncture point on the perineum, at the base of the first Soul House. It moves up through the second, third, fourth, fifth, and sixth Soul Houses to

the Bai Hui acupuncture point on the crown of the head and at the base of the seventh Soul House. From there, the Qi Channel turns down through the Wai Jiao back to the first Soul House. The Wai Jiao is the space in front of the spinal column. It is the biggest space in the body (figure 14, top). The Qi Channel is the key for healing all sickness.

The sacred and secret mantra of the Qi Channel is: 嘿哼哄啊唏噎嗡呦 Hei Heng Hong Ah Xi Yi Weng You.

The Qi Channel is the pathway of the seven Soul Houses, San Jiao, and Wai Jiao. Hei Heng Hong Ah Xi Yi Weng You assembles all the secret mantras on the pathway. Therefore, this mantra not only purifies and removes Shen Qi Jing blockages from the Qi Channel, it also further removes Shen Qi Jing blockages from and strengthens each Soul House, the San Jiao, and Wai Jiao. The more you chant, the more benefits you will receive on this pathway.

Jing Channel




Figure 14. Qi (top), Jing (middle), Shen (bottom) Channels Practice

The Jing Channel (figure 14, middle) moves in the reverse direction of the Qi Channel. The Jing Channel also starts at the Hui Yin acupuncture point on the perineum but moves up and back to the tailbone, goes through an invisible hole in the tailbone, and connects with the spinal cord. It then goes up through the spinal cord to the brain and up to the Bai Hui acupuncture point on the crown of the head. Next, it flows down the central channel through the sixth, fifth, fourth, third, second, and first Soul Houses, returning to the Hui Yin acupuncture point. The Jing Channel is the key for rejuvenation and longevity.

The sacred and secret mantra for the Jing Channel is: 呦嗡噎唏啊哄哼嘿 You Weng Yi Xi Ah Hong Heng Hei.

When you chant *You Weng Yi Xi Ah Hong Heng Hei*, you are cleansing the sacred pathway for rejuvenation and longevity. Because the Qi Channel and Jing Channel have similar pathways, the sacred Jing Channel mantra can also further remove Shen Qi Jing blockages from and strengthen each Soul House, the San Jiao, and Wai Jiao. Therefore, chant more to receive more benefits in these vital spaces of the body.

Four ancient sacred phrases explain the Jing Channel:

Lian Jing Hua Qi (煉精化氣) Lian Qi Hua Shen (煉氣化神) Lian Shen Huan Xu (煉神還虛) Lian Xu Huan Dao (煉虛還道) "Lian" and "Hua" both mean transform. "Jing" means matter. "Qi" means energy. "Lian Jing Hua Qi" means transform Jing to Qi. According to ancient Tao wisdom and traditional Chinese medicine, the kidneys produce Jing, the essence of matter. This Jing flows to the tailbone through an invisible hole up to the spinal cord and transforms to Qi, energy, which has higher frequency. "Lian Qi Hua Shen" means transform Qi to Shen. Qi flows up inside the spinal column to the brain. Before it reaches the brain, Lian Qi Hua Shen. The energy purifies and is uplifted to the Shen level, which includes soul, heart, and mind. "Lian Shen Huan Xu" means return soul, heart, and mind to emptiness. The Shen flows from the brain down to the heart, where soul, heart, and mind can be purified and enlightened to the empty state. "Lian Xu Huan Dao" means return emptiness to Tao. "Xu" is emptiness. "Dao" is ultimate emptiness. Tao is in the Zhong, which is essentially the back half of the lower abdomen. I will explain further knowledge and wisdom of Zhong in chapter fourteen. You Weng Yi Xi Ah Hong Heng Hei is the simplified version of this ancient four-phrase Tao wisdom and practice.

