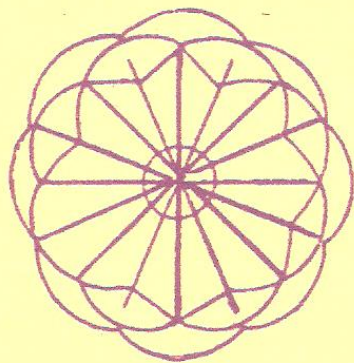

## The Voodoo Religion

Voodoo, Vodun, Voudoun are different spellings of what is one of the world's more exotic religions. For the sake of clarity, it is referred to in this handbook as 'Voodoo'. Voodoo combines certain aspects of both 'religion' and 'magic' as such terms are commonly understood and accepted. However, the believer in Voodoo does not differentiate. All aspects are part of the whole.

As with a majority of religions, Voodoo varies in many details depending on locale and country. The Voodoo of Haiti is exceedingly complex and difficult to fully comprehend. Its rituals are based on an intricate series of premises involving man, soul, and many divinities.

There is no church hierarchy, no official written liturgy, and this naturally results in the variations. Voodoo, to a great extent has been perpetuated by word of mouth, and this has contributed to the many interpretations.

With a few exceptions, Voodoo as practiced in the United States, is an offshoot of the original. American Voodoo is based primarily on the 'magical' aspects of this unusual religion. However, one of the basic principles of Voodoo holds true regardless of how applied. This basic principle is the belief that certain actions, call them rituals, spells, or whatever, will cause favorable results as desired by the practitioner.



Veve of Simbi, Patron of Magicians. Carried for power with spells.



Veve of Erzulie, Goddess of Love. Carried for success in all affairs of the heart.



Veve of Damballah. Supreme god. Kept on hand for power in Voodoo rituals.



Veve of Legba, God of the Crossroad. All prayers need the help of his symbol.

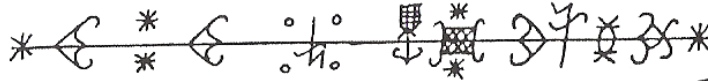
### Talismans, Charms, Amulets, Veves

The Voodooist will use any of these in order to promote chances for protection and success. A veve is a Voodoo symbol representing any of the loa (Voodoo divinities). A veve can be engraved, drawn, painted, or outlined with flour or other powders. Each loa has its own distinctive veve. Some of the more important ones are shown. Veves will vary since the designs are not strictly formalized. However, certain basic designs are included in each regardless of the background and training of the Voodooist who fashions it. Veves will be drawn on parchment, or engraved on rings and medallions to serve as good luck, power, and protective talismans.

In addition to the veves, a Voodooist will use talismans, charms, and amulets derived from almost any other religion. Especially important are Catholic statues, tiny or large. Pictures representing various saints are in great demand since they will be placed on the altar to be prayed to. The cross is carried for good luck, and the Bible will be kept on or near the altar since it is the Voodoo great conjure book and thought to bring success to any ritual. Pendants, rings, seals bearing occult designs are treasured charms.

**Voodoo 'GARDE', A Talisman For Protection**

A bocor is a practitioner of magic, and his magic is usually a form of witchcraft or black magic. To protect the innocent against the bocor's charms and spells, sometimes a Voodoo talisman or 'garde' is prepared as shown below. It can be drawn and printed on parchment paper or animal parchment. It is believed to be a very powerful form of protection against evil, and copies are kept both in the home and on the person.

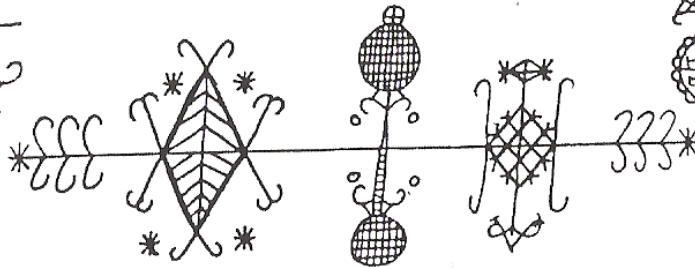

**Use Of Obeah Stick Or Staff Of Moses**

There are two forms of Obeah sticks, both being symbols of power. One is a carved staff have a snake-like groove encircling it. The other, which is far more expensive to procure, is a staff having a raised snake carved from its top to bottom. This latter staff is called a "Staff Of Moses" Obeah stick. A Voodoo priest will have at least one kind of Obeah stick to perform hexings and crossings with. The staff is anointed with Power oil to dress it. To put a spell on someone, the staff is pointed directly at the person, and whatever spell is desired, is spoken aloud.

## DICTIONARY OF CANDLES USED IN VOODOO RITUALS

Candleburning is an integral part of the Voodoo religion as it is used in countless rituals. The use of fire in worship and religion can be traced back to the beginnings of man. The Bible has many references to it. Fire has been used to protect, benefit, drive off evil, bring good fortune, and for many other purposes. The most convenient way to use fire in such manner is to light the proper candle. The following list gives beliefs but it should be remembered that as with other religious agents such as oils and powders, herbs, etc., no list of this kind can ever be complete as to beliefs ascribed. We are dealing with religion and magic intertwined and beliefs vary depending on time, locale, environment, and many other factors. For instance, a blue candle may be used for good or evil. This is true of all colors. There is a generally accepted system of symbolism, but within the system will be found many variations. Candle color and sometimes the shape of the candle together with intent and prescribed ritual determine which candle is used. What this all adds up to is that there is no one and only one proper way to use candles in rituals. It is the ritual and purpose that is most important; and it is the belief in them that leads some persons to religiously observe them. It finally comes down to personal preference, and naturally differences are great. There is one universal similarity about candleburning: Regardless whether burned for alleged supernatural powers, as symbolic religious offerings found in countless churches, or simply for personal enjoyment, candleburning is practiced around the globe by almost all peoples.

**NOTE:** All Voodoo candleburning includes use of anointing oils. Such oils are either similar in name, or are symbolic of the intent or purpose. Often more than one oil is used. This is a matter of personal preference except for exacting rituals which specify precisely what is required. In the following candle list, the first oil named is commonly used, the others are optional and meant to add additional power to the ritual. Candles should be anointed with the oil rubbed on from the center towards the top, and then from the center to the bottom. This is the accepted method except in a few rare cases where a ritual will call for a different method.

A Voodoo candle is always allowed to burn to the socket except in specific instances where a special type of candle is snuffed out and re-used. The Dictionary lists the exceptions.

### HOW TO CONDUCT A CANDLE RITUAL

There are many ways to use candles in Voodoo rituals. The famous book "Master Book Of Candleburning" contains numerous rituals designed to cope with life's problems. These rituals require various candles and oils, and certain methods of anointing, burning, and moving of the candles to different positions. The instructions are easy to understand and follow.

In addition, there are rituals that require only one candle and an oil or two. These are the rituals that are listed here. The candle needed is anointed as shown above, and is then burned completely. It is considered best done after sunset in most instances. This is an offering and a prayer that your need be filled. It can be repeated as often as felt necessary.

It also can be done in addition to any other rituals that may be performed. It is believed that a double force of power may thus be created.

The following **DICTIONARY OF CANDLES** lists beliefs of religious, mythological, and legendary derivation; all connected with present-day Voodooism. This is a presentation of beliefs as factually accepted by Voodooists.

**ASTRAL or BIRTHMONTH Candles.** *These candles are said to give off vibrations that are harmonious with personal vibrations. They are believed to be very powerful in bringing success to any ritual. Each candle is a combination of colors astrologically assigned and attuned to each of the Zodiac signs and those born under them. The historically accepted colors are:*

**AQUARIUS**, Jan.20 - Feb.18 *Blue, Pink, Green*  
**PICES**, Feb.19 - March 20 *White, Pink, Green, Black*  
**ARIES**, March 21 - April 19 *White, Rose Pink*  
**TAURUS**, April 20 - May 20 *Red, Lemon Yellow*  
**GEMINI**, May 21 - June 21 *Red, Light Blue*  
**CANCER**, June 21 - July 23 *Green, Brown*  
**LEO**, July 24 - Aug.22 *Red, Green*  
**VIRGO**, Aug.23 - Sept.21 *Gold, Black, Blue*  
**LIBRA**, Sept.22 - Oct.21 *Black, Red, Blue*  
**SCORPIO**, Oct.22 - Nov.21 *Brown, Black*  
**SAGITTARIUS**, Nov.21 - Dec.20 *Gold, Red, Green*  
**CAPRICORN**, Dec.21 - Jan.19 *White Pink Emerald Black*

*ASTRAL candles are anointed with Zodiac oil or individual birthmonth oil.*

### DICTIONARY OF CANDLES USED IN VODOO RITUALS

- A ALTAR Candle.** *An important offeratory candle used with any ritual. Use Altar or Hi-Altar oil.*  
**ALL SPICE Candle.** *Burn to increase will power. Use Crucible Of Courage oil.*  
**ALL PURPOSE Candle.** *For gaining help of beneficial forces and spirits. Burn at any ritual or alone. Use Spirit oil.*
- B BAPHOMET or SATAN'S RAM Candle.** *Seldom burned. It is important to High Priest and High Priestess as a symbol of their power and position. Kept in prominent place during rituals. Burned only when extreme conditions require all possible power for success of ritual.*  
**BENEFICIAL DREAM Candle.** *For fortunate prophetic dreams. Use Beneficial Dream oil, Success oil.*  
**BLACK ART Candle.** *For Black Magic, hexing, crossing, witchcraft. Use Black Art oil, Inflammatory Confusion oil, Jinx oil.*  
**BLACK CAT Candle.** *For gaining good luck. Use Success oil.*  
**BLACK CAT on SKULL Candle.** *Very powerful for breaking curses, hexes, defeating bad luck. Use Uncrossing oil, Commanding oil.*  
**BLACK HEXING Candle.** *For placing a powerful hex on someone. Use Hell's Devil oil.*  
**BLACK WAX Candle.** *Use in any hexing ritual. Use Jinx oil, Crossing oil, Hell's Devil oil.*  
**BLESSING Candle.** *To bring spirits' help and success. Use Spirits Guide oil.*

- C** **COILED SNAKE Candle**..For powerful protection from all evil. Use Controlling oil, Conquering Glory oil.
- COMMANDING Candle**..Forces others to your will. Use Commanding oil.

- CONCENTRATION Candle**..Burn before start of other rituals to improve concentration on intent. Use Acacia oil.

- CONQUERING GLORY Candle**..To gain power over anyone. Use Conquering Glory oil.
- CRESCENT Candle**..Very powerful for attracting good fortune and help. Use Holy oil, High John Conqueror oil.
- CROSS with SNAKE Candle**..One of very strongest candles used to send a hex or curse back to enemy who is cause of it. Use XX Doublecross oil.
- CROSSING Candle**..To cross or hex someone. Use Jinx oil, Crossing oil, Confusion oil.
- CROWN of SUCCESS Candle**..For gaining success for any purpose. Use Crown of Success oil.
- CRUCIBLE of COURAGE Candle**..Overcoming fears, gain courage and prosperity. Use Crucible Of Courage oil.
- 11** **DEVIL'S Candle**..For hexes, crossing, witchcraft. Use Black Art oil, Jinx oil, Black Devil oil.
- DEVIL'S HEAD Candle**..Use like Devil's candle, but said to be far more effective. Also used to attract help of Satan, the master Voodoo conjurer. Use Essence Of Bend Over oil, Flaming Power oil, Power oil.
- DEVOTIONAL Candle**..An offering for spiritual help. Use St. Michael oil, Angel oil, Altar oil.
- DOMINATION Candle**..For bending others to your will. Use Domination oil, Master oil.
- DOUBLE CROSS Candle**..For strong hexing and crossing. Use Crossing Oil, Babel Oil, American Voodoo oil.
- DRAGON BLOOD Candle**..Defeats curses, hexes, crossed conditions. Burn at midnight using Dragon Blood oil.
- DRAW BACK Candle**..To bring back a lost love or unfaithful mate. Use Come To Me oil, Fire Of Love oil.
- DRIVE AWAY Candle**..To be rid of bad luck and enemies.. Use Four Thieves Vinegar oil.
- F** **FAST LUCK Candle**..To gain good luck quickly. Use Fast Luck oil, Wealthy Way oil, Money oil.
- FIERY WALL OF PROTECTION Candle**..For stopping hexes, crossed conditions, bad vibrations, slander and gossip. Use Fiery Wall of Protection oil.
- FIRE OF LOVE Candle**..To win love, increase desire. Use Fire of Love oil, Caliphs Beloved oil.
- FLAMING POWER Candle**..For success in any endeavor and gain fearless confidence. Use Flaming Power oil.
- FOUR LEAF CLOVER Candle**..Extremely powerful in getting good luck. Burn an hour a day for seven days. Use Special Favor oil, Magnet oil.
- G** **GLOW OF ATTRACTION Candle**..To attract money, good fortune, love, success. Use Glow Of Attraction oil.
- GOAT Candle**..For success in hexing and invoking the help of the Master Voodoo Conjurer. Use Black Art oil. This candle can be used at sixteen rituals before discarded. It is said to have no power thereafter.

- II HI-ALTAR Candle**..Used only with other candles to bring success to any ritual. It is a very important offeratory candle seeking aid of Voodoo gods. Use Hi-Altar oil.
- HIGH CONQUERING Candle**..For success of any type.Use Hi-Conquering oil, Success oil, High John Conqueror oil.
- HORSESHOE Candle**..Said to be one of most powerful candles for gaining money and good luck. Burned thirty minutes each day until consumed. Use Easy Life oil.
- HUMAN SKELETON Candle**..For curing illnesses. Use Radiant Health oil. Burned an hour per day during daylight only, once a week for seven weeks.
- HUMAN SKULL Candle**..For revenge and redressing a wrong. Also used to send back an evil spell. Refer to Skull Candle Hex Spell and Reverse Hex Skull Candle Spell.
- I INFLAMMATORY CONFUSION Candle**..To break hexes, send back hexes, confuse enemies. Use Inflammatory Confusion oil, Crossing oil, Jinx oil.
- LADY LUCK Candle**..For luck in gambling. Use Lady Luck oil, Gamblers oil.
- LOVE Candle**..For gaining and keeping love. Use Love Me oil, Luv Luv Luv oil, Musk oil.
- LUCKY HAND Candle**..Most powerful of all luck-bringing candles. Burned half an hour before and after sunset at least twice a week. Use Lucky Planet oil, Fast Luck oil.
- LUCKY JOHN The CONQUEROR Candle**.. One of Voodoo's most popular candles burned for good fortune in love, gambling, money affairs. Use High John Conqueror oil.
- M MAGNET Candle**..For drawing good fortune. Use Magnet oil mixed with 'Magnetic Sand' or lodestone dust.
- MONEY Candle**..To obtain more money. Use Money Drawing oil, Fast luck oil.
- MUMMY Candle**..For strong powers and success.Refer to Mummy Candle Spell for full details.
- MUSK Candle**..Said to be very effective in gaining love. Use Musk oil, Civit oil, Ambergris oil.
- N NINE DAY Candle**..An offering to Voodoo gods for their help. Burn with any ritual an hour each time. Throw away after nine days. Use Blessing oil, Spirit oil.
- O OWL Candle**..Believed to be one of most powerful Voodoo aids for obtaining power over others. Burned only at night. Used for seven nights in a row. Use Power oil, Voodoo oil.
- P PEACE Candle**..For a tranquil, peaceful life. Use Number 20 oil, Guinea P oil.
- PEACEFUL HOME Candle**..To save marriages,bring tranquility to home. Use Watre Notre Dame oil.
- PINE WAX Candle**..To gain good luck and affection. Use Fast Luck oil, Lovers oil.
- POWER Candle**..For obtaining command over others. Use Power oil, Commanding oil, Compelling oil.
- PROSPERITY Candle**..To obtain much good fortune. Use Crown Of Success oil, Money Drawing oil.
- R RADIANT HEALTH Candle**..For curing illness, gaining good health. Use Healing oil.
- RED ROSE Candle**..For gaining love. Use Lovers oil, Fire Of Love oil.
- REVELATION Candle**..To gain spiritualistic and prophetic powers. Use Spirits Guide oil, Magnet oil.
- REVERSIBLE BLACK Candle**, also known as **DOUBLE ACTION REVERSIBLE BLACK Candle**..Sends back hexes and crossed conditions onto the enemy. Use Crossing oil, H & H oil.

