# The Birds of Eastern Ecuador

## VOLUME II: *The Lowlands*

### Introduction

This final publication by John V. Moore Nature Recordings of the bird vocalizations from the various life zones in Ecuador culminates over 15 years of work, commencing with the publication of the 80-minute cassette *Sounds of La Selva* in 1993. Since that time much has changed for the better in all aspects of birding in Ecuador. For the recordist and publisher of bird vocalizations, equipment has gone from reel to reel recorders to cassette recorders, to DAT machines, to Minidiscs, and now to many solid state recorders. Publishing medium has progressed from cassettes to CDs and now to MP3 and DVD discs and flash cards, with more advances following at a rapid pace. Many, many recordings are now available online through such sites as Cornell Laboratory of Ornithology's Macaulay Library (<http://animalbehaviorarchive.org/loginPublic.do>) and xeno-canto America (<http://www.xeno-canto.org/>). Indeed, almost 13% of the recordings presented herein are from sources other than the co-authors' personal collections. In the future, it is probable that publications of this type will be presented solely on the internet. However, for the time being, we are proud to offer this type of publication.

### Recording Information

This audio publication includes sounds of nearly all the birds typically found in the Amazonian lowlands of Ecuador. Not covered are some of those species and

subspecies that are more common in other areas of Ecuador and are already included in previous publications, pertaining to other life zones in Ecuador, by John V. Moore Nature Recordings (see reverse of back cover). This publication is meant to replace and greatly expand upon the 5 cassettes currently offered for sale, which specifically cover Ecuador's eastern lowlands. These cassettes are: John V. Moore's *Sounds of La Selva, Ecuador, More Bird Vocalizations from the Lowland Rainforest*, Vol. 1, Vol. 2, and Vol. 3; and English and Parker's *Birds of Eastern Ecuador*.

The assignment of species to the different publications on Ecuadorian birds produced by John V. Moore Nature Recordings is based on our best judgment on the life zone in which they are most widespread/numerous, on the frequency with which the bird is heard in each region covered, and on facilitating the listener in comparing syntopic species on the same publication. The present publication consists of two separate discs, both with the recordings in MP3 format, and also includes an extensive booklet with the recording information for each vocalization presented. One disc can be played on MP3-compatible CD players or MP3 players and has cuts announced in English, with each track containing a single file with all vocalizations of the species in one cut. The other disc is a data DVD containing a separate file for each individual vocalization, no announcement, and the files are labeled with the scientific name of the species and the type of vocalization. Both discs also include a PDF copy of the booklet and an Excel file with the recording information, which facilitates the transfer of the data into multimedia organizing software, such as iTunes.

The goal of this publication is to achieve a high degree of completeness, including not only songs but also a wide variety of call types and even some of the more diagnostic mechanical noises (drumming, bill clapping, wing noises, etc.) as well as several examples of the same type of vocalization, in order to demonstrate the range of variation. Such completeness could be reached only by including cuts

made by a large number of recordists (sixty in all), who generously put their recordings at our disposal. We thus proudly present 2317 separate sound recordings for the 564 species that are included. We believe that all the commonly heard vocalizations are covered for most species, but do realize that such a collection can never be complete, and urge ornithologists and bird enthusiasts to continue recording bird sounds whenever they have the opportunity to do so. For some species the available sound material is still surprisingly limited, and for a few we could find none at all. Some of the species for which we could find no recordings might not give audible vocalizations (vultures, coquettes, thorntails), whereas others, such as Capped Heron (*Pilherodius pileatus*), Wavy-breasted Parakeet (*Pyrrhura peruviana*), Little Ground-Tyrant (*Muscisaxicola fluvialis*), and Bare-necked Fruitcrow (*Gymnoderus foetidus*), undoubtedly do. We also could not find any recordings of the subspecies *buckleyi* of Black-crowned Tityra (*Tityra inquisitor*). Except for one species, Rufous-vented Ground-Cuckoo (*Neomorphus geoffroyi*), we have only included recordings of the subspecies occurring in lowland eastern Ecuador, and for most true songbirds (oscines) and hummingbirds, in which local dialects may occur, we have only included recordings made in eastern Ecuador or the immediate vicinity.