Shen Channel

The Shen Channel (figure 14, bottom) is the immortality pathway. It starts simultaneously at the Bai Hui acupuncture point at the base of the seventh Soul House with the secret mantra *Weng* and at the Hui Yin acupuncture point at the base of the first Soul House with the secret mantra *Hei*. From these two points, the Shen Channel flows through the central channel down from the seventh Soul House and up from the first Soul House, to meet behind the navel in the third Soul House with the secret mantra *Hong*. From there, it flows straight back to the Ming Men acupuncture point where it splits, with one part going up through the Wai Jiao, returning to the Bai Hui acupuncture point, and the other part going down through the Wai Jiao, returning to the Hui Yin acupuncture point, all with the secret mantra *You*.

Therefore, the sacred and secret mantra of the Shen Channel is: 嗡嘿哄呦 Weng Hei Hong You.

The secret mantra *Weng* connects with Heaven. The secret mantra *Hei* connects with Mother Earth. The secret mantra *Hong* connects with a human being. The secret mantra *You* connects with Tao. When you chant *Weng Hei Hong You*, the Shen Qi Jing of Heaven, Mother Earth, human being, and Tao will join as one. Therefore, this sacred mantra is to practice and achieve immortality.

光感謙愛服寬圓慈 Guang Gan Qian Ai Fu Kuan Yuan Ci

This mantra is for practicing and purifying the Qi Channel further to heal all sickness. The functions are the same as with the mantra *Hei Heng Hong Ah Xi Yi Weng You*. *Hei Heng Hong Ah Xi Yi Weng You* is the secret Tao mantra with sacred meaning. *Guang Gan Qian Ai Fu Kuan Yuan Ci* is the Tao mantra that incorporates eight of the Ten Da Tao Natures.

"Guang" refers to Da Guang Ming, which is greatest light. It is the sacred mantra for the first Soul House.

"Gan" refers to Da Gan En, which is greatest gratitude. It is the sacred mantra for the second Soul House.

"Qian" refers to Da Qian Bei, which is greatest humility. It is the sacred mantra for the third Soul House.

"Ai" refers to Da Ai, which is greatest love. It is the sacred mantra for the fourth Soul House.

"Fu" refers to Da Fu Wu, which is greatest service. It is the sacred mantra for the fifth Soul House.

"Kuan" refers to Da Kuan Shu, which is greatest forgiveness. It is the sacred mantra for the sixth Soul House.

"Yuan" refers to Da Yuan Man, which is greatest enlightenment. It is the sacred mantra for the seventh Soul House.

"Ci" refers to Da Ci Bei, which is greatest compassion. It is the sacred mantra for the Ming Men point, Kundalini, and Wai Jiao.

Each Da has unique power and abilities to transform all life. Applying one Da is powerful. Applying eight Da together is beyond powerful. The mantra Guang Gan Qian Ai Fu Kuan Yuan Ci is the key for healing all sickness of the body.

慈圓寬服愛謙感光 Ci Yuan Kuan Fu Ai Qian Gan Guang

Similarly, *Ci Yuan Kuan Fu Ai Qian Gan Guang* is the mantra of the Jing Channel with eight of the Ten Da Tao Natures. The functions are the same as in the mantra *You Weng Yi Xi Ah Hong Heng Hei*. Both are powerful mantras for rejuvenation and longevity. It is the reverse order of the Qi Channel mantra *Guang Gan Qian Ai Fu Kuan Yuan Ci*. Chant *Ci Yuan Kuan Fu Ai Qian Gan Guang* as much as you can to receive immeasurable benefits for your Jing Channel.

圓光謙慈 Yuan Guang Qian Ci

Yuan Guang Qian Ci is the mantra for the Shen Channel with four of the Ten Da Tao Natures. The Shen Channel is the Ren Di Tian Dao He Yi (人地天道 合一) Channel, where human being, Mother Earth, Heaven, and Tao join as one. Therefore, the Shen Channel is the Tao Channel. To practice the mantras Weng Hei Hong You and Yuan Guang Qian Ci is to practice and achieve immortality. Chant Yuan Guang Qian Ci as much as you can. The benefits are beyond comprehension.