- RED WITCH Candle.**.. To obtain love. For complete Red Witch Spell ritual, see following page.
- ROSEMARY Candle.**.. For friendship and stopping bad feelings. Use Rosemary oil, Peace oil.
- S SACRED NOVENA Candle.**.. Use like Nine Day candle.
- SATAN BE GONE Candle.**.. For breaking and defeating hexes, curses, crossings. Use Uncrossing oil and burn Jinx Removing incense.
- SEVEN HOLY SPIRIT Candle.**.. To gain spirits and Voodoo gods help. Use Spirit oil and burn while taking a bath with Seven Holy Spirits Bath oil added to bath water.
- SKULL and CROSSBONES Candle.**.. Same as Human Skull Candle.
- SPARK OF SUSPICION Candle.**.. To arouse envy, jealousy, cause discord. Use Confusion oil, Jinx oil.
- SEVEN KNOB Candle.**.. To make wishes come true. Use King Solomon oil or Success oil. Make a wish and burn one knob only. This should be repeated until all knobs are gone.
- SATAN Candle.**.. Refer to Satan Candle Voodoo Rituals for full details.
- SPIRITUALISTS Candle.**.. To obtain great power for rituals. Use Spirits Guide oil, Power oil.
- STAR and CRESCENT Candle.**.. Similar to Spiritualists Candle, but usually used only by Voodoo priest or priestess. It is used many times instead of burning all at one time. Snuff out at end of other ritual. Use Hindu Grass oil.
- STAR Candle.**.. Use like Star and Crescent Candle.
- STAY HOME Candle.**.. To keep mate or lover faithful. Use Zodiac oil, Crown of Success oil.
- T TRIPLE ACTION Candle.**.. For defeating hexes, crossings, witchcraft. Use Uncrossing oil, Voodoo Night oil.
- U UNCROSSING OIL.**.. To end crossings, hexing. Use Uncrossing oil.
- V VAN VAN Candle.**.. For luck and power of all kinds. Use Van Van oil.
- VENUS Candle.**.. To arouse love and desire. Use Venus oil, Lovers oil.
- VOODOO NIGHT Candle.**.. For Voodoo success. Burn at any Voodoo ritual. Use Voodoo Night oil.
- VOODOO Candle.**.. Similar to Voodoo Night Candle. Use American Voodoo oil.
- W WEALTHY WAY Candle.**.. To attract large amounts of money. Use Wealthy Way oil.
- WEED OF MISFORTUNE Candle.**.. To overcome enemies, change luck, cause trouble and confusion. Use Confusion oil, Domination oil.
- WHITE HEX BREAKER Candle.**.. For breaking hexes. Use Fiery Wall Of Protection oil.
- WHITE ROSE Candle.**.. To have peace of mind, eliminate troubles. Use White Rose oil.
- WORLD'S WONDER Candle.**.. For obtaining money, luck, treasure. Use Voodoo oil.
- WORMWOOD Candle.**.. To gain help of spirits of the dead. Use Spirits Guide oil.
- X XX DOUBLE CROSS Candle.**.. For very strong hexing or crossing write enemy's name on candle with sharp point. Use XX Doublecross oil, Flaming Power oil.

**Red Witch Candle Love Spell**

This ritual is for keeping love. Anoint a red candle shaped like a witch with Lovers, Cleo May, and Controlling oil. For further affect, burn Fire Of Love incense and light the candle after sunset. Say, *"Red Witch, Let this offering to you bring my lover (insert lover's name) to me alone, and for evermore"*. Burn the candle for at least ten minutes. Repeat the ritual following evenings until love is secure.

**Stay Home Powder Spell**

The simplest way to use this powder to keep a wandering mate at home is to sprinkle it on his or her clothes. In case this does not seem adequate, a further ritual is resorted to. Every night, for seven nights, bathe before retiring, and anoint the body with the Stay Home powder. Only a small amount is used. On the eighth night bathe and powder again and write these words on a piece of paper: SATOR AREPO TENET OPERA ROTAS. This paper is kept under the pillow.

**Invocation To Erzulie For Love**

Erzulie is the Voodoo Goddess of Love. Her aid is sought for help with any type of love problem. Her veve must be kept near the heart. It can be drawn on parchment or engraved on metal. This veve is shown elsewhere in this handbook. Basil is sprinkled on one's food and before eating, recite, *"Mistress Erzulie, I give you to eat with the left hand. It is with the left hand because you are of the Invisibles"*. This is followed by a statement of just what help is wanted such as making a mate or lover stay faithful, causing a lost love to return, making a person love you, and so forth. This ritual should be performed at least once a week until the problem is solved.

**Mummy Oil Spell**

Used to create a bad luck ouanga, also called wanga. It is mixed with salt and camphor, and a pinch of Goofer Dust. Wrap the mixture in black cloth or paper together name of the enemy written on red paper. Stick nine pins through the packet which seals it. Bury it in the enemy's yard or pathway.

**To Obtain Success**

Burn for one hour each day two candles, one Green and one Pink candle, side by side. Stand before the candles and recite the 23rd Psalm. When the hour is up, snuff out the candles. Dust your body with Jinx Removing powder and anoint your hands with Success oil daily. Add a half teaspoon of Dragon Blood Bath oil and ten drops of Glow Of Attraction oil to the bath water once a week. Continue this until success is achieved.

**To Get Rid Of Evil Spirits**

Starting at midnight, sprinkle Uncrossing powder all around the outside of the dwelling. Do this three nights in a row. On the third night, at any time of your choosing, burn a Reversible Black Wax candle for two hours. Repeat for thirty nights in a row or until at least three candles have been completely burned. In pocket or purse carry a white lodestone and a red lodestone. After the thirty nights, burn one Peace candle each night for three nights. This completes the ritual. Repeat at least once a year.

**Voodoo Charm Bags**

A charm bag is one of the most valued possessions a Voodooist can have. The items that can be put in a charm bag are beyond count, but they all have one thing in common. Each represents some magical or mystical force that its possessor feels will bring good fortune in many facets of life or is protective against ill fortune and the forces of evil. The following charm bags are examples that are considered to be of great strength. They can be made by anyone who can obtain the materials.

A...Burn a small amount of Sweet Basil to ashes. To the ashes add an equal amount of Graveyard Dust ( mullein or patchouli ) and mix well. To the mixture add enough Black Cat oil to make a thick paste. Put the paste into the hollow end of an animal horn or a replica of it. Fill the cavity with wax to seal it. Put a drop of Black Cat oil on each corner of a parchment Spirit seal, and one drop in its center. Rub the Black Cat oil on a miniature metal hand. Put the horn end, the seal, and the hand in a leather bag. This bag has an ancient history that says it conveys great powers to its owner.

B...A charm bag that contains a number of talismans and amulets, any of which could be carried alone, but together are considered to be of tremendous power.

A Sea Horse amulet...brings protection from the loa Agwe, plus peace and strength for life's problems.

A Caprelata...a charm scroll that is a protective charm against all evil as well as a bringer of good fortune. A caprelata is also known as a 'garde' and an example is shown on page 1-2.

A Sun stone amulet...brings the favor of Legba, God of the Crossroads. Brings protection from evil and answers to prayers since all prayers must be channelled through him.

A Jalap root ( High John the Conqueror root )...brings luck in love, gambling, health, and money affairs.

Tonka Bean Arret...Powerful love charm. This charm is a pierced Tonka Bean attached to a metal cross.

Seven Jobs Tears...these pearly gray seeds that look like teardrops are thought to have the power to answer prayers.

A Damballah talisman...to gain the benevolence and help of the supreme loa of Voodooism.

C...A charm bag to protect against hexes, crossings, curses, demons, and all other forms of evil. With Dove Blood red ink write the characters **•\*†oSY\*†•** on a small piece of sheepskin parchment. Sprinkle some Van Van oil on the parchment and then dust on Uncrossing powder. Put a small quantity of the powder in the palm of your hand and blow it to the East, West, North, and South. Put some myrtle leaves on the parchment and wrap it all in white new cloth. Use red thread to sew the parcel shut and place it in a small red flannel bag. Put the flannel bag in a leather charm bag. Keep in a safe place or carry it with you.

*A charm bag can hold anything its owner feels will be of help in the affairs of life. Roots, stones, talismans, herbs, seals are among the treasured contents. Some feel that a charm bag should be 'fed' from time to time. This means that it is anointed with an oil that is symbolic of its purpose and fumigated ( passed through ) with the smoke of incense. For instance, a charm bag symbolic of financial*

gain would have Money Drawing oil sprinkled in it, and it would be passed through the smoke of Prosperity incense. A charm bag of protective power would use Fiery Command oil and Uncrossing incense. Such oils and incenses are chosen as a matter of individual judgment as charm bags are a personal choice as to contents. Choose what seems most appropriate and most symbolic of the intent.

### The Best Gambling Hand

Drill a hole in a nutmeg and fill the hole with Mercury (also called quicksilver). Seal the hole with wax. Into a leather charm bag place a Green Iodestone, a Lucky Hand root, Silver Magnetic Sand, Gold Magnetic Sand, High John the Conqueror root, Devil Shoestring root and Five Finger Grass. On top of all these things place the Nutmeg. Sew the bag tightly shut. Sprinkle three drops of Jockey Club perfume on it once a week. Keep this bag with you whenever gambling and allow no one to touch it.

### To Gain Prosperity

A Marie Laveau nostrum: Place a Prosperity candle in your house, anoint it with King Solomon oil and burn it for one hour each day. Burn daily a small amount of a mixture of Good Luck incense and Helping Hand incense. Spray the house with Chinese Wash and apply Drawing powder to your neck and chest daily. Stay out of debt. Protect your income.

## DICTIONARY OF BOTANICALS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

Botanicals, meaning roots, herbs, barks, berries, and the other parts of plants, have been used for magical purposes since the dawn of man. The Bible makes many references to them, and legends regarding them abound in every culture. Voodoo attaches great powers to them. Each of the many botanicals listed has more than one magical power attributed to it. Since a large volume would be required to list them all, only the most prevalent and widely accepted beliefs have been chosen.

As with oils, powders, etc., the Voodooist is likely to use a number of roots and herbs in the attempt to magically gain his desire. The Voodooist believes that if one ritual is good, then more is that much better. As an example: A Voodooist may make and carry a charm bag for good luck, but he will not stop there. Candles, incenses, powders, and oils will also be utilized to further the chances for success.

As mentioned, the most popular beliefs are listed, but it should be kept in mind that the same herb or root may be used for good or evil depending on the user's belief and knowledge. Legends and beliefs regarding the plant world sometimes vary greatly, and one man's rose is another's poison. For instance, Mandrake is highly valued both as a love charm and for casting witchcraft spells that harm.

- A AARON'S ROD..Brewed in a tea to restore youth.
- ABSCESS Root..Brings help from Voodoo Gods.
- ACACIA Flowers..Burn for power and blessing.
- ADAM & Eve Roots..Powerful for love.Man carries Eve Root and woman carries Adam root.
- ADDER'S MOUTH..Stops slander. Cast upon enemy's doorsteps.

- AFRICAN GINGER**..Stops hexes, cures sore throats. For illness, used as a tea. For hex, kept in every room.
- AGRIMONY**..Burn to reverse spells and send them back.
- AGUE Root or Weed**..Burn to stop hexes and crossings.
- ALFALFA**..Burn to keep poverty away. Save the ashes.
- ALKANENT**..Burn to destroy evil and bring wealth.
- ALL HEAL**..For curing illness, burn as an incense, or make a tea and sprinkle around bedroom floor.
- ALOES**..Burn for love and scatter ashes outside.
- ANGELICA Root**..Make into tea and sprinkle in corners and entryways to purify and stop evil forces.
- ANGEL'S TURNIP**..Carry for good luck.
- ANISE**..Burn to increase Voodoo powers.
- ARCHANGEL**..Burn to bring lost love back to you.
- ARTEMISIA**..Also known as Southernwood. Do not confuse with Wormwood which is another type of the Artemisia family. This Artemisia is brewed and sprinkled to intensify love or to eliminate personal problems.
- ASAFOEIDA**..Burn to hex and increase Black Magic power, or carry in bag to defeat hexes. Considered one of most powerful of all magical materials.
- ASH LEAVES**..Burn to prevent hexes and witchcraft from harming you. Carry some for attracting love.
- B** **BALM**..Drink the tea for rejuvenation. Put in wine or food to make a love potion.
- BALM GILEAD BUDS**..Carry for protection against evil, and to solve love problems.
- BALMONEY**..Mix with hexing incenses and burn to cast a strong hex or crossing spell. Call out name of one to be hexed while lighting incense.
- BASIL**..Invokes aid of Voodoo Love Goddess Erzulie in love affairs. Very powerful. Sprinkle on food.
- BAY LEAVES**..Keep in home and on person as protection against any type of evil or sorcery.
- BAYBERRY ROOT**..Attracts good fortune and money. Burn a Bayberry candle and sprinkle Bayberry root in the flame.
- BERRY OF FISH**..Also known as Hockle Elderberry. It is never taken internally as it is a deadly poison. No longer available in U.S.A. Was said to be a love aid.
- BETEL NUT**..Increases mental and spiritual powers.
- BETH Root**..Used to attract mate by secretly mixing in to various foods.
- BENZOIN**..Burn with incenses and oils to bring peace of mind. Also defeats hexes and evil curses. Purifies.
- BENNET Root**..Used in a tea to cure illnesses.
- BERGAMOT**..Considered very powerful for success. It can be burned with any ritual for more power.
- BETONY**..Burn with Uncrossing Incense to defeat any form of witchcraft.
- BILBERRY**..Mix with Thyme to make a love tea said to inflame those who drink it.
- BISTORT**..Carry or burn to attract wealth.
- BITTERSWEET**..Said to be a strong aphrodisiac if taken as a tea once a day. If more is used it has no effect.
- BLACK CANDLE TOBACCO**..Mix with salt and burn with a black candle. Said to win court cases.
- BLACK COHOSH**..Make tea, add to bathwater. Protection from all harm. Helps potency in love life.
- BLACK HAW Bark**..Mix with Red Shanks to make a tea said to be a contraceptive.

- BLACK MUSTARD SEED.**..Causes disturbance and problems. Spread on doorsteps and pathways.
- BLACK SNAKEROOT.**..Drunk as a tea to restore sexual potency. Burn with any love spell.
- BLADDERWRACK.**..Carry for protection while traveling.
- BLAZING STAR Root.**..Bury in enemy's yard to cause mental derangement.
- BISHOPWORT.**..Put in bath water and bathe before rituals. Gives protection against outside evil witchcraft.
- BLOOD Root.**..A favorite Voodoo root for defeating hexes and spells. Carry on person in red bag as a charm, and burn some at least once a week.
- BLUE FLAG.**..Mix with Money Drawing Incense and burn for financial gain.
- BLUE VERVAIN.**..Used as a tea for quieting nerves. Carry some to attract love.
- BLUEBERRY LEAVES.**..Make a brew by soaking overnight. Throw on doorsteps for hexing.
- BOLDO Leaves.**..Sprinkle about premises to ward off evil.
- BROOM Tops.**..Make into a tea and sprinkle in front of every entryway and in all corners.Clears evil away.
- BUCHU Leaves.**..Used as a tea to make one able to foretell the future.
- BUCKEYE Nut.**..Carried as a charm against arthritis and rheumatism.
- BUCKTHORN Bark.**..Grants a wish if made into a tea which is sprinkled in a circle at time of a full moon.
- BURNET.**..Burn as an incense and pass Voodoo materials through the smoke to gain tremendous powers.
- C** **CALAMINT.**..Mix with incense to purify,remove evil.
- CALAMUS.**..Mix with Voodoo controlling mixtures.
- CARAWAY Seed.**..Carry for protection.
- CASCARA SAGRADA.**..Make a tea and sprinkle about premises before going to court. Wins cases.
- CARDAMON.**..For a love potion, powder the seeds in a mortar and add to food or drink.
- CAMPHOR.**..For prophetic dreams, mix Camphor with incense such as Rama Dream and burn before retiring.
- CAMPHIRE.**..Same as Camphor.
- CELERY SEED.**..Increases psychic and Voodoo powers. Burn with incense and powdered Orris root.
- CHAMOMILE,**also spelled Camomile. Make Into a tea and use in love potions and with gambling oils on the hands before betting or playing games of chance.
- CHEWING John Root.**..Chew the root and throw it away. Takes away a hex or crossing and sends it back. Also in powdered form it is burned for same purpose.
- CACTUS THORNS.**..Used to inflict injury by jabbing the thorns into a cloth or clay Voodoo doll.
- CARROT Root.**..Mix into food as a love potion. Dream of it means good luck and financial gain.
- CHICORY.**..Burn to cause a sure hex on someone.
- CINNAMON.**..Burn to make Voodoo room sacred. Add to wine or food as a love potion.
- CURRY POWDER.**..Burned to keep evil forces away.It is said to be one of most powerful aids of all.
- CUMIN or CUMMIN.**..Mixed with food or drink it keeps a lover faithful even though separated for long periods.

**CORIANDER**..For a strong love potion,powder and mix with food or drink.

**COWSLIP**..Place before entryways to turn away visitors.

**CLOVES**..Mix with Chicory and Cinquefoil and burn as an incense to increase mediumistic powers.

**CINQUEFOIL**..Refer to Cloves.

**CORNFLOWERS**..Brew tea, cool, and sprinkle around outside of home. Brings peace and harmony to marriage.

**COUCH GRASS**..See Witch Grass.

**CLOVER**..The four leaf variety bring good luck. Red clover is used in love potions. White Clover is used to uncross and defeat hexes.

**CRUEL MAN OF WOODS**..Carry to protect against all spells. Said to return spell back to creator of it.

**D DAMIANA**..Said to be an aphrodisiac and to draw love to those who drink it as a tea.

**DANDELION**..Carry to make wishes come true. The tea is said to induce clairvoyance.

**DEVIL'S BONE ROOT**..Cut into small pieces and carry in red bag to ward off arthritis.

**DEVIL'S SHOESTRING ROOT**..One of most famous Voodoo roots. Carry in red bag which is hung around neck at night for protection.Cut root into small pieces, put in small jar and fill with whiskey and camphor. Whenever power of any sort is needed, take out a piece of root and rub in hands. The root is carried in pocket or purse to draw luck. It is a gambler's lucky 'hand'.