The Ecuadorian Amazon holds no major barriers for forest birds. The Aguarico river and especially the Napo river form the distributional boundaries for some birds of poor flight and mark the replacement of some closely related species, but the lack of subspecific differentiation across them suggests that these rivers have not functioned as lasting major barriers during recent geological times. We have identified each cut to subspecies level, but for most resident birds only one subspecies occurs in lowland eastern Ecuador. We suspect that the major exception, Long-winged Antwren (*Myrmotherula longipennis*), which has two distinct forms replacing each other across the Aguarico, is better ranked as two species, and we

have therefore presented them under different headings. Over eight species have different subspecies in the foothills and the lowlands of eastern Ecuador (vocalizations of the foothill forms are presented in Vol. 1 of this series). We suspect that at least some of these are also better ranked as two species, notably Strong-billed Woodcreeper (*Xiphocolaptes promeropirhynchus*), Blackish Antbird (*Cercomacra nigrescens*), Dusky-capped Flycatcher (*Myiarchus tuberculifer*), White-crowned Manakin (*Dixiphia pipra*), and Thrush-like Schiffornis (*Schiffornis turdina*). The Long-tailed Woodcreeper (*Deconychura longicauda*) also differs vocally between foothills and lowland Amazonia, but the foothill form remains unnamed. A special case is that of the Spot-backed Antbird (*Hylophylax naevius*), which in lowland eastern Ecuador appears to be composed of two sympatric species with different vocalizations, one occurring in flooded forest (*varzea*), the other in *terra firme* forest, the two sometimes occurring within earshot of each other. Finally, we present recordings suggesting that Great-billed Hermit (*Phaethornis malaris*) might vocalize differently north and south of the Napo.

The habitats of the Ecuadorian Amazon include forests of various types (such as *várzea* and *terra firme*), clearings, black and white water lakes and rivers, and islands. All of them are humid, except for temporary river islands, which are often so hot that they are nearly savanna-like. Within each of these habitats, a very large number of bird species occur that have coexisted for extended periods of time. Several habitats may form intricate mosaics, and in such places the number of wide-ranging resident bird species that may be found within a small area is breathtaking and unsurpassed.

For the oscine and suboscine passerines we have usually attempted to arrange each species' vocalizations in a sequence beginning with a "dawn song" as described below, but usually a territorial song, and followed by other song types (e.g., display song, flight song, etc.), territorial calls, flight calls, and other vocalizations. Thus, a species' most commonly heard vocalization may not necessarily

be the first example given. Most recordings were made under natural conditions; if not, the text specifically states so. Several recordings have been considerably edited and filtered to reduce background noise and, at times, voices of other species or poor sections. In some cuts a poorly recorded phrase has been replaced by a similar phrase from elsewhere in the same recording. Such cuts have been identified as 'edited'. Any cut with a modification of the time sequence of the vocalizations has also been identified as 'edited' or 'intervals shortened', depending on the case. For very short vocalizations, often given only once, we decided to repeat the cut and indicated this on the MP3 CD by announcing "again" before the repeated vocalization. In order to avoid abrupt unnatural changes in volume and soundscape, all cuts fade in at the beginning and out at the end. In a few cuts, a vocalization that was given at the end of the cut and was deemed important by the authors has been repeated using fade-in/out. We have also used fade-in/out within a single recording when the interval was so extended between vocalizations that the recording would be tediously long. And, lastly, on the data DVD we have used fade-in/out between repeated vocalizations where the announcement "again" has been omitted. There is no notation of these modifications in the booklet as it is evident from the recording.