3. Mind Power

When you chant Hei Heng Hong Ah Xi Yi Weng You and Guang Gan Qian Ai Fu Kuan Yuan Ci, visualize a golden light ball moving from the first Soul House up to the seventh Soul House, then down through the Wai Jiao back to the first Soul House to form a circle (figure 14, top).

When you chant You Weng Yi Xi Ah Hong Heng Hei and Ci Yuan Kuan Fu Ai Qian Gan Guang, visualize a golden light ball moving from the first Soul House to the tailbone, then up the spinal cord to the Bai Hui acupuncture point at the top of the head. From there, it flows down the center of the body through all seven Soul Houses back to the Hui Yin acupuncture point (figure 14, middle).

When you chant *Weng Hei Hong You* and *Yuan Guang Qian Ci*, visualize two golden light balls, one in the seventh Soul House and one in the first Soul House. They move through the center of the body and join as one in the third Soul House. The one ball moves straight back to the Ming Men acupuncture point, where it subdivides into two balls that travel respectively up and down through the Wai Jiao, returning to the Bai Hui and Hui Yin acupuncture points (figure 14, bottom).

Part II Tao Body

TO FULFILL THE leaky body, there are two steps: One is to purify the spaces. I have shared the secret wisdom for this in step I. The other part is to purify the organs. According to ancient Tao wisdom and traditional Chinese medicine, the human body is made up of five basic elements (figure 15). Each element is led by an authority organ that is in charge of the entire element. The Five Elements, their authority organs, and more are:

Wood element

The Wood element includes the liver, gallbladder, eyes, tendons, and, in the emotional body, anger. The authority organ of the Wood element is the liver. To purify and to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages from the liver will directly benefit everything within the Wood element.

Fire element

The Fire element includes the heart, small intestine, tongue, blood vessels, and, in the emotional body, depression and anxiety. The authority organ of the Fire element is the heart. To purify and to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages from the heart will directly benefit everything within the Fire element.

Earth element

The Earth element includes the spleen, stomach, mouth, lips, teeth, gums, muscles, and, in the emotional body, worry. The authority organ of the Earth element is the spleen. To purify and to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages from the spleen will directly benefit everything within the Earth element.

Metal element

The Metal element includes the lungs, large intestine, nose, skin, and, in the emotional body, sadness and grief. The authority organ of the Metal element is the lungs. To purify and to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages from the lungs will directly benefit everything within the Metal element.

Water element

The Water element includes the kidneys, urinary bladder, ears, bones, and, in the emotional body, fear. The authority organ of the Water element is the kidneys. To purify and to remove Shen Qi Jing blockages from the kidneys will directly benefit everything within the Water element.

In part II (chapters twelve and thirteen), I will share the sacred mantras for the authority organs of the Five Elements and more to fulfill your leaky body and to purify, develop, and enlighten your physical body.

"Zhuang Shen" means *strengthen the kidneys*. Zhuang Shen Jin Dan is a golden light ball to strengthen and develop the kidneys. When you chant *Zhuang Shen Jin Dan*, you gather the Shen Qi Jing from countless planets, stars, galaxies, and universes, Tao, and Oneness to form the Zhuang Shen Jin Dan.

In summary, to reach longevity and immortality, the first step is Bu Lou Zhu Ji, fulfill the leaky body and build a foundation. To clear Shen Qi Jing blockages in the spaces (part I, chapters one through twelve) is the sacred way to heal and prevent all sickness. To purify and heal major organs is also a very important practice to heal all sickness. Both practices are equally important for the longevity and immortality journey.

3. Mind Power

The visualizing practices below will guide you step by step to develop the Five Elements' Jin Dans (figure 15) and enlighten each of them.