**DILL**..Steep in hot wine for a love potion. Keep dill in home to repel witchcraft.

**DITTANY OF CRETE**..Said to make one of strongest of love potions. Mixed with food or drink to kindle the

**DEVIL'S BIT**..Keeps evil within a dwelling. Sprinkle outside all entryways.Prevents evil forces and hexes from leaving. Done only to enemies. Do not confuse with Devil's Shoestring which is also known as Cracca Virginiana. Devil's Bit is of the Scabiosa Succisa family of herbs.

**DOG ROSE**..Wrap in red bag, carry for protection and throwing back hexes. Mix with Chewing John for more power if necessary.

**DRAGON BLOOD Powdered**..Burn at midnight for seven nights to be rid of any bad spell. Burn near an open window to drive out the evil forces.

**DRAGON BLOOD REED**..A small solid piece of Dragon Blood that is carried in a red bag for luck. This is a Voodoo favorite.

**E EARTH SMOKE**..To attract quick financial gain, make into a tea and sprinkle all about outside of dwelling and rub on bottom of shoes. Repeat once a week.

**ENDIVE**..Same as Chicory.

**EGYPTIAN PARADISE Seed**..See Grains of Paradise.

**ERYNGO**..Also known as 'sea holly'. Add to food or drink as a love tonic. Carried by women to insure the love of a man.

**ELDER**..Strong protection against witchcraft. Keep in every room as this plant is hated by witches.

**EUCALYPTUS**..Hide under pillow for protection.

**ELECAMPANE**..Dry and mix with Vervain and Berries of Mistletoe to make the ancient 'True Love Powder'. Mix with food or drink.

**ELEMI.**..Mix with *Fiery Wall of Protection* and burn. It is one of strongest Voodoo protections against witchcraft, hexes, curses, and crossings.

**ELDER BERRIES.**..Grind into powder and put in each corner and on outside of doorways and windows for protection and eliminating troubles.

**F FERN.**..Keep near windows to defeat witchcraft. Mix with *Bay Leaves* for added strength.

**FENNEL SEED.**..Carry to prevent witchcraft. Also is used in love potions.

**FIVE FINGER GRASS.**..Wrap in red cloth and hang over bedstead to ward off any evil, or make a tea with it and bathe hands and forehead nine times to wash away any hexes or curses.

**FIVE FINGER ROOT.**..One of the most 'luck' roots in the world. Also known as 'Lucky Hand' root. Carry it always.

**FRANKINCENSE.**..Of strongest mystical power. Use with any ritual. Burn it pure or as an incense. Due to cost most users prefer the incense. Adds great power to any Voodoo work.

**FLAX.**..Used as a tea to increase powers of divination.

**G GALANGAL.**..Burn every night for fourteen nights before a court case. Save ashes in a chamois bag and take it to court. Makes for a favorable jury decision.

**GENTIAN.**..Add to bath in form of a tea. Brings love.

**GINSENG.**..Said to be a powerful aphrodisiac, and cure for many diseases. Also thought to prolong good health and longevity. Used in either powdered or solid root form which is chewed. Powder is added to food or drink.

**GINGER.**..Added to love potions for quick results.

**GARLIC.**..Kept on hand as protection from witchcraft. It is also burned with incense to clear evil away. Potent.

**GRAINS OF PARADISE.**..Used several ways; Put a picture of St. Peter at the front door and a picture of St. Michael at the back door. Put a bag of the Grains behind each picture to insure success. Carry the Grains in red bag for luck. As a love stimulant, add the Grains to food or drink. It is also called *Egyptian Paradise Seed*.

**GOLDEN BOUGH.**..Keep near or under bed to keep love.

**GRAVEL ROOT.**..Helps chances of getting job. Carry it in red bag.

**GROUND IVY.**..Burn with any hex or jinx incense to cast a spell against person named.

**GUINEA PEPPER.**..Cast upon doorsteps to break up homes. Burn to protect against conjure. Fed to saints for success. Use like *Grains of Paradise* with picture of saint desired.





**H HIGH JOHN THE CONQUEROR Root.**..Probably the most famous and popular of all Voodoo roots. Carried as a charm it is alleged to draw love, gambling luck, good health, and money. Usually kept in a red bag. It is also kept in a special oil which is rubbed on the hands to benefit from its vibratory powers.

**HOLY THISTLE.**..Brew as a tea which is sprinkled all about outside of dwelling to defeat all conjuring and to bring help of spirits.

**HEAL ALL Herb.**..Drink the tea for gambling luck.

**HEARTSEASE.**..Useful for a variety of illnesses. Chew it or secrete some on lover to increase affection.

- HAWTHORNE**..Any part may be used to purify Voodoo room and dwellings. Add in tea form to scrub water.
- HOUSELEEK**..Keep as near ceiling as possible as a defense against storms and lightning.
- HEMLOCK**..Tie together the herbs bark and parchment on which enemy's name is written. Keep in hidden dark place to place a spell on the one named.
- HOLY HERB**..Make into a tea and add to bath water for seven days. Believed to wash away illnesses and bring both protection and spiritual power.
- HOLY GHOST ROOT**..Prolongs life and protects against evil spirits and witchcraft. Drink the tea daily.
- HUCKLEBERRY**..Sprinkle about premises either dry or as a tea to be rid of despair and depression.
- HYSSOP**..Keep on hand as protection against Evil Eye. Put in bath water in form of tea for purification before any ritual. Dispels bad vibration. Bathe others as well for same purpose.
- HOREHOUND**..Keeps trouble away. Keep near doorways.
- I** **INDIAN ARROW WOOD**..Same as Wahoo Bark.
- INDIAN BALM**..Same as Beth Root.
- INDIAN TURNIP**..Same as Plant Of Peace.
- IRISH MOSS**..Kept under rugs to bring good fortune.
- IRON WEED**..Its tea makes a very good tonic.
- J** **JOHN The CONQUEROR ROOT**..Same as High John.
- JEZEBEL ROOT**..Hold root in left hand and concentrate on enemy. Then put in jar with warm water, seal jar and hide for three days and at end of time throw away the root and follow it with a curse.
- JOBS TEARS**..Keep seven Tears in the pocket for luck.
- JAMAICA GINGER**..Carry for good gambling luck.
- JASMINE**..Burn to have prophetic dreams. Also said to be a powerful aid in love spells. Add to love incense.
- JUNIPER BERRIES**..Steep in wine and use daily for increasing virility.
- JOE PIE**..Carry it for friendship and popularity.
- JUMBIE SEED**..String some together as an amulet for protection against evil spirits.
- K** **KAVA KAVA Root**..Soak in hot water for a tea that is said to be an aphrodisiac. Also protects against harm and brings good luck.
- KHUS KHUS**..Very famous among West Indian Voodoos. Carry in red bag for luck and success. Also attracts benevolent spirits when its essence is put in bath water. Make the essence by soaking Khus Khus in water for at least three days. Strain the liquid and bottle.
- KING OF THE WOODS**..Same as Master Of The Woods.
- L** **LADIES THUMB**..Place the herb on a picture of the one you want and seal in a box. Bury the box beside front door. Draws love.
- LUCKY HAND Root**..One of most popular and famous of Voodoo roots. Keep in red bag with other charms for best of luck. Always have on hand when gambling and also when seeking love.
- LIFE EVERLASTING**..Believed that its tea will prolong life. A spell was spoken before drinking the tea: "Chills and ills, pains and banes, do your fasting with life everlasting".

### DICTIONARY OF BOTANICALS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

**LOVAGE ROOT..**Put in bath water in form of a strained tea. Always strain teas before putting into bath or other waters. Lovage is used for the purpose of absorbing beneficial occult vibrations. Also said to help love life.

**LOW JOHN ROOT..**Same as Beth root. Also used to remove a hex or curse and witchcraft spells by chewing a piece of root and casting it on the ground. Sends the evil back.

**LIGNUM ALOES..**Use in love powers and considered very important for blessing the Voodoo room. Mixed and burned with a purifying incense.

**LAUREL..**Give to brides for a happy marriage. Also rubbed on the joints to prevent arthritis.

**LAVENDER..**Burn with incense to bring peace, love, and money to the home.

**LINSEED..**Burn to attain divinitory powers. Make a Voodoo cross outside each entryway and ground-level window to keep out any evil spirit.

**LINT BELLS..**Same as Linseed.

**LEMON VERBENA..**Used two ways: Add to rituals as a help for success or it may be used to break up lovers and marriages by casting it, at night, upon doorsteps.

**LUCKY BEANS..**Same as Mojoe Beans.

**LITTLE JOHN The CONQUEROR..**Same as High John The Conqueror root. Usually a small root.

**LICORICE..**An ingredient of love potions. Also sprinkled on footprints of lover to keep faithful.

**LINDEN, also called Lime..**Keeps a lover faithful. Powder and moisten a small amount and dab on forehead before retiring.

**LOTUS..**The pod is used in casting spells. Lotus is said to attract vibratory and magnetic powers for increased strength. The pod is used as an incense burner to join its forces with incense.

**M MAIDEN HAIR..**Bring beauty and love into your life. Put Maiden Hair into water and remove and keep near at hand or in charm bag. Represents Venus, the Goddess of Love.

**MANDRAKE..**Probably the most famous of all magical roots. The shape of a man or woman is often desired for both love and hate spells. Roots of such shapes are for practical purposes, almost impossible to attain. The Voodooist will take a number of pieces and join them together with red thread and glue to form male or female figures. A man keeps the female shape to draw love, and a woman keeps the man shape. Keep a root near money to draw much more. Carry to increase virility. Burn as an incense when casting Black Magic spells. When working in any hour of Saturn, burn Mandrake as a supreme offering. Stops all evil.

**MARJORAM..**Prized as a charm against witchcraft. Place in each room of dwelling and renew each month. It is an herb of Venus and is added to food as a love potion.

**MASTER OF The WOODS..**Carry in a small pouch to bring success and well-being in times of stress.

**MISTLETOE..**Refer to Elecampane for 'True Love Powder'.

**MUGWORT..**Burn as an incense while crystal gazing to increase psychic vision. Cause prophetic dreams by placing in a red bag which is kept under pillow at night. Carry in a charm bag to keep from tiring while travelling.

**MULLEIN..**Use as incense in Black Magic rituals. Add to love potions. Keep near entryways to bar witchcraft.

### DICTIONARY OF BOTANICALS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

**MYRTLE**..For preserving youth and love, Myrtle tea is drunk every three days. A famous potion using Myrtle was called "Angel Water". This consisted of Orange Water or tea, Rose water (tea), Myrtle Water (tea), and musk with Ambergris.

**MAGNOLIA**..Place in, near, or under bed for faithfulness.

**MAY APPLE**..Another name for Mandrake.

**MOJOE BEANS**..Carry for luck and making wishes come true. Known as the 'Wishing Bean'.

**MARIGOLD**..Used with love sachets to attract. Add tea to bath water for attaining love vibrations.

**MINT**..Ingredient of love potions. Also kept in house as protection against witchcraft.

**MUSTARD SEED**..A symbol of faith followed by success. Usually carried in a silver or golden charm. One of oldest good luck amulets known.

**MYRRH**..Burn on Voodoo altar with any love ritual. Also mixed with Frankincense for potent success burning.

**MOTHERWORT**..Useful for love. Add the tea to bath water. Its presence is also said to protect all in a family from harm.

**MASTIC GUM**..Purifies the Voodoo room of all evil forces and protects the ritual practitioner. Mastic is burned alone or mixed with other incenses. It is one of the basic ingredients of many church incenses.

**N** **NETTLE**..For removing curses and hex, mix with any strong jinx or hex removing powder and sprinkle in each room and outside every entryway, being sure to draw a solid, unbroken line when doing so.

**NUTMEG**..Said to be one of most powerful of lucky talismans or charms for the gambler when properly prepared according to Voodoo belief. A hole is bored in it, and it is filled with quicksilver. The hole is plugged with sealing wax. It should be rubbed with a silver coin and kept in a red bag; kept on hand whenever gambling.

**NUTGALL**..For witchcraft rituals and hexing, add nutgall to the incenses.

**O** **ORRIS ROOT**..Casts a love spell by dusting it on the clothes of opposite sex. Added to food or drink as a love potion. Added to incense for good magical works.

**OLIBANUM**..Same as Frankincense.

**ORANGE**..Use leaves or flowers for love ritual. Burn together with name of loved one written on parchment. Gather the ashes and keep in a wax-sealed bottle or jar.

**P** **PEONY ROOT**..Anoint with Conquering and Success Oils and place in red bag as a powerful lucky charm. This preparation must be done only on a Sunday or it is of no value. Also said to reverse spells.

**PALMA CHRISTI BEAN**..Kept in a sealed bottle as a protection against evil forces and witchcraft. A small bottle is kept in each room. Every month the bean is thrown away and a new one put in its place.

**PANSY**..A talisman of love, it is kept on hand to draw affection of all who come near it.

**PEONY ROOT**..Anoint with Conquering and Success Oils and place in red bag as a powerful lucky charm. This preparation must be done only on a Sunday or it is of no value. Also said to reverse spells.

## FAMOUS VODOO RITUALS AND SPELLS

### DICTIONARY OF BOTANICALS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

**PINE Bark**..Reverse and send back a spell by burning it. Mix it with Uncrossing Incense.

**PLANT OF PEACE**..Same as Indian Turnip. Keep on premises to bring peace and harmony.

**PATCHOULY**..Use in any ritual where 'graveyard dust' is required. Some Voodooists prefer Patchouly to actual dirt or dust from a cemetery.

**PEPPERMINT**..Add to Rama Dream Incense to increase chances of having prophetic dreams. Burn in early evening.

**PERIWINKLE**..A love herb. Burn with Lovers Incense and keep some in bedroom. Also put in others belongings.

**PURSLANE**..Said to be a sure protection against evil forces of all types. Sprinkle about home and particularly the bedroom.

**POKE ROOT**..Breaks hexes and witch spells. Brew into a tea and add to both bathwater and cleaning water. Clean premises, especially corners, and then bathe.

**PENNYROYAL**..Keep in home for marital peace.

**PASSION FLOWER**..Helps attract love and peace. Brings harmony and friendship where kept.

**Q QUEEN ELIZABETH Root**..Voodooists will sometimes use this root as a pendulum if they are unable to procure a specially made occult pendulum. A string about thirteen inches long is tied to the root. The string is held between thumb and forefinger and a question is thought of very intently. If the root swings left and right, the answer is 'yes', if the root swings back and forth towards the questioner, the answer is 'no'.

**QUASSIA CHIPS**..Ground or powdered Quassia is mixed with hair of the beloved and burned to ashes. The ashes are kept in a small bottle to preserve the love.

**QUEEN OF MEADOW**..For good luck, brew into a tea. Let stand in cool place for seven days. Strain and add to bath water. Do this once a week.

**QUEEN'S DELIGHT Root**..Legend say that drinking a tea made from this root will help a woman conceive. It is also carried to be more attractive to the opposite sex.

**QUEEN'S Root**..Same as Queen's Delight.

**QUINCE SEED**..Carry some in red bag for protection from all harm of any type.

**R ROSEMARY**.. "Where Rosemary Flourishes, The Lady Rules", is an ancient saying. Rosemary is kept near the bed to insure faithfulness. For causing prophetic dreams, Rosemary is dipped into a mixture of vinegar, rum, water, gin, and wine. This is kept near the bed. Before retiring say, "Tibi impero ut quaedam viluero et velim adimpleas et facias".

**RATTLESNAKE ROOT**..Refer to Rattlesnake Spell for full details.

**RUE**..Brew into a tea and mix some with Lovers Incense. Burn the incense and drink the tea. This is said to attract the right lover and prevent a wrong and unhappy choice.

**ROSE BUDS**..Carry in a bag sewen closed to bring love.

**ROSE HIPS**..Use like Rose Buds and also to bring luck.

**RULER'S Root**..See Wonder of World Root Spell.

### DICTIONARY OF BOTANICALS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

- R ROWAN WOOD**..A most powerful protective charm against witchcraft. Take two small pieces of rowan and form a cross. Tie securely with red thread or yarn and keep near at hand. Best when carried in a charm bag.
- S SAMPSON SNAKEROOT**..Strengthens one's virility if it is carried as a charm. Chewed to soften hearts of others.
- SEA SPIRIT**..Place in a small bottle and fill with whiskey and seal. Keep one in each room as a lucky charm and to attract beneficial spirits guide and help.
- SOLOMON SEAL Root**..Place in container to one side of ritual chamber and burn as an important offering for success in the following ritual of any sort.
- SOUTHERN JOHN The CONQUEROR Root**..Carry as a charm to bring luck in love and money affairs. One of the most favorite of Voodoo roots.
- SPIKENARD**..Make love secure by burying Spikenard in the ground. Must be renewed twice a month to the spell active.
- ST. JOHNSWORT**..Strong protection against all forms of witchcraft and black magic. Put in a small red bag, the herb is hung at every window and entryway, and a prayer is spoken, "St. John, protect me from all works of the devil". Also burned with incense to banish all evil.
- SUMBUL ROOT**..Carried near the heart to ward off disease and bring good fortune.
- SATYRION Root**..Very powerful love root. Carry to direct to you. Said to excite if use in love potions.
- SANDALWOOD**..Always mixed with incenses and other herbs and burned at rituals. One of most ancient and powerful offerings for success in any work or wish.
- SEA HOLLY**..Same as Eryngo.
- SWEET SEDGE**..Use with any love ritual, mix with other herbs and incenses.
- SAFFRON**..Included in hex charms. Add to any that are to be thrown on enemy's doorsteps or buried in yard. Also used for prophecy by drinking Saffron tea.
- SOUTHERNWOOD**..Kept in home as a love charm and it is also burned to protect against trouble.
- SACRED BARK**..Carry for luck, and burned to purify and consecrate ritual room.
- SANG ROOT**..Same as Ginseng.
- SQUILL ROOT**..Add to lucky charm bags, also brew a tea and add to cleaning water to purify premises. Said to bring good fortune to self and business.
- STAR ANISE**..A favorite good luck charm kept in home or carried in luck bag. Also placed on each corner of altar and renewed each week.
- SAGE**..Wards off misfortune. Keep near entryways with other herbs and roots of same purpose.
- STYRAX**..Said to be of great strength for providing success for any Voodoo work. Add to burning incenses. This is usually known only by Voodoo priests who do not let their innermost secrets be known.
- STORAX**..Another name for Styrax.
- SARSAPARILLA**..Soak in wine for seven days and then remove and allow to dry. Grind into powder, mix with Frankincense and Myrrh. Burn at least one evening a week to prevent illness and to arouse love's passions.
- SLIPPERY ELM Bark**..Stops slander and gossip and often enables a person to be more impressive with speech. Burn with Uncrossing Incense, and carry in charm bag.