The function of a bird sound is often difficult to assess without a thorough study of the species. In general, we have used the term 'song' for the more complex vocalizations that appear to have an advertising and usually also a territorial function, and the label 'call' for more simple vocalization types, some of which may also be territorial. Whenever possible we have used modifiers to describe the vocalizations. Most terms are self-explanatory and based on a subjective impression of the sound and the context in which it was given. They may be behavioral (e.g., 'countersinging pair', 'foraging call', 'call of a perched bird', 'flight call', 'bill snapping', 'wing clapping') or functional (e.g., 'territorial song', 'display song',

'alarm call', 'contact call'). Sometimes they just describe the sound structure (e.g., 'single-noted call', 'double-noted call') or the sound type (e.g., 'scold', 'drum', 'rattle'). The term 'dawn song' is used only for song types given by some species (many tyrant-flycatchers and some tanagers) at early dawn (only occasionally during the day and sometimes at dusk) and which differ from songs given at other times of the day. When this type of song is present, it is given as the first vocalization. An incomplete or less complex song is labeled 'subsong'. We have used the term 'duet' only for simultaneously singing pairs or family groups. The phrase 'countersinging' is used for the song of a bird or a pair interacting with a bird or a pair in an adjacent territory.

The listener should be aware that this publication contains a number of high frequency vocalizations, and it may be difficult for those with even moderate hearing limitations to hear the entire frequency range of these sounds. Other ('background') species heard in the recordings are verbally announced only if we felt that not doing so would cause the listener to experience real confusion as to which vocalization belongs to the principal species. In the booklet, however, we have tried to identify most of the clearly audible species vocalizing in the background. A question mark after a bird's name indicates doubts about the identification. We encourage the users to draw our attention to any potential misidentifications. Comments should be sent to John V. Moore Nature Recordings (addresses stated on the back cover).

In the list of recordings below we have included the English, scientific (including subspecies), and Spanish names. For monotypic species the scientific name in the heading consists of only two parts. If only one subspecies occurs in the area covered, the subspecies name is given in the main heading. If there is more than one subspecies in the region, we state the subspecies before each block of recordings.

The recording information of each particular cut begins with the initials of the recordist and is followed by the date, a locality code that identifies the site where the recording was made, the Province/Department/State and, when not recorded in Ecuador, the country, and lastly the altitude. Then follow the type of vocalization, species vocalizing in the background, and any studio modifications (other than noise reduction) that we made to the original recording. Finally, for some recordings, the public library catalogue number is given. The two libraries used are LNS (Macaulay Library, Cornell Lab of Ornithology) and XC (Xenocanto). Where appropriate additional information is given above or below the text for all the recordings of a species. For taxonomy, sequence, and bird names, we largely follow *The Birds of Ecuador* by Ridgely and Greenfield (2001). However, where appropriate, Spanish names were adapted to *Aves del Ecuador: Guía de Campo* (2006) by the same authors and scientific names to *A Classification of the Bird Species of South America*, which is periodically updated and published online by the South American Checklist Committee (SACC) and the American Ornithologists' Union (AOU) (Remsen *et al.* 2008: <http://www.museum.lsu.edu/~Remsen/SACCBaseline02.html>). In case of differences between the aforementioned authors or between them and del Hoyo, Elliott, and Sargatal/Christie (eds.) (1992-) *Handbook of the Birds of the World* or Schulenberg *et al.* (2007) *Birds of Peru*, regarding the taxonomic status of particular species and/or their English names, we give both in the booklet text and also in the corresponding indices.

This publication consists of: 1) a CD containing all vocalizations in MP3 format, announced in English, with each track containing a single file of all vocalizations for each species, and 2) a data DVD containing a separate MP3 file for each individual vocalization without announcements. Also included is a comprehensive booklet in both digital (PDF and Excel) and hard copy format, containing recording information for each cut. This publication is meant to replace and greatly expand upon the 5 cassettes currently offered for sale which specifically cover bird vocalizations of Ecuador's eastern lowlands.

We present 2317 separate sound recordings of 564 species. Included are the sounds of nearly all the birds predominantly inhabiting the life zones of Ecuador's eastern lowlands. The habitats of these lowlands include forests of various types (such as várzea and terra firme), clearings, black and white water lakes and rivers, and islands. Our goal is to achieve a high degree of completeness, not only including song repertoires but also a wide variety of calls and mechanical sounds for each species. This publication is the final part of a series that covers bird vocalizations from all major life zones in Ecuador, a country with one of the richest avifaunas in the world.