When you chant Xu Xu Xu, Xu Jin Dan, Shu Gan Jin Dan, visualize a golden light ball shining in and around your liver to heal, strengthen, and prevent sickness in the liver and the rest of the Wood element, including the gallbladder, eyes, tendons, and, in the emotional body, anger. This could also enlighten your liver.

When you chant *Ah Ah Ah, Ah Jin Dan, Yang Xin Jin Dan*, visualize a golden light ball shining in and around your heart to heal, strengthen, and prevent sickness in the heart and the rest of the Fire element, including the small intestine, tongue, blood vessels, and, in the emotional body, depression and anxiety. This could also enlighten your heart.

When you chant Hu Hu Hu, Hu Jin Dan, Jian Pi Jin Dan, visualize a golden light ball shining in and around your spleen to heal, strengthen, and prevent sickness in the spleen and the rest of the Earth element, including the stomach,

mouth, lips, teeth, gums, muscles, and, in the emotional body, worry. This could also enlighten your spleen.

When you chant Si Si Si, Si Jin Dan, Xuan Fei Jin Dan, visualize a golden light ball shining in and around your lungs to heal, strengthen, and prevent sickness in the lungs and the rest of the Metal element, including the large intestine, skin, nose, and, in the emotional body, sadness and grief. This could also enlighten your lungs.

When you chant *Chui Chui Chui, Chui Jin Dan, Zhuang Shen Jin Dan*, visualize a golden light ball shining in and around your kidneys to heal, strengthen, and prevent sickness in the kidneys and the rest of the Water element, including the urinary bladder, ears, bones, and, in the emotional body, fear. This could also enlighten your kidneys.

Sacred wisdom

目不妄視 Mu Bu Wang Shi

"Mu" means eye. "Bu" means not. "Wang" means random. "Shi" means to look at. "Mu Bu Wang Shi" means do not look at things randomly to avoid seeing impure and polluted things. According to ancient spiritual teaching, the eyes are the windows of the heart and the soul. When you look at impure and polluted things, your heart and soul could be infected and even get lost. This is the first step of purification, to stop being polluted. Then your heart and soul will become purer and purer with your Xiu Lian (purification practice).

耳不妄聽 Er Bu Wang Ting

"Er" means ear. "Ting" means to listen. "Er Bu Wang Ting" means do not listen to sounds randomly to avoid hearing impure and polluted sounds. Human language carries positive and negative power. The ears and hearing connect with the kidneys through the Water element. The kidneys produce Jing (the essence of matter). Therefore, to hear negative sounds, words, and messages will cause you to leak Jing. This is how hearing and matter (Jing) are connected.

口不妄言 Kou Bu Wang Yan

"Kou" means mouth. "Yan" means to speak. "Kou Bu Wang Yan" means do not speak carelessly with impure or polluted words. When you speak, you use energy (Qi). If you speak negative words, you could seriously lose your Qi. When we speak negative words, it is usually with negative emotions, such as anger, upset, or overexcitement. This could easily cause significant loss of Qi. It is why we can feel exhausted after such outbursts.

Furthermore, an ancient spiritual teaching says, "Huo Cong Kou Chu (褐從口出)," which means disasters and misfortune come from the mouth. Speaking too much, especially speaking carelessly and negatively, is a fast way to create

negative karma and burn your virtue. Virtue is spiritual currency to bless every aspect of your life. To lose virtue is to harm your spiritual life and physical life.

外三寶不漏 Wai San Bao Bu Lou

"Wai" means external. "Wai San Bao" means three external treasures, which are eyes, ears, and mouth. "Bu Lou" means do not leak. "Wai San Bao Bu Lou" means do not leak your Jing Qi Shen through your eyes (seeing), ears (hearing), and mouth (speaking).

不視安神於心 Bu Shi An Shen Yu Xin

"Bu Shi" means do not look at or see. "An Shen" means peaceful Shen (soul, heart, mind). "Yu Xin" means in the heart. "Bu Shi An Shen Yu Xin" means do not look at impure things to keep your Shen (soul, heart, mind) pure and peaceful in your heart. This is the Tao teaching on how to develop peace and nourish your Shen.