### DICTIONARY OF BOTANICALS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

**SLOE** Bark or Berries..Either can be used to exorcise demons and purify the premises of all evil. Mix with a strong unhexing oil and incense and burn at high noon and again at midnight. Do this for seven days.

**SEVEN BARKS ROOT**..Carried as a good luck charm.

**SEA WRACK**..Add to black magic and hex rituals.

**SENNA** Roots or Pods..Brew a tea and strain. Put in bathwater of mate to insure faithfulness. Done secretly.

**SMARTWEED**..Attracts money and clears the mind.

**SULPHUR**..Although not a herb, it is mixed with many herbs to give power to a spell. Used for crossing, hexing. For example of use, refer to Brimstone Spell.

**SMELLAGE ROOT**..Brew a tea and when cool sprinkle it on a troublemaker to change attitude.

**STILLINGEA**..Same as Queen's Root, Queen's Delight.

**STONE ROOT**..Carry for protection. Stop witchcraft by sprinkling in front of entryways. Keep jarful in home.

**SUMBUL ROOT**..A favorite love root often hard to obtain. Said to attract opposite very quickly. Carried as a charm, burned as an incense, and its tea is put in bath water. Do all of these for best results.

**SWEET BASIL**..See Basil regarding use for love.

**T TONKA BEANS**..A favorite Caribbean Voodoo charm for good luck. Said to most effective when used with the Wishing Cross, the Cross of Caravaca. A hole is made in the bean and a thread or wire is passed thru and attached to the cross.

**TORMENTIL**..The tea is drunk to keep witchcraft away.

**TILIA**..Same as Linden or Lime.

**TWITCHGRASS ROOT**..Same as Doggrass Root. Reverses hexes, and causes many troubles. Throw on doorsteps.

**THYME**..Add to good luck herb jar in home, renew monthly as herbs lose their vibratory powers in time.

**TREFOIL**..Mix with Vervain, Dill, and St. Johnswort to make one of most powerful defenses against all types of sorcery and witchcraft. Brew the mixture in a tea and do not strain. Rub on any hex material and it will destroy its power over you. If hex signs are found on steps and doorways, or sent in the mail, sprinkle the tea on any of them.

**U UNICORN ROOT**..Carried for protection and also as a love charm. For love, give to opposite sex by hiding it among their belongings. Also carried for virility.

**UVA URSI**..Helpful when meditating or with any higher mystical rite. Burn with psychic incenses.

**V VALERIAN**..Drink the tea to quiet nerves and sprinkle about home to bring peace and end strife.

**VERVAIN**..See Trefoil for powerful protection mixture. Also used with Elecampane and Mistletoe to make the ancient 'True Love Powder'. See Elecampane.

**VETIVERT**..Another name for Khus Khus root.

**VERBENA**..See Lemon Verbena.

**VANILLA BEAN**..Use like a Tonka Bean. Also burn one bean per week to powerfully attract and keep love.

**VANDAL ROOT**..Destroy hexes by burning with jinx-removing incense and oil. Burn anointed yellow candle at same time. Use jinx-removing oil on candle.

**VIOLET**..A love ingredient of ancient fame. Mix with sachets, brew a tea and add to bath, burn with love incense. Use in all ways to inflame the opposite sex.

- VIRGINIA SNAKEROOT**..Said to be one of most reliable of good luck charms. It is hard to get, and if once possessed, it should be guarded carefully.
- W WAHOO BARK**..Defeats hexes. Rub Wahoo tea on a hexed person's forehead and say 'Wahoo' seven times.
- WITCH BURR**..Symbol of an Obeah man or woman's power. Said to add great power to their work and spells. It also defeats any evil forces by its presence.
- WITCH GRASS**..Sprinkle on Voodoo dolls and other hex charms to increase power of hex.
- WONDER OF WORLD ROOT**..See Spell for details.
- WORMWOOD**..See Wormwood Spell for many details.
- WHITE SQUILL ROOT**..See Squill root.
- WOOD ROSE**..Thought to give great occult power to whoever owns one. It is a strange looking flower that appears to be made from wood. Difficult to obtain.
- WILD THYME**..Greatly beloved by good spirits. Offer it as an incense to gain their help.
- WOOD SORREL**..Use in same way as Wild Thyme. Mix the two together for better results.
- WILLOW BARK**..Its presence is said to invoke aid of Satan.
- WOODRUFF**..Same as Master of the Woods.
- WATER ERYNGO**..See Eryngo.
- WASTE AWAY TEA**..Another name for 5 Finger Grass.
- WILLOW BARK**..Plant a picture or some belonging of a loved one beneath a willow tree to keep their love. Its presence at rituals is said to invoke aid of Satan but this can be dangerous unless fully prepared.
- Y YARROW**..Sometimes called Devil's Nettle, it is burned in rites to invoke Satan's powers.
- YELLOW DOCK**..Improves business and general good fortune. In tea form it is sprinkled about premises. Also mixed with cleaning water to thoroughly clean all floors.
- YERBA MATE**..Love potion ingredient for food or drink.
- YERBA SANTA**..Also known as Holy Herb.
- Z ZEDOARY**..Added to wine it is said to have a stimulating effect. Also burned as a ritual incense as a love offering.



### Wonder Of The World Root Treasure Ritual

Some American Voodooists believe that a treasure hunter may find hidden wealth by digging a hole in ground where he thinks treasure may be buried. In the hole is placed a parchment paper bearing an ancient seal called Schemhamphoras. Near this hole is buried the whole Wonder of the World root or pieces of it. Since this root is expensive and quite hard to get, the searcher will often use some pieces of it and save the rest for other searches. If pieces are used, then four pieces are best, and they are put in the ground to the east, west, north, and south of the hole. A Voodoo oil, Three Jacks And A Knave oil, is rubbed on the hands. A branch with a coin stuck to its end is waved over the area. Now a mirror is held over the ground, and if the ritual works, the treasure will be seen in the mirror which must be slanted towards the ground.

### Wormwood Ritual



Wormwood is used to contact spirits of the dead and in divination. It is burned as an incense. A favorite method is to put it in a black paper cone which is lit at the bottom. As the smoke rises, the spirit of the deceased sought is called for and asked to make its presence known. Questions are asked and help requested.

Some Voodooists will burn wormwood while using a pendulum or planchette for divination purposes.

### Luck Ball

Have a small amount of whiskey on hand as it is necessary to give this charm a 'drink' as it is being made. Required are sixteen pieces of white yarn, each thirty six inches long, and sixteen pieces of white thread of the same length. Fold each piece four times until it is nine inches long. Take four of the yarn and four of the thread and lay them together ends matching. Now tie the strands together making a four knotted skein. Repeat with the remaining pieces so that four skeins are made with a total of sixteen knots. The skeins are rounded into a nest and a small amount of whiskey is sprinkled over it. In the center of the nest is placed a small ball of tinfoil, some Red Clover herb, and Goofer Dust. Then the nest and its contents are thoroughly wrapped tight with more white yarn which should be securely tied in a knot. The finished wrapping should be in the shape of a ball. Again, whiskey is sprinkled on it. Wrap the ball in tinfoil and wrap the tinfoil ball with red silk. Put the finished ball in a bag, a red bag is best, and either hide it or carry it in a pocket. Once a week the ball should be taken out of the bag and receive its 'drink' of whiskey to keep up its strength.

### Haitian Voodoo Love Spell

This love fetish should be made by a Voodoo priest or priestess. It consists of two needles, laid side by side, point of one needle to the eye of the other. Wrap the needles in bay leaves and wind red thread or red yarn around the leaves from end to end. Put the packet into a leather pouch and sew tight. Whoever carries the pouch is said to gain the love of anyone desired.

### DAMBALLAH-WEDO Spell

This is basically an invocation to gain the help of the major benevolence in the Voodoo pantheon of gods. Damballah-Wedo is the manifestation of Da, the force that controls all life and motion. He is the being who sustains the world and all within it. In order to help a ritual to be successful, the Voodooist will light an offeratory white candle anointed with Success Oil and burn a success or conquering incense. Then the invocation to Damballah is spoken, "Au nom Monsieur Damballah-Wedo-Toka-Mirwaze,

Da, Sa Lavatyo pasa wilino wilime oda kosikos  
oda kosikos ods kosikos oda ayika siuka, oda  
ayika siuka, oda owedo, neme oda misu wedo,  
dieke, Damballah-Wedo legi neg Ak-a-Syel".

When this is finished, any ritual, for whatever purpose, may be completed with the thought that Damballah's help may be present to insure success. This preparatory invocation may be used before any ritual at any time.

### Dragon Breath Spell



Dragon Breath Fire Powder can be used, according to Voodooists, to remove or put on a hex, and for love spells to gain love, remove love, and get rid of rivals. This odd powder comes in a tube which is squeezed to shoot the powder across a candle flame. The powder flashes like the legendary dragon breath; thus its unusual name. Here are several Voodoo uses:

#### TO REMOVE HEX AND CROSSED CONDITIONS

Light a White Hex Breaker candle. Stand a few feet from it, facing south, and squeeze the tube so the powder shoots across the flame. Do the same thing facing north, east and west. Before creating the flaming breath each time, say, "As the Mystic fire burns, may it burn away all hexes and troubles". This is a very impressive ceremony and is fine for groups who are in trouble.

#### TO PLACE A HEX OR CROSSED CONDITION

Write name of enemy on a piece of parchment paper. Wrap the paper around a black Weed Of Misfortune candle and glue it so that it will stay. Light the candle and sprinkle Jinx Oil in its flame. Allow the candle to burn until wax has run down over the paper. Then shoot the mighty Dragon Breath flame across the candle three times; each time from a different direction so that a Hoodoo crisscross is formed. Thus an enemy is cursed as the Hex Triangle is bound above his name. Repeat once a week.

#### FOR LOVE AFFAIRS AND LOVE PROBLEMS

Write name of loved one on a red Fire Of Love candle using a sharp point. Anoint the candle with Lovers Oil and set in socket and light. Blast the Dragon Breath Fire across the flame from all four directions and seal the love to you.

**A Rival:** Write the rival's name on a red Fire Of Love candle and anoint with Crossing Oil. From the North, and then from the South, spray the Dragon Breath. Believed to bring misfortune upon the rival, and to drive he or she away.

**To remove love:** Write names of both persons involved on a red Fire Of Love candle. Names must crisscross each other. Anoint candle with Black Cat oil. Spray the Dragon Breath Fire Powder so that it crisscrosses above the flame. Repeat from the opposite direction. Do this seven nights in a row starting with a Monday night.

### Love Charm Ritual

Requires nine used nails, a pint of vinegar, a pint of rain water, three teaspoons of Goofer Dust. Place all of these in a pot and boil until only half the liquid remains. Take it off the fire and allow to stand for nine days. After that time the pot is refilled with an equal amount of vinegar and rain water. Mix well and let stand for nine more days. It is then placed in a bottle which is capped or corked. Each night for the following nine nights, sprinkle some of the liquid about the dwelling place of the man or woman desired. On the following tenth night make your desire known to the other party. When the liquid is bottled, the nails must also be put into the container.



**To Win A Man**

A blue candle is placed on an altar or table. In front of the candle is placed a dish or saucer containing a small amount each of quicksilver, molasses, white sand well mixed together; a pot containing cooked okra and rice; a pot or dish containing a mixture of salt, black pepper, red pepper or cayenne, and vinegar; and a saucer containing a small amount of dark whiskey. To one side is set a red candle formed of seven knobs. Some Voodooists will place symbolic pictures of St. Joseph, St. Peter, and St. Michael on the altar.

The blue candle is lit and seven Hail Mary's spoken. Taste the okra and rice and make a wish about the man.

The name of the petitioner, the man, and any possible rival, if there is one, is written on separate pieces of paper. The rival's name is put in the vinegar dish. The saucer of whiskey is set aflame and the other names are put in the flame.

One knob of the seven-knobbed candle is burned each night for seven nights. Each time the candle is lit say three Hail Mary's. Each day, for the seven days, a small amount of the okra and rice is eaten. At all times a piece of lodestone is kept near at hand. Many Voodooists will anoint the candles with Lovers and Success oils.

*"Hail Mary, full of grace! The Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen."*

**Ghost Smoke Spell**

'Ghost Smoke' is a white powder that when lit gives off billows of white smoke. It is usually called Smoke Powder in curio and magic shops where it can be obtained. This powder is used in a ritual to get rid of evil forces, bad luck, and misfortune.

This prayer and invocation must be performed outdoors after sunset. If done indoors it is said to cause great harm to the one performing the invocation.

Place a teaspoonful of Ghost Smoke Powder on a piece of white paper laid on the ground. Write your name and the following prayer on a piece of parchment paper using Dove Blood Red ink.

"I, ( write in your name ), offer to you, Mysterious Beings and Spirits that direct my fate, this invocation to grant me your help. Make bad luck and misfortune leave me. Give me peace of mind and prosperity. Keep from me all harm and hardship. As this wondrous smoke reaches your upper realms, grant my wish. Amen".

Place the parchment paper on top of the Ghost Smoke and sprinkle some Special Favor Oil on it. Light the powder and as it bursts into smoke, concentrate on your prayer and desire to be helped. When the smoke has ascended, gather the parchment and ashes and bury it in the ground. Do this three nights in a row.

### DICTIONARY OF INCENSES USED IN VODOO RITUALS

Incense has been used since time immemorial as offerings to the gods. Man has believed it is pleasing to deities and spirits, and that it is a medium, or channel, for carrying wishes and petitions to the Gods who find fragrant aromas to be most pleasurable. The use of incense is mentioned in the Bible, (Exod. xxx, 1-7), and has been used by most religions including Voodoo. Voodooists will often use more than one incense in a ritual and will also add one or more oils to the burning incense to strengthen its effect. Voodooists use incense more intensively than other religions. For their own mysterious purposes, they use incenses taken from many climes, cultures, and other religions. The Voodooist will use any religious article, regardless of its origin, if he feels that it will assist his rituals. He bends it, so to speak, to his own mystical purpose.

*Meanings given are in general the most widely accepted beliefs. They may vary somewhat from locale to locale.*

Although many rituals require candles, oils, powders, etc. in addition to incense, there are also rituals which require only incense. For instance, the first incense listed below, Algiers Fast Luck Incense, is burned as an offering in the hope that it will bring good luck. One method is to write your wish or need on a small piece of parchment paper, and place the incense on the paper. As the incense smoke and aroma rises it is believed to take the meaning of the words with them. This method can be used with many of the incenses listed. Also, various incenses can be used at the same time, with a parchment paper and wish beneath each.

- A** **ALGIERS FAST LUCK Incense**..A favorite for good luck.  
**ABTINA Incense**..A favorite for power and success.  
**ADAM & EVE Incense**..Attracts and keeps love.  
**ALTAR Incense**..Attracts spirits aid; blesses.  
**ANGEL Incense**..For luck and protection against evil.  
**ARAB-KA SOUDAGOR Incense**..Helps business and luck.  
**ARIES Incense**..Used by those under its sign for luck.  
**AQUARIAN Incense**..Used by Aquarians for luck.  
**ASTARTE Incense**..Special for lovers. Use often.  
**ATTRACTION Incense**..Draws power, love, luck, money.
- B** **BINGO Incense**..Burn for luck before going to play.  
**BUDDHA PUJA Incense**..A secret blend incense burned to receive love, peace, and good fortune.  
**BANISHING Incense**..Removes evil forces and hexes.  
**BAT'S BLOOD Incense**..For Black Magic and hexing.  
**BAT'S EYE Incense**..Use where eye of a bat is needed.  
**BAT'S HEART Incense**..Breaks love affairs and hexes.  
**BENEFICIAL DREAM Incense**..Burn at night to make dreams come true. Helps develop clairvoyance.  
**BENZOIN Incense**..For peace of mind, quiet life.  
**BERGAMOT Incense**..For protection against anything.  
**BIBLE Incense**..Very important. Blesses all rituals.  
**BLACK ARTS Incense**..Use only with Black Magic. It is burned during hexing and crossing rituals.  
**BLACK CAT Incense**..Of tremendous power either for hexing or for obtaining luck and good fortune.  
**BUCKEYE Incense**..For luck and sending back curses.