不聽蓄精於腎 Bu Ting Xu Jing Yu Shen

"Bu Ting" means do not hear. "Xu Jing" means to accumulate Jing (matter). This character "Shen" means kidney. "Bu Ting Xu Jing Yu Shen" means do not hear impure sounds to accumulate Jing in your kidneys. This is the Tao teaching on how to gather and accumulate your Jing.

不言孕氣丹田 Bu Yan Yun Qi Dan Tian

"Bu Yan" means do not speak. "Yun Qi" means to increase Qi (energy). "Dan Tian" is the Lower Dan Tian, a foundational energy center in the lower abdomen. "Bu Yan Yun Qi Dan Tian" means do not speak too much, especially by speaking impure words, in order to increase the pure energy in your Lower Dan Tian. This is the Tao teaching on how to increase and accumulate your Qi.

內三寶自合 Nei San Bao Zi He

"Nei" means internal. "Nei San Bao" means three internal treasures, which are Shen, Qi, and Jing. "Zi He" means join together. "Nei San Bao Zi He" means three internal treasures (Shen, Qi, Jing) join as one. When the three internal treasures join as one, a Jin Dan is formed. It is Ming Xin Jian Xing, enlighten your heart to see your own true nature. During this process, your Shi Shen (reincarnated soul) will realize and receive guidance from your Yuan Shen (original Tao soul). Gradually, Shi Shen will align more and more with Yuan Shen until, finally,

they meld together as one. This is a very long process, but an essential step to reach Tao.

外不漏 Wai Bu Lou

Three external treasures (eyes, ears, mouth) do not leak.

內自合 Nei Zi He

Three internal treasures (Shen, Qi, Jing) join as one.

通天達地 Tong Tian Da Di

"Tong Tian" means connect with Heaven. "Da Di" means connect with Mother Earth. "Tong Tian Da Di" means connect through Heaven and Mother Earth as one. When you join your three internal treasures (Shen, Qi, Jing) together, you will see your Yuan Shen, your original soul, which is Tao. Tao creates Heaven, Mother Earth, and all things, which means you have connected with them. They are in you. You are in them. Everyone and everything carries the Tao nature. Why can't a person reach Tao? It is because of the person's Shen Qi Jing blockages.

逍遙道中 Xiao Yao Dao Zhong

"Xiao Yao" means free, liberated. "Dao Zhong" means in the Tao. "Xiao Yao Dao Zhong" means meld with Tao to have true freedom from all You World laws. After your three external treasures (eyes, ears, mouth) stop leaking and your three internal treasures (Shen, Qi, Jing) join as one, you have reached the level where Heaven and Mother Earth join as one with you. Then you can be uplifted from the You (existence) World to the Wu (emptiness) World. Therefore, you are no longer controlled by the laws of Heaven and Mother Earth. You have reached the Tao. You have reached the condition that Lao Zi expressed as Dao Fa Zi Ran, follow nature's way. You will be able to offer great service with all Ten Da Tao Natures.

Attain Tao

 ${\bf B}^{\rm AO}$ YUAN SHOU Yi is the final step to reach Tao and become a Buddha. This is the highest pursuit and highest goal in one's physical life and spiritual life.

Remember the profound sacred wisdom of Tao Normal Creation and Tao Reverse Creation that I shared in the introduction to this book and in figure 1.

Tao and One are the Wu World (emptiness and formless world). In the Wu World, the law is Bao Yuan Shou Yi, Oneness. Heaven and Mother Earth belong to the You World (existence and forms world). The number one law in the You World is Yin Yang law. We live on Mother Earth, so we live in the Yin Yang world. Hence, birth, aging, sickness, and death are the inescapable parts of life. To escape from those sufferings and become an immortal, one must apply the immortal law, which is the Wu World law of Bao Yuan Shou Yi, to become Oneness.