**COMPELLING Incense**..Forces others to obey you.  
**CONFUSION Incense**..Breaks hexes and 'crosses'.

**DOUBLE FAST LUCK Incense**..Powerful for gaining luck.  
**DOVE'S BLOOD Incense**..Brings peace and tranquility. Also substitutes for actual Dove blood.  
**DOVE'S EYE Incense**..Use like Dove's Blood Incense.  
**DOVE'S HEART Incense**..Helps love affairs and can be used as a substitute for actual dove heart.  
**DRAGON BLOOD Incense**..One of most powerful incenses. Burn at midnight for seven nights to foil any hex. Carry a stick of it for exceptional good luck.  
**DOMINATION Incense**..Gives power over anyone. Protects against evil forces and spells.  
**DRAW BACK Incense**..Stops curses from reaching you.

**WHEN IS INCENSE BURNED?** The Voodooist burns incense any time a need is felt. The incense is burned alone or as part of a ritual. From the Voodoo viewpoint, a specific incense has to be burned for the purpose that it is symbolic of.

### New Orleans Charm For Good Luck

Before assembling this good luck charm it is required to say, "The God before me, the God behind me, the God be with me". Materials to make up the charm are small amounts of Allspice, a white bean, black pepper seeds, a medal or statue of St. Benedict, Rosemary herb, Chamomile herb, Calamus root, a small lodestone, a few strands of hair, and breadcrumbs. After making the blessing of God, all the materials are wrapped in red cloth or a red bag. This is sewen shut so nothing can escape. Every Friday, except Good Friday, the charm is wet with a small amount of rum. Then it is kept in a safe secret place. Some persons make charms for each room of their home.

### Defeating Witchcraft With H & H Spell

To defeat witchcraft, get some hair of the witch. If the hair cannot be obtained, write name of the witch thirteen times on black paper using white ink. If the name is not known, write, "Whose evil has been cast upon me, now shall it be cast back on thee". Anoint a ten penny nail with H & H oil and wrap the hair or paper around it. Tie with white and black thread wound ten times around the nail. Pick a quiet spot on the north side of the dwelling and drive the nail into the ground. Every day, at sundown, for nine days in a row, sprinkle H & H oil on the nail head. The ninth day completes the casting back of evil spell.

Some Voodooists perform the ritual in another fashion. Dirt is taken from the north side of the yard, put in a box and tamped solid. The box is kept inside near a north wall and the nail is driven into the dirt. The rest of the ritual is exactly the same as in the first example.



### Lodestones



Lodestones are usually carried in pairs; one to drive evil away, and the other to draw good luck. The stones are 'fed' every Friday and then placed in a red bag. Feeding is accomplished by sprinkling 'magnetic sand' on the stones or the stones may be immersed in the 'sand'. Before each feeding, the old 'magnetic sand' is thoroughly brushed away. Lodestones are usually handled in their natural state of a rough, blackish stone. However, modern Voodooists often carry colored lodestone such as silver, gold, red, green, and so forth. Red is said to draw love more strongly. Gold, silver, and green are believed to attract money and strong gambling luck. White gives greater protection against evil and bad luck. Of course, many Voodooists prefer the natural uncolored stones as being closer to vibrations of occult nature.



### To Break A Hex Or Crossed Condition

Anoint three pink candles with Uncrossing Oil and place on the altar. Place seven pieces of Temple Incense cones in an incense burner and light each piece with a different match. Also light the pink candles, each with a separate match. The hexed party bows to the incense three times. Sprinkle him (or her) three times with Holy Water (water that has blessed). Repeat the bowing before the altar and this time the incense burner is lifted from the altar and its smoke is waved over the hexed one's head. Do this each time he bows. Next sprinkle him seven times with the Holy Water. Sprinkle in each corner of the room and sprinkle down the center of the room. Sprinkle across the room to form a cross. The hexed party is then stood on the intersection of the cross. Place another incense burner near the doorway and light seven Temple Incense cones in it. As the smoke rises, take his hand and lead him through the smoke three times. Then return him to the center of the cross. Take up the doorway incense burner and smoke each corner of the room and every other part of the room. When this is completed give him a red flannel bag containing a High John the Conqueror Root and a Lucky Hand Root. Bid him go in peace.



### Paper Hex Ritual

To cause a hex or bad luck to follow someone disliked, a piece of paper, preferably black, is cut into the shape of a man or woman. Use Dove Blood Red ink to write the person's name on the paper image.

Stick a new pin at the head and thread it in and out of the image all the way down to the feet. This will cause the paper image to fold up and become quite small. Place the image and pin in a small box and take it to a cemetery. Dig a small hole and place the box within. On top of the box place some Devil's Shoe-string roots and sprinkle the roots and box with Black Art Oil. Then cover with dirt from the graveyard. Leave the cemetery and never return to where the box was buried.



**Voodoo Belief Regarding Powders And Oils**

Powders and oils are rubbed on, sprinkled about, blown, and burned so as to fill the air with their vibratory powers. Some powders and oils have very little aroma so as to not attract attention. However, this varies greatly as formulas are great in number. The basic purpose behind their use is to have the magic they represent seep in and affect the will of whoever they are directed at. Refer to Powder and Oil dictionary lists for the individual beliefs.

**DICTIONARY OF OILS USED IN VODOO RITUALS**

Scented and unscented oils have played a part in most religions. Voodoo requires both essential and mixed oils for a myriad of uses.

Voodoo oils are compounded with various ingredients, not just one. For instance, a Rose oil or Musk oil will contain more than just the named oil. This is true of all the oils. It takes experience and knowledge to gain the proper balance and resulting satisfactory oil.

Voodooists will often use more than one oil during a ritual. They add 'strength' oils to give more power to a spell or ritual. It is believed that the more oils used, the better the chance of success.

Listed are the most widely known oils together with a short summary of the Voodoo beliefs regarding them.

- A **ADAM & EVE OIL**...For love anoint hands before touching. Add to love rituals. Used by both women and men.
- AFRICAN JUJU OIL**...Powerful help in crossing. Use with all crossing rituals and spells.
- ALGIERS FAST LUCK OIL**...Put on lucky charms. Burn a green candle each night. Anoint with the oil first.
- ALMOND OIL**...Put on incense and burn to attract good fortune and money.
- ALL SAINTS OIL**...To bring success, add to incense and anoint candles used in rituals.
- ALL SPICE OIL**...Adds power to all rituals. Use like All Saints Oil.
- ALTAR OIL**...A basic oil added to incense and candle anointing. Sanctifies the altar and is an offering oil.
- ANISE OIL**...Good luck oil. Add to incense, candles.
- ANGEL OIL**...For love and invoking spirits' aid.
- ANGEL'S DELIGHT OIL**...Similar to Angel Oil.
- ANointing OIL**...For success. Use on candles, add to incense. Add to bath water. Dress curio bags.
- AMERICAN VODOO OIL**...For success in any work. Add and anoint all materials used.
- APPLEBLOSSOM OIL**...Burn as an incense, add to bath water. For success and happiness.
- AQUARIUS OIL**...Added to rituals and charms by those born between January 20th and February 18th.
- ARABIAN NIGHTS OIL**...Love oil. Add to rituals, love charms, anoint hands.
- ARIES OIL**...Added to rituals and charms by those born between March 20th and April 20th.
- ATTRACTION OIL**...Attracts all good things. Used like Attraction Powder and to anoint green candles.

- BAYBERRY OIL**...Anoint bayberry candle and burn to the socket to obtain adequate money.
- BEND OVER OIL**...Same as Essence of Bend Over. Refer to spell shown in detail elsewhere in book.
- BENEFICIAL DREAM OIL**...Burn as an incense, anoint white candle and burn before retiring. For peaceful and comfortable nights and good sleep.
- BENZOIN OIL**...Add to rituals that bring peace of mind. An ancient mystic offering. Burn with incense, candles.
- BERGAMOT OIL**...One of the most famous of Voodoo oils. Use with any ritual.
- BIBLE OIL**...For success. Anoint all candles except black. With Bible on altar, burn incense and oil before it.
- BLACK ART OIL**...Used only in Black Magic. Refer to the Black Art Oil Spell for full details.
- BLACK CAT OIL**...Can be used for both hexing and for love and luck. Refer to Black Cat Oil spell.
- BLACK DEVIL OIL**...Sprinkle a mixture of the oil, salt, and sugar on clothing of man or women who is unfaithful. Do this while they are asleep.
- BERRY OF FISH OIL**...Anoint red candle and burn before bed time. Said to arouse desire tremendously.
- BLACK MUS OIL**...Add to Black Mus Powder for more strength. Refer to Black Mus Powder for details.
- BLESSING OIL**...Invokes spiritual and Voodoo gods' help. Anoint altar, candles, rub on hands.
- BOSS FIX OIL**...To gain consideration, sprinkle where employer is sure to walk.
- BUDDHA OIL**...To gain power over others, anoint hands and a statue or picture of Buddha nightly for 7 days.

- HOLY OIL**...To bring blessings and success. Purifies the premises. Rub on candles center to top.
- HONEYSUCKLE OIL**...An attracting oil. Burn by itself or put on incense. Use at noon and midnight.
- H & H OIL**...Said to be one of the most powerful means to defeat witchcraft. Refer to the H & H Spell.
- I** **INCENSE OIL**...Sprinkle on incense to make the offering more potent. Draws spirits help in succeeding in work.

- SPIRIT OIL**...Use like Mint Oil and also spray with water mixture all around outside of dwelling. Done at night.
- SPIRIT'S GUIDE OIL**...Gain help of spirit for success. It is sprinkled aout and some is left in open pot for enjoyment by the spirit who feeds on the aroma.
- SQUINT OIL**...Brings back the lost lover regardless of distance. Anoint two red candles and burn at noon and night.
- STAY HOME OIL**...Sprinkle on bottom of shoes of mate and also secretly put into mate's bath water.

- VERBENA OIL...** *Many uses. One is to defeat hexes. Use in scrub water to wash all entries and pathways.*
- VERVAIN OIL...** *Keeps away evil spirits. Mix with water to make a brew called "Juno's Tears". Spray and clean throughout the dwelling.*
- VIOLET OIL...** *For peaceful conditions and to increase love's passions. A very ancient use. Use like a perfume and also as a bath water, and addition to incense.*
- VODOO NIGHT OIL...** *Use in ceremonies to inflame the participants. Put in pot and burn with wick.*
- VODOO OIL...** *Make into a water spray and anoint altar and work room. This is a blessing oil.*
- VIRGO OIL...** *For power and success, added to rituals by those born between August 23rd and September 22nd.*
- W WALL BREAKER OIL...** *Awakens psychic powers and eliminates financial problems. Burn on incense.*
- WATER OF NOTRE DAME...** *Causes calm and peace by attracting the help of beneficial spirits. Mix with water and spray about the dwelling.*
- WATER OF PEACE OIL...** *Solves marital problems. Put about the home for fourteen days in a row.*
- WAR WATER OIL...** *Causes hexes and much trouble. Put on doorknobs and make an oil cross in front of home.*
- WEALTHY WAY OIL...** *To attract money, anoint a green candle and burn. Repeat each day until satisfied.*
- WHITE ROSE OIL...** *Sprayed about home to achieve peace and quiet. Helps marriages. Mix with water.*
- WINNER'S CIRCLE OIL...** *For betting and gambling luck. Rub on hands before starting. Burn with yellow candle.*
- WINTERGREEN OIL...** *Use only with daytime Voodoo rituals. Put in open pot for success. Throw away after ritual is finished. Always use new oil each time.*
- WISTERIA OIL...** *Ceremonial oil. Add to olive or palm oil. Use with wick. Attracts helpful spirits.*
- WORLD'S WONDER ROOT...** *Use with root of same name for treasure hunting. See Spell for full details.*
- WORMWOOD OIL...** *Many uses. One is to stop hexes. Go to a dark place beneath a tree and pour the oil in a circle and command the hex to return to its maker.*

- Z ZODIAC OIL...** *Always used when burning Astral candles in candle ceremonies. No matter what the birthmonth, any Astral candle is anointed from center to top, and from center to bottom with Zodiac Oil.*



### For Help In Getting A Job

Put a green lodestone in a red flannel bag and 'feed' it Magnetic Sand. Carry this when seeking employment. 'Feed' means to cover the lodestone with Magnetic Sand. 'Magnetic Sand' is the Voodoo term for iron pyrite.

### To Be Popular and Loved

Assemble on the altar three White Cross candles, three yellow (Glow Of Attraction) candles, three orange (Crown Of Success) candles, 9 lumps of sugar, a bottle of Crown Of Success Oil, a red flannel bag, 9 pieces of red cloth about four inches square, an ounce of Magnetic Dust, 9 pieces of red ribbon in length about twelve inches each, a John The Conqueror root, and some Beth root.

After all materials are on hand, place some incense (such as Altar Brand Incense or Success Brand Incense) and ignite it. Incense offerings are important in Voodoo rituals just as they are in the majority of the other worldwide religions. Pass all the materials through the smoke of the incense. This is a request for success and a mystical anointing of the ritual items.

Place a White Cross candle at the head of the altar. To the right of it place a yellow candle and on the left side place an orange candle. Anoint the yellow and orange candles with Crown of Success Oil. Anoint the cross candle with Altar oil. Altar oil should always be kept on hand as it is one of the most important oils used in Voodoo rituals where candleburning is required.

Place three lumps of sugar on a metal plate or incense burner. Dampen each piece with Crown of Success Oil. Now light the three candles, the incense, and the three lumps of sugar. As the flame is applied, murmur softly, "Canga, Cina, Eh, Eh". Repeat this over and over until all materials are alit.

Put a small amount of Magnetic Dust on each of the three lumps of sugar and leave the room; returning when the three candles have burned out. If you start this ritual at noon, return at dusk. Place the remains of each piece of sugar on a square of red cloth which is then folded into a small packet. Tie the three packets with a red ribbon, being sure to wind the ribbon both ways across a packet so as to form a cross. Place the three packets on the right side of the altar. As you wind and tie the ribbons call softly the name or names of whoever you wish to think highly of you.

Repeat the above ritual in the same manner for two more days and you will end up with nine packets. On the third night take the nine packets and hide them all about the room or home. Each is hidden in a separate place. After this is done, return to the altar and again repeat, "Canga, Cina, Eh, Eh" over and over as you anoint the John The Conqueror root and Beth root with a few drops of Crown of Success Oil. Place the roots in the red flannel bag. This bag should be kept near or on the bed such as under the pillow. This done, the ritual is complete.

Note: An altar can be a table that has been perfumed with the smoke of incense and blessed and named. Many Voodooists will spread an altar cloth across it.

### Essence Of Bendover Oil Spell

This oil is sometimes called Bend Over oil, but is more widely known as Essence Of Bendover. It is one of the most famous of Voodoo oils. This spell is meant to gain power over someone and make the Voodooist's will have complete control of the other's actions.

A white candle is anointed with Essence Of Bendover in a manner that is not common in Voodoo rites. The oil is put in the palm of the hand and the candle is twisted through it. This is symbolic of turning a person to one's will. The candle is lit and allowed to burn to the end. After sunset, on the third day following the candleburning, a Voodoo mixture is made. Essence Of Bendover is mixed with salt, camphor, and some Asafoetida or Solomon Seal root, Either of the last two will do, both are better. To complete the spell, on this third night the mixture has to be sprinkled across the pathway where the one to be ruled is sure to walk.

### To Get Rid Of Someone

Take some new salt and mix well with Four Thieves Vinegar. Put aside until the mixture is dry. On nine different days ( they do not have to be in consecutive order ) throw some of the salt behind the enemy as he or she walks by. This is said to cause the party to leave the neighborhood.

### To Keep A Husband True

This work is done on an altar which can be any table draped with an altar cloth. Three red candles are lit at midnight. Before them is an incense burner containing Love incense. At the very front of the altar is a dish or pot containing a small amount of Cleo May perfume. Light the incense and dip a string nine inches long in the Cleo May, being sure to thoroughly moisten the string. The string is then held in the smoke of the incense while these words are said, "God before me, God beside me, God behind me". The string is then laid in front of the red candles which are allowed to burn to the socket through the night. The following day at twelve o'clock high noon, the woman must disrobe and take her place again in front of the altar. New red candles are lit again and the Love incense is set aglow. Nine knots are tied in the nine inch string and this string is then tied to a longer piece so that the resulting string is long enough to go around the waist where it is tied together like a thin belt. Cut some hair from the right armpit and some from the left side of the groin area. Then cut some hair from the left armpit and the right side of the groin. Place this hair in the incense burner and burn to ashes. All this time it is necessary to keep wishing that the husband will be faithful and true. The woman now gets dressed but the knotted string belt is kept on until nightfall. Then it is removed and wrapped in red cloth which is carefully hidden in a safe place. All materials are removed from the altar as soon as the candles have burned away. This ritual may be performed by the woman alone or it can be done by a houngan ( Voodoo priest ) or anyone versed in the ritual.

## FAMOUS VODOO RITUALS AND SPELLS

### A 'Lucky Hand' Good Luck Charm

A 'Lucky Hand' charm is not the same as a Lucky Hand root which in itself is considered a lucky charm. A Hand in this context is a collection of various things said to convey good fortune to whoever possesses it. It can be a charm bag prepared in a special manner. One 'lucky hand' is made as follows: Wrap a sand burr, a Sampson Snake root, and a Devil's Shoestring root in a piece of black cloth. Sew the black cloth together with white thread. Wet the packet with whiskey and put it in a red bag. This bag and its contents are supposed to extend a helping hand to its maker. It is kept in a secret place and sprinkled with whiskey once a week.

### Arrowhead Good Luck Charm

Indian arrowheads are known in some myths as "ELF SHOT". Needed is an arrowhead, a piece of punk or incense, and a solid knife or piece of steel or iron. The arrowhead is struck with the knife or other hard metal until sparks ignite the punk or incense. After the ashes have cooled they are wrapped in green cloth or paper and this is put into a small red flannel bag. This is a personal good luck 'jack' charm.

### DICTIONARY OF POWDERS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

Voodoo powders are used in a variety of ways. They are sprinkled, blown, used to anoint hands and body, rubbed on charms and other items, and often form an important part of the ingredients in conjure bags.

The listed names and beliefs date, in many cases, back into the eighteen hundreds. However, many are of more modern vintage since Voodoo is not static, but is continually evolving with new spells, rituals, and ingredients being added as may be created by various initiates.

Generally accepted beliefs are given, but these will sometimes vary in greater or lesser degree depending on locale and background of the practitioner.

- A **ABTINA POWDER**...Used as an offeratory powder before starting a ritual to assure success. Rub on the hands and sprinkle on each corner of the altar table. Also is used to draw a circle and pentagram or Voodoo cross on the floor in the center of the room.



A Voodoo cross is drawn using four lines as at the left. Abtina Powder is also used in form of an incense. See incense dictionary listing.

- ALGIERS POWDER**...Used for the same purpose as Algiers Floor Wash; to obtain good fortune in love affairs and gambling. This powder is applied to the body before seeing a lover and to the hands before gambling. The floor wash is mixed with water and sprinkled about the premises. This is to remove any bad influences that might hinder good fortune.

- ALL SAINTS POWDER**...Sprinkled about altar or Voodoo work room before beginning ritual or spell to bring success. Some also sprinkle after the ritual is finished.

- ALTAR POWDER**...Sprinkle small amount in center of altar and draw Voodoo cross on floor at each front corner of altar table.

### DICTIONARY OF POWDERS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

- A** **AMERICAN VODOO POWDER...***For success in any work. Applied to body and added to conjure bags and charms. Also mixed with other Voodoo powders to give them added strength.*
- AMBROSIA POWDER...***Used to attract love. A woman anoints her body with it before seeing the man she desires. A man rubs a very small amount on his hands before seeing a woman he wants.*
- ANCIENT WISDOM POWDER...***sprinkle on Voodoo ingredients, rub on forehead before ritual for protection against counter forces.*
- AS YOU PLEASE POWDER...***A form of commanding and compelling powder. Place some in shoes or belongings of those you wish to do your bidding. If this cannot be done, sprinkle where they are sure to walk.*
- ANGEL POWDER...***To invoke the aid of good spirits this powder is sprinkled very lightly on the bed sheets.*
- A** **ATTRACTION POWDER...***used to attract money, better business, good luck, love, and the better things of life. For love and gambling it is applied to the body and the hands in small amounts. It is sprinkled about a place of business. It is rubbed on charms and added to conjure bags that have a beneficial purpose.*
- B** **BANISHING POWDER...***To get rid of someone. If in the home, sprinkle under their bed, put in toe of shoes. If in another home, sprinkle on doorsteps in front and rear of home. Burn some Banishing incense and light a black candle before the work is started. "Work" means conducting a ritual, casting a spell, or any other Voodoo procedure involving the influencing of others. It also includes the making of charms, bags, etc.*
- BATS BLOOD POWDER...***For placing a crossed condition or hex on someone, put some of this powder on a piece of parchment paper and fold four ways to make a small packet. Fold the paper away from you, never towards you in this spell. Seal the packet with red sealing wax and scratch the enemy's initials in the wax. Bury the packet in the enemy's front yard after nightfall or hide in his or hers home.*
- BLACK POWDER...***Used in Black Magic rituals. It is added to anything meant to cause trouble to someone else. If an altar is used, it is sprinkled about the surface and used to draw Voodoo crosses on each corner.*
- BLACK ART POWDER...***Used the same way as above.*
- BLACK CAT POWDER...***To cause a crossed condition or hex on someone, sprinkle on their doorsteps.*
- BLACK CAT BONE POWDER...***A famous Voodoo powder used for good fortune and love affairs. Rub on any charm, anoint the altar by sprinkling, rub on money to bring more back, anoint body to attract love.*
- BLACK MUS POWDER...***To severely hex a person write their name thirteen times with Dove Blood red ink on a piece of black paper. Cover the paper with Black Mus Powder and fold together. At midnight burn the packet to ashes. When the ashes have cooled, throw them out a window.*
- BEND OVER POWDER...***A ruling powder used to make others do your bidding. Sprinkle it in pathway of one you wish to do your bidding. Sometimes is added to Essence Of Bend Over Oil. See Dictionary Of Oils.*

## FAMOUS VODOO RITUALS AND SPELLS

### DICTIONARY OF POWDERS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

- B** **BENEFICIAL DREAM POWDER...** Rubbed lightly on the forehead and sprinkled about the bed before sleeping. To make wishes and dreams come true.
- BLACK DEVIL POWDER...** To stop unfaithfulness it is sprinkled on the offenders clothing particularly in pockets.
- BLESSED POWDER...** To attract help of good spirits. It is sprinkled about the Voodoo room and also about the home and place of business.
- BLESSING POWDER...** Used like Blessed Powder but also used as an anointing powder. If a ritual or spell is being worked for someone else, anoint that party with the powder before and after the work.
- BOSS FIX POWDER...** Used in places of employment and also in private life as its purpose is to cause one to receive kindness and consideration. Sprinkle in path of person to be influenced.
- BRIMSTONE POWDER...** Burned to drive away evil forces and thus break spells and hexes. Refer to Brimstone Spell for full description of use.
- C** **CANDLE POWDER...** Make a circle around a candle with this powder to increase power of spell when conducting any candleburning ritual.
- CLEOPATRA POWDER...** A love powder thought to have a powerful influence on men. Used like a sachet after bathing.
- COME INSIDE POWDER...** Sprinkled on front doorway and pathway to make one popular.
- COME TO ME POWDER...** An old Voodoo powder used to attract the opposite sex. Use as a sprinkling powder and also can be added to the Come To Me Oil ritual described in full elsewhere in this book.
- COMMANDING POWDER...** To obtain influence over anyone, sprinkle this powder on or near the person without them being aware of it.
- COMPELLING POWDER...** Use like Commanding Powder.
- CONCENTRATION POWDER...** Anoint forehead with small amount to aid in solving a problem. Clears the mind.
- CONFUSION POWDER...** Dust a letter with this powder and send to enemy. If possible, blow some on their garments. Causes confusion and mixed-up thinking.
- CONGO POWDER...** A hex or crossing powder to cause trouble for someone. Used to trace a Voodoo cross on their front pathway or steps. Always done at night.
- CONQUERING POWDER...** Use like Commanding Powder.
- CONQUERING GLORY POWDER...** Use like Commanding Powder and also add to the Conquering Glory Oil spell. Also is sprinkled about a Conquering Glory candle. See candle dictionary listing for such use.
- CONTROLLING POWDER...** If your influence over someone is growing weaker, sprinkle this powder where they are sure to walk.
- CONVINCE POWDER...** Helps win arguments and disputes. Rub on favorite charm once a week or more often.
- COUNTERACTING POWDER...** To throw back a spell or hex and reverse its action onto its creator, this powder is sprinkled about the home, on front and back doorsteps, and rubbed on the hands every morning until successful.
- CROSSING POWDER...** To cast a hex or crossed condition, sprinkle this heavily on doorstep and send an envelope dusted with the powder to the address. Also is used with crossing and hex oils to add to their power.

### DICTIONARY OF POWDERS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

- D** **DAMNATION POWDER**...Use with Damnation Water Oil in accordance to Marie Laveau gris-gris or mix the two and throw on doorstep of enemy while walking by and saying as the mixture is thrown, "May damnation and misery be on the head of....."
- DELIGHT POWDER**...A sexual stimulant. Sprinkle on lover. Said to bring quick response to all advances.
- DEVIL SHOESTRING POWDER**...Add to any ritual calling for Devil Shoestring roots. Adds to the power.
- DEVIL SNUFF POWDER**...Used as a hexing agent. Cast upon the person's clothes or in their home. This name is derived from a deadly poison, a certain form of puff ball.
- DOMINATING POWDER**...Used like Commanding Powder.
- DOUBLE CROSS POWDER**...For crossing or hexing someone. Sprinkle in their pathway or on them. This must be done so that the sprinkling goes unnoticed.
- DRAW ACROSS POWDER**...Brings people to you. Sprinkle about the home. If possible, sprinkle on the opposite sex.
- DRAW BACK POWDER**...Brings back the lover who has gone astray. Sprinkle around, beneath, and in the bed.
- DRAWING POWDER**...To attract and draw good fortune to you, use as an offering powder with rituals, rub on charms and hands.
- DRESSING POWDER**...An altar and ritual powder. It is always used before any ritual begins. Sprinkle about the altar and room.
- E** **EASY LIFE POWDER**...Used with green candle and Easy Life Oil. See Easy Life Spell listed in book. Also sprinkled about the home and on belongings.
- EYE OF A CAT POWDER**...Used in any ritual where the eye of a cat or tiger is required. This symbolic powder takes the place of an actual eye.
- ELECAMPANE POWDER**...An ancient love potion requires mixing Elecampane powder together with vervain and mistletoe. This is mixed into the food of the opposite sex. Elecampane is also used in Voodoo rituals as an anointing powder. For love it is rubbed or sprinkled on the body; very lightly.
- F** **FAST LUCK POWDER**...Similar to all luck powders. It is sprinkled in the home or place of business, and rubbed on money and lucky charms.
- FIERY WALL OF PROTECTION POWDER**...For protection draw a line around front and rear entrances. Also use with Fiery Wall Of Protection candle or blue candle. See Candle Dictionary.
- FIRE OF LOVE POWDER**...Use as offering in love rituals and for sprinkling on the one desired.
- FIVE CIRCLE POWDER**...To increase psychic power and be able to prophesize, anoint the forehead with this powder and sprinkle beneath pillow at bedtime.
- FLAMES OF PASSION POWDER**...Anoint hands and body very lightly and dust small amount under bed. Said to arouse sexual desire strongly.
- FLYING DEVIL POWDER**...Used for two purposes, to gain revenge, and to break a spell. For revenge it is added to the Flying Devil Oil Spell referred to in this book. To break a spell, draw a Voodoo cross on parchment paper, sprinkle the cross with the powder, fold four ways and burn to ashes. Go out and cast the ashes into running water. Do the same for a total of seven nights.

**FRENCH LOVE POWDER...***Said to be one of the very strongest of love powders. Famous in New Orleans Voodoo circles. Used as with other love powders. Anoint and sprinkle.*

- G** **GAMBLING POWDER...***Rub on hands before starting any game of chance or placing any bet.*
- GET AWAY POWDER...***If you wish someone to leave for good, sprinkle some on their clothing. As a protection against unwanted visitors sprinkle on your doorsteps or entryway.*
- GO AWAY POWDER...***Same as Get Away Powder.*
- GODDESS OF LOVE POWDER...***Rub on hands and touch the one desired. Said to be a very powerful sexual stimulant.*
- GOOD FORTUNE POWDER...***Rub on hands, charms, and on bottom of shoes for favorable luck.*
- GOOD FRIEND POWDER...***Sprinkle about dwelling and in pathway of the one you want as a friend.*
- GOOD LUCK POWDER...***Use like Good Fortune Powder.*
- GOOFER DUST POWDER...***Use to hex by casting it upon the enemy's pathway and steps, or put some in a red bag and bury it in the yard.*
- GRAVEYARD DUST POWDER...***Same as Goofer Dust.*
- GRIS-GRIS POWDER...***Added to hex powders to make them work better and be longer lasting in effect.*
- H** **H & H POWDER...***A powder that is sometimes added to the H & H Oil Spell to conquer witchcraft and Voodoo curses. See H & H Oil Spell.*
- HEART OF SWALLOW POWDER...***Takes the place of an actual swallow's heart in spells calling for such an item.*
- HEALING POWDER...***This is not used for health, but to bring peace and relaxation after defeating a spell or curse. After a hex is broken, this powder is cast about the dwelling and on the front and rear entries.*
- III-ALTAR POWDER...***A very important powder used to anoint the altar and Voodoo work room. Applied before starting a ritual or any work.*
- HIGH JOHN CONQUERING POWDER...***To gain love, money and good health refer to spell giving use in detail.*
- HOLY POWDER...***To attract helpful spiritual forces and to dispel evil forces. Sprinkle about dwelling and on favorite charm. Use as an anointing powder with any prayer and religious article.*
- HORN OF PLENTY POWDER...***Similar to Money Drawing Powder. To attract money and good fortune rub on money, bottom of shoes, and carry a small amount in a red bag.*
- HOT FOOT POWDER...***Sprinkled or burned to cause a hex or crossed condition. Sprinkled on enemy's pathway. Write enemy's name on a black candle after anointing with a hex oil. Light candle and sprinkle a tiny amount of powder into flame. Do this three nights in a row. Let each candle burn to socket.*
- I** **INFLAMMATORY CONFUSION POWDER...***Similar to Confusion Powder except it is used to break a hex. It throws the hex back on whoever caused it. Use in same manner as the other powder.*

- INVOCATION POWDER...***To help summon spiritual help this powder is sprinkled about before praying and starting Voodoo work. It is also rubbed lightly on the forehead. Said to be very helpful for success.*
- IRRESISTABLE POWDER...***A favorite with women who seek a mate or are having trouble with their husband or lover. Applied to body after bathing.*
- J**
- JAMAICAN BUSH POWDER...***For breaking crossed conditions. Used with a hex-breaking ritual. Add to other ingredients for more power.*
- JEHOVAH VISION POWDER...***Helps to foresee the future, make prophecies. Anoint forehead before concentrating on your predictions.*
- JERUSALEM POWDER...***Added to ritual sprinkling powders to gain more spiritual assistance.*
- JINX POWDER...***For causing trouble sprinkle this powder on pathways and doorsteps, entryways, where enemy is sure to walk. Mix with other hex powders.*
- JINX REMOVING POWDER...***Sprinkle about premises and in front of all entryways and windows. Such areas should be swept clear before sprinkling.*
- JOHN THE CONQUEROR POWDER...***Refer to High John The Conqueror Spell elsewhere in this book.*
- JOB BREAKER POWDER...***To cause someone to lose their job, this powder is sprinkled on their clothing.*
- JU JUA POWDER...***Add to jinxing and crossing powders for strength or use alone like Jinx Powder.*
- JUPITER POWDER...***For much added power it is often added to ritual sprinkling. It is used only on Sunday from noon to midnight and on a Thursday from midnight to noon.*
- K**
- KABALA POWDER...***Sprinkled when trying to invoke Voodoo gods for help.*
- KING MIDAS POWDER...***A money drawing powder that is rubbed on the hands and bottoms of shoes so that the drawing follows everywhere.*
- KEEP AWAY ENEMIES POWDER...***Sprinkled in each corner of room, outside of doorways, and across pathways leading to dwelling.*
- KEEP AWAY HATE POWDER...***Used like Keep Away Enemies Powder.*
- KEEP AWAY SPIRITS POWDER...***Meant only for evil spirits. Sprinkle only at midnight. Draw protective lines before and across all entryways.*
- KYPHI POWDER...***An offering powder that is symbolic of fragrances offered to ancient gods. Its name goes back thousands of years. Sprinkle this about to gain power in all Voodoo work.*
- L**
- "L" HAND POWDER...***Sprinkle for good luck and rub on favorite good luck charm carried on person.*
- LADY LUCK POWDER...***Used most often by women, but also by men. Sprinkle about dwelling.*
- LODESTONE POWDER...***Considered very powerful for bringing good luck and success. Sprinkle and anoint as with other good luck powders.*
- LOST AND AWAY POWDER...***Said to be one of the most powerful of powders for getting rid of someone. Refer to Lost And Away Spell for details of use.*