In part III, chapters fourteen through nineteen, I will teach you the sacred wisdom of Bao Yuan Shou Yi, and how to practice it to form and grow the Jin Dan in your body to achieve longevity and immortality, which is to reach Tao, the summit of all sacred spiritual mountains.

Sacred wisdom

抱元守一 Bao Yuan Shou Yi

I have explained this phrase in the introduction. "Bao Yuan Shou Yi" means to hold Yuan Shen, Yuan Qi, and Yuan Jing and focus on One, which is Tao.

一即是中 Yi Ji Shi Zhong

"Yi" means Oneness. "Ji Shi" means is exactly. "Zhong" means core of life. "Yi Ji Shi Zhong" means Oneness is Zhong, the core of life, which is Tao.

坤宮命門尾閭會陰足根中 Kun Gong Ming Men Wei Lü Hui Yin Zu Gen Zhong

This sacred mantra describes the position of the Zhong (figure 17) in a human body.

"Kun Gong" means *Kun Temple*. It is located in the third Soul House, in the center of the body behind the navel.

"Ming Men" refers to the Ming Men acupuncture point on the back. It is directly behind the navel. "Ming" means *life*. "Men" means *gate*. "Ming Men" means *life gate*. It is the core of the Kundalini, a foundational energy center that is located in front of the sacrum.

"Wei Lü" is the sacrum or tailbone area.

"Hui Yin" is an acupuncture point located on the perineum, between the genitals and the anus.

"Zu Gen" means the heels of both feet.

"Kun Gong Ming Men Wei Lü Hui Yin Zu Gen Zhong" means the Zhong extends from the Kun Temple to the Ming Men acupuncture point, to the tailbone, to the first Soul House, and down to the heels of both feet.

人中地中 Ren Zhong Di Zhong

"Ren" means human being. "Zhong" means core of life. "Di" means Mother Earth. "Ren Zhong Di Zhong" means a human being's Zhong is located here. Mother Earth's Zhong is also located here.

天中道中 Tian Zhong Dao Zhong

"Tian" means Heaven. Dao is the Source or Ultimate Creator. "Tian Zhong Dao Zhong" means that this Zhong is also the Zhong of Heaven and Tao.

中中道空空 Zhong Zhong Dao Kong Kong

"Kong" means emptiness. "Zhong Zhong Dao Kong Kong" means core, core, Tao, emptiness, emptiness, which are all Tao Source.

Sacred wisdom

抱元守一 Bao Yuan Shou Yi

Yuan includes Yuan Shen, Yuan Qi, and Yuan Jing. "Bao Yuan Shou Yi" means hold your Yuan Shen, Yuan Qi, and Yuan Jing, which are Tao. Focus on Oneness, which is also Tao. In fact, Bao Yuan Shou Yi is to hold Tao and focus on One.

天一真水 Tian Yi Zhen Shui

"Tian" means *Heaven*. "Yi" means *Oneness*. "Zhen" means *sacred*. "Shui" means *liquid* or *water*. "Tian Yi Zhen Shui" means *Heaven's Oneness sacred liquid*. This liquid falls from Heaven into the seventh Soul House (Bai Hui acupuncture point at the crown), and then goes into the brain and mouth.

金津玉液 Jin Jin Yu Ye

The first "Jin" in this phrase means *golden*. The second "Jin" is a different Chinese character that means *liquid*. "Yu" means *jade*. "Ye" is another character for *liquid*. "Jin Jin Yu Ye" means *golden and jade liquid*, which implies that the liquid is invaluable. This sacred liquid comes from Mother Earth. It goes up through the Yong Quan acupuncture points on the soles of the feet, the legs, the central meridian, and finally up to the salivary glands.

咽入丹田 Yan Ru Dan Tian

"Yan" means swallow. "Ru" means to go into. "Dan Tian" refers to the Lower Dan Tian. "Yan Ru Dan Tian" means swallow Tian Yi Zhen Shui (Heaven's Oneness sacred liquid) and Jin Jin Yu Ye (Mother Earth's sacred liquid) into the Lower Dan Tian.