- L** **LOVE POWDER...***Comes in a variety of colors. Colors are chosen based on situation. Sprinkled to obtain and/or keep love. Choose color that is favorite to benefit from strongest vibrations.*
- LOVE BREAKER POWDER...***Sprinkle lightly on clothing of pair you wish to be separated. Can be applied to self and mate if desired to break up.*
- LOVERS POWDER...***Use like Love Powder, but choice of color is not necessary.*
- LOVE FIRE POWDER...***To stimulate desire, this powder is sprinkled beneath bed.*
- LOVING HOME POWDER...***To attain a peaceful and loving home atmosphere, sprinkle in all rooms in corners.*
- LUCKY LUCKY POWDER...***Supposed to be stronger in results. Sprinkled about home, work, place of business.*
- LUCK AROUND BUSINESS POWDER...***Sprinkled only on business premises. Only used in home if business is conducted there.*
- LUCKY HAND POWDER...***Rub on Lucky Hand root and carry it as a charm to attract all good things.*
- LUCKY PLANET POWDER...***Anoint all charms and sprinkle in each room and before all entryways. Said to be one of the strongest of luck powders.*
- M** **MAD POWDER...***Causes irritation and bad feelings in a home if it is sprinkled on the front steps.*
- MAD LUCK POWDER...***Makes luck go astray and turn bad. Use like Mad Powder.*
- MAGNET POWDER...***Rub on charms and carry with you. Add to Magnet Oil and anoint a lodestone to draw money.*
- MASTERS POWDER...***For commanding others. Sprinkle on you doorway so that whoever enters is compelled to follow your wishes. Be firm in demands.*
- MECCA POWDER...***Sprinkle alone or with others powders to gain power and success in any ritual. Mix with oils.*
- MONEY DRAWING POWDER...***Anoint your money to draw more and rub on bottom of shoes.*
- MUSK LOVE POWDER...***Use about the home; especially bedroom.*
- MOVING POWDER...***Put on pathways of those you want to be rid of.*
- MYSTIC POWERS POWDER...***Used the same as all other Mystic type powders. It is said to increase the success of any spell and to make the user a more powerful and wiser expert on Voodoo rites. It is sprinkled widely.*
- MOUNT POWDER...***Anoint self and mate to increase virility and ardor.*
- N** **NECROMANCY POWDER...***Used only when trying to contact help of spirits for direct action. Not used in other rituals.*
- NGAMA POWDER...***Said to be very powerful when sprinkled for the purpose of knowing others secrets.*
- NINE POWDER...***Draws luck when gambling. Anoint money before betting with it.*
- NUMBER HIGH POWDER...***Used like Nine Powder but only when playing the numbers.*

### DICTIONARY OF POWDERS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

- O** **OBEAH POWDER...***A ceremonial sprinkling powder used on the altar and about the room. Use before start of ritual and after ritual is finished. Very important to do so.*
- ORRIS POWDER...***Lightly dust on clothes of opposite sex to gain their love.*
- ORIENTAL LOVERS POWDER...***Sprinkle this about the premises for love. A famous powder.*
- P** **PEACE POWER...***Sprinkle for achieving peaceful conditions. Sprinkle in every room including bathroom.*
- PEACEFUL HOME POWDER...***Used like Peace Powder.*
- PROSPERITY POWDER...***Rub on hands, sprinkle about the premises, burn a green candle anointed with Money Drawing Oil and draw a circle around the candle with the powder.*
- PROTECTION FROM ENVY POWDER...***Sprinkle on or near person filled with envy. This must be done carefully so it not noticed. Also put about home.*
- PROTECTION FROM HARM POWDER...***An all-purpose protective powder that is put across doorways, window sills, and rubbed on lucky charms.*
- PSYCHIC POWERS POWDER...***Sprinkle when invoking aid of mystic and spiritual powers.*
- Q** **QUEEN OF NIGHT POWDER...***Used only by women who sprinkle it about to attain and keep love.*
- QUEEN OF SHEBA...***Used like Queen Of Night powder and also to attract good fortune and money.*
- QUEENS POWDER...***Used only by women. Sprinkle on anyone to increase their passions.*
- R** **RAMA DREAM POWDER...***Sprinkle at rituals and around candles to gain psychic power.*
- REMOVING POWDER...***A favorite Voodoo powder for getting rid of hexes and curses. Sprinkle in every room and draw a line before outside doorways.*
- RUN AWAY POWDER...***Used like Get Away Powder and Lost And Away powder to get rid of someone.*
- S** **ST. JOSEPH POWDER...***Sprinkle in dwelling and on pink candle to be burned once a week. Candle is lit at dusk and burned to socket. To get a good husband and happy home.*
- SABBAT POWDER...***Use only on Sundays to give rituals more power. Add to other powders used.*
- SATAN BEGONE POWDER...***To break hexes and possession. Sprinkle all rooms and anoint whoever is cursed. Draw crosses with the powder before and behind dwelling.*
- SEPARATION POWDER...***For breaking up friendships and lovers, married or unmarried. Must be sprinkled on both parties without their knowing it.*
- SPIRIT POWDER...***To gain aid of beneficial spirits, use about altar and work room.*
- SPIRITUALIST POWDER...***Used by spiritualists to gain psychic power.*
- STAY HOME POWDER...***Keep the wandering mote at home and faithful. Sprinkle on clothes.*
- SUCCESS POWDER...***Anoint favorite charms and the entryways. Rub on bottom of shoes to walk with and towards success.*

### DICTIONARY OF POWDERS USED IN VODOO RITUALS

- T TAMING POWDER...** *Calms down and makes others do ones bidding. Put on their clothes secretly.*
- TEASING LOVER POWDER...** *Compels the flirting lover to be faithful. Use like Taming Powder.*
- TEMPLE POWDER...** *An offering and purifying powder to be used about the altar room.*
- U UNCROSSING POWDER...** *For full details refer to Uncrossing Powder Spell elsewhere in book.*
- UNHEXING POWDER...** *Use like Uncrossing, or draw three Voodoo crosses on front and rear entryways every night for seven nights. Remove each morning.*
- V VAN VAN POWDER...** *For money and good luck, rub on High John The Conqueror root; carry root as charm. Throw away root after thirty days and replace with new powder and root.*
- VESTA POWDER...** *Draws success and protection. Put on charms, in bags, around home.*
- VENUS POWDER...** *Often used with the Sortilege Prayer to increase its effect. A love powder, it is used for sprinkling and anointing.*
- VISION POWDER...** *Used when trying to foretell the future or divine another's thoughts. Sprinkle on a burning white candle, cast upon blessed water and rub a little on forehead. Then concentrate.*
- VOODOO POWDER...** *Use like American Voodoo in the rites that require Haitian chants.*
- W WALL BREAKER POWDER...** *Brings peaceful conditions, stops marital troubles, ends quarrels. Sprinkle about all rooms.*
- WAR POWDER...** *A hexing and crossing powder said to be one of the most powerful. Write enemy's name on piece of paper and coat it with the powder. Fold and seal the paper without losing any of the powder. Cast the packet into a river or stream and wish evil upon the one named.*
- WEALTHY WAY POWDER...** *To gain large amount of money, rub on bottom of shoes and palms of hands. Rub on favorite charm and put tiny amount in purse, billfold.*
- WHITE CROSS POWDER...** *Used only for good. Line powder in form of Voodoo cross in place where it will not be disturbed. Put on front and rear entryways. Said to be one of best ways to bring love, peace, prosperity.*
- WHITE MUS POWDER...** *For protection against all evil and bad luck. Draw a line with it all about dwelling or put line across doorways and windowsills. Blocks off all bad forces.*
- WISHING POWDER...** *Sprinkle on altar and around candles during any ritual and wish for all to come true.*
- X XX DOUBLE CROSS POWDER...** *Also known by three Xs and other forms referring to Double and Triple Cross. All work the same except larger numbers refer to stronger mixture of mixture. This is a hexing powder said to be of great strength. Use like War Powder or cast upon enemy's steps during the night.*
- Z ZODIAC POWDER...** *Sprinkle during rituals performed at night before midnight to bring success to the ritual.*



### To Stop A Witch's Spells

Fashion an image in dough. In some manner of shape it must resemble the witch. Tie a string around the neck of the image and allow to lay for four hours. Then the dough figure is baked and the witch spell is strangled by the string. Put some Van Van Oil on the figure and hide in a safe place. This entire ritual should be repeated whenever danger of a spell is felt. However, each baking was said to protect against a specific witch for at least three months.

### Home Breaking Rituals

Several methods may be used in trying to separate a man and wife. These are old Southern Voodoo methods.

A... You must secure the woman's tracks. This is done by taking up dirt or grass where you know she has walked. Only two tracks are needed. Put the tracks on a piece of paper. Sprinkle some War Water Oil on them and dust with Separation Powder. Place dog and cat bristles on the tracks, add gunpowder and sulphur and a piece of lodestone. Fold the paper from east to west, turn the paper, and fold again in the same direction. Now seal the folds with red wax either from a red candle, or use red sealing wax. Take the sealed parcel to a river or stream at midnight. Say the following:

"Dog bite it, Cat scratch it,  
Gunpowder burn it, Sulphur smoke it,  
Lodestone carry it far away".

Turn your back on the running water and throw the parcel back over your right shoulder into the water. Leave and do not look back.

B... This requires the tracks of both the man and woman taken from damp ground after a rain. These tracks are put in a paper bag together with bristles of a cat and a dog. Some will further add Separation Oil to the mixture. The bag is tied shut with red string or thread and put away for several days. Then it is put into a fire and burnt to ashes.

C... The name of either the husband or wife is written thirteen times on a piece of paper using Dove Blood Red Ink. On the paper is sprinkled Lost And Away Powder. Then the paper is folded from each corner towards the middle and the folds will overlap. These folds are sealed with red wax. This packet is then buried at night in a hidden spot. Every night, for thirteen nights, either War Water Oil or Damnation Oil is sprinkled on the burial place. On the fourteenth night the packet is dug up and burned to ashes. The ashes should be carefully collected and scattered to the winds or thrown into running water so they can never be recovered.

D... An old method attributed to Marie Laveau, the famous Voodoo Queen of New Orleans. Separation Powder was the basic ingredient. This powder had to be hidden in the belongings or clothes of both the husband and wife. Shoes were the best as the powder could be placed in the toes & not be seen. If possible, the powder would be hidden in such manner at least three times.

**VOODOO SPRAYS**..also called **RELIGIOUS INCENSE SPRAYS**

These sprays contain essential oils believed by Voodooists to have vibratory powers essential to making their wishes and prayers come true. They are sprayed about the home or place of business while concentrating on wish or prayer.

**ALL PURPOSE Spray Incense**..Used with any wish or prayer. Often used before and after Voodoo rituals.

**BLESSED Spray Incense**..For gaining the spiritual help of Christ. An offering for divine assistance.

**CONQUERING GLORY Spray Incense**..Use with any wish or prayer for power and success in any affair or for the solving of life's problems.

**CONGO Spray Incense**..Used with wishes and prayers for gaining better friendships and prosperity.

**CROWN OF SUCCESS Incense Spray**..Sprayed when starting any new endeavor or plan and to make rituals successful.

**DOUBLE FAST LUCK Incense Spray**..Contains twelve Zodiac oils thought to bring quick good fortune.

**DRAWING POWER Incense Spray**..Make Sign of Cross while praying for desires to come true.

**FIRE OF LOVE Incense Spray**..Perfume the home or any room to rouse passions of lovers.

**FORTUNE TELLER Incense Spray**..Thought to cause one to be able to make prophecies and see the future.

**GAMBLERS Incense Spray**..Sprayed before starting any game of chance. Thought to greatly improve chances of winning.

**HIGH JOHN The CONQUEROR Incense Spray**..Believed to bring good luck in love, money, and gambling.

**JINX REMOVING Incense Spray**..Contains nine Indian herb oils thought to remove hexes and curses or crossed conditions.

**LOVE Incense Spray**..The impressions this incense is said to create are thought to be a powerful love force on whoever comes in contact with the aroma.

**GOLD-SILVER OFFERING Incense Spray**..Thought to invoke the Spirit of Good luck and bring it to the home, business or church.

**MONEY HOUSE BLESSING Incense Spray**..Said to call the Horn of Plenty to the home for abundant prosperity.

**PEACEFUL BLESSING Incense Spray**..Spray while saying a prayer or wish for peace and harmony, and an end to troubles.

**SEVEN AFRICAN POWERS Incense Spray**..Spray as an appeal to seven African Saints for help with financial, health, and love problems.

**THREE WISEMEN OFFERING Incense Spray**..An offering for spiritual and mystical help. Often used by mediums and Voodoo priests and priestesses.

**Gambling Charm**

Take a piece of Devil's Shoestring root, Sampson Snake-root, and a Sand Burr and wrap them together in a piece of black cloth. Fold the black cloth towards you. White thread is used to sew the parcel shut. Place the parcel in a red flannel bag and sprinkle whiskey on it. This charm is kept near at hand while gambling. Before starting to gamble, open the bag and fold the parcel towards you.

### Good Luck Ouanga Ritual

Draw a pentagram on a piece of paper. The pentagram is to be about five inches from point to point. The one point should point towards the top as shown. On each of the points place a green candle anointed with Easy Life oil and Lucky planet oil. The Easy Life oil is applied to the candles from the middle and rubbed towards the top. The Lucky Planet oil is rubbed on from the middle towards the bottom.



In a metal pot place a small amount of herbs of lime, balsam, and a few castor beans. Char these over a fire. Put aside to cool. On a red square of cloth place some of the lime, balsam, and three castor beans. Mix together and sprinkle the charred herbs and beans. This sprinkling is to cover the fresh herbs. On top of this pile place a tuft of your hair that has been tied together with a red thread. On top of the hair place a small metal cross. Take some wine in your mouth and spray it over the pile. Place a copper penny on the pile and sprinkle it with Baume du Commandeur (Commanding perfume). Tie the packet that is formed by folding together the red cloth, around and around with yellow ribbon. Going the opposite way, wrap the packet with red ribbon. Secure the ribbons by tying the yellow and red together. During this ritual repeat from time to time, "Tout Mystere gider li".

This good luck ouanga is carried in a pocket and during the night it is kept in the bedroom.

### Conjure Bag To Cross Someone

One of the most common practices of Voodoo is the burying or hiding of a conjure-bag to hex or cross someone; the purpose being to bring bad luck, illness, and in rare cases, death to the victim. To 'cross' or bring bad luck, a conjure-bag was made using nine new needles, nine new pins tied together with some hair of the intended victim. To this is added a piece of snakeroot, and some Goofer Dust Powder. All of this is put into a red flannel bag which is then hidden in the victim's house or buried in the yard. This spell is claimed to work well as long as the bag remains undiscovered. If it is discovered a reverse spell must be cast to nullify the bad effects. A simple method of reversing the spell is to get the bag from its hiding place, soak it in Four Thieves Vinegar, and then throw it into running water such as a stream or river.

### To Bring A Wife Or Husband Home

Take a piece of red flannel about three inches wide and a foot long and fold it three times towards you so that it is folded in half. Turn the cloth around and fold it three times again. Now take nine new needles and one by one, work them through all six folds three times. Do this in such fashion as to form the needles in the shape of a cross. All the time this is being done keep concentrating on the missing party to come home. Place the flannel in a small box and every morning anoint the flannel with Come To Me Oil.

### Voodoo Dolls

Contrary to common belief, there is no doll that, it alone, can be called a Voodoo doll. The image-maker of other cultures finds his counterpart in the Voudoun practitioner who fashions a doll-shaped wanga. The 'wanga' is a magic charm made for malignant purposes. However, the years have brought about a change in the use of Voodoo dolls. At one time, a doll was fashioned primarily for the purpose of seeking revenge or death. Today, especially in the United States and some parts of the Caribbean and Brazil, Voodoo dolls are made in the pursuit of love, luck, and money, as well as for the ancient purpose. The main difference between a Voodoo Doll and the wax, wood, and other images connected with medieval Black Magic is the method of preparation and rituals. It does not matter if the doll is made by its user or is purchased ready-made. Preparation and purpose are the deciding factors.

#### BLACK Voodoo Doll...

**PREPARATION:** The following is the preparation and a ritual for revenge, etc. Some small piece of the subject's clothing should be attached to the doll. Within the doll should be placed something from the person such as nail cuttings, hair, etc. To this should be added a drop of blood, animal or human. This is done by opening a seam of the doll and then sewing it tight again after placing the items within. The doll should have eyes, mouth, and a cross signifying the heart, painted or sewed on it. On its back is marked a Voodoo vever (sign) as shown at left above.

At midnight, the prepared Doll is laid on a black cloth or paper between two black candles. At the feet of the Doll is placed something made of iron (such as a nail) and at its head a stone is placed. The candles should be anointed in Voodoo fashion with Crossing or Jinx oil and lit. Proper way to anoint is to rub the oil from the center of the candle towards the top and from the center to the bottom. It is never done in one direction only. After lighting the candles, say,

"Be you gone and may you, (name is spoken), rot in the grave.

Damballah, curse him as I curse him and spoil him as I spoil him. By the fire at night, by the dead black hen, by the bloody throat, by the goat, by the rum on the ground, this ouanga be upon him. May he have no peace in bed, nor at his food, nor can he go and hide. Waste him and wear him and tear him and rot him as these rot".

Now is chanted three times:  
Eh! Eh! Bomba, Hen! Hen!  
Canga Cafio Te  
Canga Mouna Dele  
Canga Dahi La  
Canga Li

*The origin and meaning of the chant is unknown but it has been used with Voodoo rituals for centuries. Evidently it is a chant for success and is used with almost any ritual.*

Following the above chant, various acts would be performed such as sticking pins into the doll, burning, tying a thread or small rope about the neck, putting it in a coffin-like box which is buried in the ground, etc. To make the spell even more effective, sometimes two dolls are used. One is treated as above, and when possible, the other is hidden in the victim's dwelling.

### PERSONIFICATION OF A VODOO DOLL

There could be times when it would be difficult to obtain anything of a personal nature belonging to the subject. In such an event another ritual could be utilized. Before performing the midnight Voodoo Doll ceremony it was absolutely necessary that the doll be made to represent the subject. It could be done as follows:

The Doll was laid on something black and a preparatory ritual begun after lighting two black candles. The practitioner invokes three Voodoo loa, or gods; Legba, Agwe, and Ghede. On hand should be a small amount of black dirt, water, and matches.

A...Sprinkle some dirt on the Doll and say, "Legba, Legba, Conga Bafo Te".

B...Sprinkle some drops of water on the Doll and say, "Agwe, Agwe, Conga Nouné De Le".