神氣精合一 Shen Qi Jing He Yi

Shen includes soul, heart, and mind. "Qi" means energy. "Jing" means matter. "He" means join as. "Yi" means one. "Shen Qi Jing He Yi" means soul, heart, mind, energy, and matter join as one.

天地人合一 Tian Di Ren He Yi

"Tian" means Heaven. "Di" means Mother Earth. "Ren" means human being. "He" means join as. "Yi" means one. "Tian Di Ren He Yi" means Heaven's, Mother Earth's, and human being's Shen Qi Jing join as one.

金丹形成 Jin Dan Xing Cheng

"Jin Dan" means *golden light ball*. "Xing Cheng" means *formed*. A normal human being does not have a Jin Dan. Only a Tao practitioner can form a Jin Dan in the body through sacred spiritual practice. If you have followed my teachings in this book and have been practicing seriously, you may very well have already formed a Jin Dan in your lower abdomen.

Sacred wisdom

抱元守一 Bao Yuan Shou Yi Hold Tao, focus on One.

舌抵上顎 She Di Shang E

"She" means tongue. "Di" means touch. "Shang E" means palate. "She Di Shang E" means hold the tip of your tongue to the roof of your mouth. The sacred wisdom within this phrase and practice is that it connects two major meridians, the Ren meridian (任脈) and the Du meridian (昏脈). The Ren meridian, or Conception Vessel, runs up the center line of the front of the body. It is the conception vessel of all the major Yin meridians, including the liver, heart, spleen, lung, kidney, and pericardium meridians. The Du meridian, or Governing Vessel, runs along the center of the back, following the path of the spinal cord up from the tailbone area to the top of the head, and then ends inside the mouth. The Du meridian governs the major Yang meridians, including the gallbladder, small intestine, stomach, large

intestine, urinary bladder, and San Jiao meridians. The San Jiao is the pathway of Qi and bodily fluid. It is divided into Lower Jiao (space from pelvic floor up to the level of the navel), Middle Jiao (space from level of navel up to the diaphragm), and Upper Jiao (space above the diaphragm). When the tip of the tongue touches the palate, it connects the Ren meridian and Du meridian, promoting the flow of energy and bodily fluid through the Ren Du meridians. To promote Qi flow and blood flow in the Yin and Yang meridians is to balance Yin and Yang, which is the most important five-thousand-year-old principle of healing in traditional Chinese medicine. This is a major sacred practice for the Tao journey.

咽津不斷 Yan Jin Bu Duan

"Yan" means swallow. "Jin" includes Tian Yi Zhen Shui and Jin Jin Yu Ye, Heaven's and Mother Earth's sacred liquids, respectively. "Bu Duan" means nonstop. "Yan Jin Bu Duan" means swallow Tian Yi Zhen Shui and Jin Jin Yu Ye nonstop. These liquids are not the normal saliva of the human body. You can only receive Heaven's sacred liquid (Tian Yi Zhen Shui) and Mother Earth's sacred liquid (Jin Jin Yu Ye) through sacred spiritual practices. They are the sacred essential ingredients to form and grow the Jin Dan. Jin Dan is a golden light ball. Growing this Jin Dan is the Tao journey. The size of the Jin Dan represents the achievements of one's Tao journey.

金丹壯大 Jin Dan Zhuang Da

"Zhuang Da" means to expand. "Jin Dan Zhuang Da" means the golden light ball expands and becomes stronger.

"Bei Dou" means the Big Dipper (figure 21). "Qi" means seven. "Xing" means star. "Bei Dou Qi Xing He Yi" means the Shen Qi Jing of the seven stars in the Big Dipper join as one. The Big Dipper consists of seven bright stars. In sacred spiritual wisdom, the Big Dipper is Heaven's spiritual temple. 


Figure 22. Five Elements