C...Wave a lighted match over the Doll and say, "Aia bambaba bomba, Ghede, Ghede, Conga Do Ki La, your name and your life and your suffering shall be that of .....". Here was spoken the subject's name and it was believed the Doll was fully personified.

### OTHER USES FOR A VODOO DOLL

**RED Voodoo Doll...**Used in love rituals. The name of the person desired is written on a piece of parchment paper and attached to the doll with a new pin piercing the heart. Before using the pin its head should be painted red. The Doll is to be placed on a piece of red cloth and anointed with Come To Me oil or other love oil. Place a red candle at each side of the doll. Candles are anointed with the love oil. Light the candles and pray that your desire will be granted. Allow the candles to burn to the socket. The following day hide the Doll in a safe place. Repeat the ritual until satisfied, but not more than once a week.

**GREEN Voodoo Doll...**Used in money rituals. A small silver coin is sewn inside the doll. Anoint two green candles with Money Drawing oil and sprinkle oil on the doll. Set the doll between the candles, say a prayer for receiving adequate finances, and light the candles.

**WHITE Voodoo Doll...**Used in health rituals. Attach name of person to be helped plus some of their hair. Anoint two red Radiant Health candles with Healing oil and sprinkle the oil on the Doll. Light the candles, one on each side of the Doll, and say a prayer asking for good health.

**YELLOW Voodoo Doll...**Used to gain friendship, draw people, make one magnetic and charming, beloved, popular. Anoint two purple Conquering Glory candles with Crown Of Success oil and sprinkle the oils on the doll which should bear a name tag made of parchment paper pinned to it. Place the Doll between the candles which are burned to the socket. Keep Doll in a safe place under lock and key. Wrap it in yellow satin before hiding it away. Repeat ritual as felt necessary.

**PINK Voodoo Doll...**For protection rituals against any form of evil. Place name tag on Doll. Anoint two brown Drive Away candles with Uncrossing oil and sprinkle the oil on the Doll. Anoint two purple Satan Be Gone candles with Jinx Removing oil and sprinkle some on the Doll. Place the four candles to form a square and lay the Doll in the center. Light the four candles and walk around them four times. As the candles are circled, whisper the Voodoo success chant shown at the beginning of this article. The Doll is left in the square through the night. The next morning, wrap the Doll in pink cloth and put in drawer or cabinet near a window. Take it out only if the ritual is to be repeated.

*In all Voodoo Doll rituals the candles should burn to the socket. Each candle should have its own candleholder.*

### VOODOO SOAPS

These are very fragrant soaps that are used in the bath and for ritualistic washings of hands and face. They are similar to incense sprays in that they are meant to invoke spiritual and occult help in making wishes and prayers come true.

**GAMBLERS SOAP..**Used before any game of chance.

**HIGH JOHN The CONQUEROR SOAP..**Used in hope of gaining good luck in love, gambling, health.

**JINX REMOVING SOAP..**Thought to remove hexes, jinxes, and the Evil Eye.

**LOVE SOAP..**For influencing lovers and faithfulness.

**MONEY HOUSE BLESSING SOAP..**Symbolic of bringing the Horn of Plenty and goodness to the home.

**SEVEN AFRICAN POWERS SOAP..**Wash or bathe while praying for financial, health, or love success.

**ST. CLARA SOAP..**Thought to bring justice, protection, and granting of desires.

**3 WISEMEN OFFERING SOAP..**Wash or bathe with this soap as an offering to obtain spiritual and mystical help.

### Four Thieves Vinegar Spell

Marie Laveau, the famous Voodoo Queen of Old New Orleans, used the oil potion called Four Thieves Vinegar in a number of ways she said would drive enemies away.

1. Smear the oil on the enemy's doorknob where it would be sure to be touched.
2. Putting a small amount of it in a bottle together with the enemy's name written on parchment paper. The bottle is thrown into a river or stream. As it floats away, it is thought to draw the enemy with it and that person will leave the neighborhood.

### Skull Candle Hex Spell

This hexing or crossing spell uses a candle shaped like a human skull. Preparation should be made during the day or evening as the candle has to be lit exactly at midnight.

A proclamation is written on parchment paper or red paper stating, "In the Name of the Mystic Skull, I, (insert name), put the Curse of Althazar, and Gaap, and Flauros upon thee (insert subject's name).

The candle is anointed with Conquering Oil and the paper is laid before it. At exactly midnight, the candle is lit and allowed to burn for half an hour. Before putting the flame out, the paper is lit with it, placed on a metal container such as an incense burner and burned to ashes. The ashes are left there. This ritual is repeated the following night. If felt necessary, the two nights are repeated the following week and in the future in order to keep an enemy under a hex. After each two day ritual, the ashes are put in a small bottle and sealed in. The bottle can be kept on any shelf not touched by direct sunlight. Some Voodooists will have a special shelf which becomes lined with bottles. Use a personal code to identify each bottle.

### Reverse Hex Skull Candle Spell

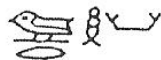
The Skull candle is also used to send back a hex to its maker. The skull candle is anointed with Uncrossing Oil and Jinx Removing incense is burned. The candle is lit at midnight and Psalms 10 and 43 are spoken. The flame is put out after half an hour. This is done at least once a week until the hex has been removed which is said to be indicated by a feeling of relief and lightness when it occurs.

### Mummy Candle Spell for Power and Success

A spell combining elements of American Voodoo, European Ceremonial Magic, and ancient Egyptian magic. Voodoo is the melting pot of magic. A careful study of Voodoo will reveal rituals or parts of rituals taken from many cultures.

The Mummy candle is shaped like a mummy case and is used in this ritual to bring power and success in any endeavor.

The Ritual: Anoint the candle with Mummy Oil and place in a candle holder which is placed in the center of a pure (new) white cloth. About six inches in front of the candle place an incense burner. Fill with an offering of Power incense, or Success incense, or myrrh incense, or a combination of them well mixed. Upon a piece of parchment or linen paper draw the following hieroglyphic. Light



the incense and wait until the fire is well-spread. Then lay the paper upon the incense and light the candle. Now speak the words of the ancient invocation called the 'Power Of Powers'. These words were used by Egyptian magician priests three thousand years ago.

*"The Soul of the Gods is in Unas, Their Spirit-Souls are with Unas, and the offerings made unto him are more than those made unto the Gods. Unas is the Great Power, the Power of Powers, and this offering will his powers unto me, who does make it, and success shall be mine".*

The hieroglyphic means 'Mighty One of Spells'. The spell should be performed only when alone.

## FAMOUS VODOO RITUALS AND SPELLS

### **Black Cat Candle Luck Ritual**

It is a common belief that if a black cat crosses one's path, it is a sign of bad luck. This is a happenstance over which one has little control except to perform a counteracting ritual.

However, Voodooists believe the opposite can be true if one controls a symbolic Black Cat. Combining such a symbolism as the Cat with candle burning rites is said to be one of the most potent Voodoo methods for attracting good fortune and luck. This is the application of sympathetic magic for benefit and not harm.

*Black represents the Night when the Forces of Darkness are at their strongest and a Voodoo offering is made*

Once night has fallen, a Black Cat candle is anointed with Success Oil and then burned for seven minutes the first night and eleven minutes the second night. The burning time is always alternated in this way. Thus there is seven minutes of burning the third night, and eleven minutes the fourth night. This is continued until satisfaction has been achieved.

### **Satan Candle Voodoo Rituals**


Voodooism considers Satan to be a conjurer and to have him on one's side is to be helped by the master of the black arts. Some Satan candles are straight candles with a name label. The Satan candle in this ritual is a carved candle in the commonly accepted shape of Satan.

When used with a beneficial ritual, the Satan candle is burned only during daylight. The candle is anointed with Black Art oil and placed facing a wall. A wish is made and the candle lit and burned for half an hour. After this beginning ritual to gain the help of the master conjurer, any other Voodoo ritual may be performed.

For Voodoo Black Magic such as hexing, revenging, etc., the Satan candle is always burned after nightfall. Anoint the candle with Jinxing, Crossing, or similar oil and put it on the altar facing forward. Supplication is made to Satan for his help in achieving whatever the following ritual is designed for. The candle is lit and allowed to burn through the night. It is after the Satan candle is lit that the second Voodoo is performed.

*Note that in both of the above examples the Satan candle is anointed and lit, a wish is made, as a preparation before starting the main Voodoo ritual.*

### **To Get Someone To Leave The House**

If there is an unwelcome relative, guest, or renter who is not wanted in the house then procure an onion; round, if dealing with a woman, somewhat pointed, if dealing with a man. Write the party's name five times on a piece of paper. Core out the onion carefully and stuff the paper in the hole. Onto the paper pour some Lost and Away Powder and seal the hole with some of the removed core. Anoint the onion with Inflammatory Confusion Oil. When the party leaves the house, quickly roll the onion behind her or him. This must be done before anyone else crosses the doorway except yourself. As the onion is rolled, make a strong wish that the party leave your house permanently. Retrieve the onion and hide in a secure place. 





### Uncrossing Oil Spell



This oil is used to be rid of a 'crossed' condition or hex. Anoint a pink candle with the oil and burn one hour. Snuff out the candle and throw away. Do this three days in a row. After the third time, make a wooden cross using new wood. The cross should be no longer than three inches, and the two pieces of slender thickness can be tied together with red thread or yarn. The entire cross is anointed with the oil and then burned to ashes. As the cross burns, these words are spoken, "*Mu prale mare loa Petro. Hi Hi. Ja Petro, chen ki chen.*"

The ashes of the cross are gathered up and kept in a secret place in the home.

### Flying Devil Oil Revenge Spell

Something belonging to the enemy is mixed with wax which is formed into a ball. This ball is hollowed out and filled with Flying Devil oil. It is sealed with warm wax and kept in a safe hidden place for seven days. On the seventh midnight the ball is pierced with a thorn and as the oil is poured onto the ground, a curse is spoken, "*As this oil wastes upon the earth, so may the luck and life of .....*" Flying Devil oil is also used to make other spells more powerful. A red candle is anointed with the oil and burned on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays during other rituals.

### Easy Life Oil Spell For The Good Life

To make life smooth and serene, without strife and lack of money, a green candle is dressed with Easy Life oil and burned for ten minutes each day for five consecutive days. On the sixth day put five drops of the oil on a piece of paper which is then lit in the candle flame and burned to ashes. The ashes are wrapped in red cloth and kept in a charm bag. The candle burns to the socket.

### Hate and Death Coffin Spell

This is one of the most feared of all Voodoo spells. A small coffin is made from wood or wax. The coffin is consecrated in the names of the trinity patrons of Voodoo sorcerers. This trinity is composed of Maitre-Carrefour, Lord of the Crossroads and Demons; Grand Bois, Master of Night Earth and Night Forests; and Baron Cemitiere, Sovereign of the Cemeteries. Upon being consecrated, the coffin became a ouanga, or magical charm. This was sent on an 'expedition' to the victim. Voodooists believe it invokes the aid of the dead against the living.

Anoint two black candles with Black Devil oil and place the coffin between them. Sprinkle Damnation oil on the coffin. Burn XX Double Cross incense and say the words, *Zo wan-we sobadi sobo kalisso Maitre-Carrefour, mwe mem kiriminel.*

*M'a remesye loa-yo Grand Bois, l'uvri baye mwe.*

*Baron Cemitiere, l'envoi morts.*

Light the black candles and burn to the socket. When the flames go out, at any time thereafter, the coffin is sent on its way.



### Lost And Away Powder Spell To Drive Away

Used to cast a spell to cause someone to depart the dwelling or region. The powder is put on a piece of paper on which the name of the enemy is written thirteen times. The paper is folded with each corner towards the middle and sealed along the folds with red wax. The sealed packet is buried in a safe place for thirteen days. Every day the burial spot is wet with War Water oil or Damnation Water oil. On the fourteenth day the packet is dug up, burned to ashes and the ashes are scattered to the winds.

### Black Cat Oil For Hex Or Luck

For Hexing: Anoint a black Candle with Black Cat oil at the stroke of midnight. Write the victim's name on the candle using a sharp point. The name should be spread out so that it covers the length of the candle. Starting from the bottom of the candle, an inch above the base, a needle is inserted about half way. At even spaces, until two inches below the top, four more needles are inserted. The five needles represent one of the best numbers to hex or conjure with according to Voodoo belief. The candle is lit, and the hexing words said.

*'As this candle burns away, so shall all the good fortune of... (name inserted)... disappear and may he (or she) have only bad luck from this day on''.*

The candle is burned until the top needle drops off. The candle is then snuffed out. The second night, at midnight, the candle is again anointed with the oil, and it is burned until the second needle falls off. Each needle is put to one side of the candle. This ritual is followed completely for five midnight ceremonies. Each night the words of hex are spoken. On the fifth and final night after the fifth needle has fallen, all five needles are laid across the remaining candle stub and it is allowed to burn through the night until it goes out by itself.

For Luck: It is rubbed on charms, jacks, money, on the hands before gambling. Anoint a green candle and burn to the socket.

### Come To Me Oil Love Spell

To bring back a lover or mate who has strayed: Anoint a pink candle with Come To Me oil. After sundown, light the candle, the name of the loved one is spoken three times, and he or she is asked to return. The candle is burned for fifteen minutes. This ritual is repeated five nights in a row. On the sixth night, Come To Me oil is mixed with Myrrh, Frankincense, or an incense such as Lovers or Commanding. The incense is lit, and spell-words said aloud. *"Akmas Akmas Honah Haitunin Bisun in Honah Gedu"*.

### Controlling Oil Spell

For gaining power over a person, put some of the oil on his or hers shoes. On the same day anoint a pink, red, or brown candle and burn for half an hour. Repeat each day until the candle is consumed.

### To Make A Man Love You

Obtain six red candles such as Fire Of Love brand Red candles, about 400 new pins, several sheets of parchment paper, and some Lovers brand Incense. Also have on hand Doves Blood brand Red Ink and a dip pen, also a bottle of Fiery Command Oil.

Take sixty pins and stick thirty into one side of a candle starting at the bottom and making a straight line up to the top. Do the same on the other side. Stick the pins about half way in. Be sure that each candle is anointed with the Fiery Command Oil before placing the pins. When anointing, the oil should be rubbed on from the center of the candle towards the top, then from the center of the candle towards the bottom. This is the correct Voodoo way of candle anointing. This should be done with each candle at the time of using. Cut out six paper triangles about three inches wide at the base. These are to invoke the aid of the Trinity Power. Three is a powerful number and the three points are believed to both defend the ritual against evil forces and also to attack them in return. On each triangle write the name of the man three times. Place the paper triangle underneath the candleholder and light the candle at dusk. Allow the candle to burn to the end.

Have prepared; six squares of parchment paper with the name written once on each using the Dove Blood Red Ink. When the candle is lit also light the Lovers incense. Put four pins through the parchment square and pass it through the smoke of the incense. Place the smoked parchment in front of the candle. The next morning gather the sixty pins, pass the parchment square through the smoke of newly lit Lovers Incense and then bury the paper and pins near your doorstep. This procedure is followed for six nights and days until the six candles have been burned. On the seventh night pour Fiery Command Oil upon the buried materials and make a strong wish that your lover will be true to you.

### Black Art Oil Crossing or Hex Spell

To 'cross' or hex an enemy, the Voodooist anoints his forehead and body with Black Art oil. This is done in secrecy in the Voodoo or altar room. A small amount of the oil is poured into a saucer set on the floor in the center of the room. Wetting a forefinger in the oil, the Voodooist walks to a corner of the room and anoints the floor point with the oil, and then returns to the saucer. This action is repeated until each corner is anointed. This is thought to crisscross the room with a powerful net of black magic forces which the oil represents. Now the Voodooist leaves the chamber, the anointing oil on the person believed to draw the magic forces along. Proceeding to a point where the enemy has to pass by sooner or later, the Black Art oil is carefully poured on the ground or pathway so as to form an X. The X has to go entirely across the way from edge to edge so as to be sure to make contact with anyone walking through it. A similar X is placed near the enemy's dwelling or on the steps if possible.

## FAMOUS VODOO RITUALS AND SPELLS

### A Voodoo Chant For Success

An important part of many Voodoo rituals is a chant or prayer for success. The following example is an all-purpose chant that can be used with almost any ritual as an invocation to the Voodoo gods named. It should be chanted at the end of a ritual.

*Papa Legba, open wide the Gate!  
Damballah Ouedo, thou art master  
of the sky!  
Wangol, Master of the Earth!  
Papa Agwe, he is master of the Sea!  
In the name of all the Gods and all  
the Mysteries!  
Damballah, behold the deed we have  
done as you commanded!*

*Papa Legba, ouvri barriere pour mains!  
Damballah Ouedo, ou mait la ciel!  
Wangol, Mait la Terre!  
Papa Agwe, li mait la Mer!  
Lans nom tout Loi et tout Mystere!  
Damballah Ouedo odan q'icit  
Maude ca la! Oue!*

### Black Mus Hex Spell

Black Mus is supposed to hex or cross a person by harming his soul, or 'shadow' as it is known in Voodoo. This is one of the very basic beliefs of this religion. It is held that if such harm befalls a person, great damage will be reflected on the physical body resulting in a trance or even death. This is said to be accomplished by having the shadow soul be pursued by demons and evil spirits. The person's name is written thirteen times with Dove Blood red ink on black paper. The paper is covered with Black Mus powder. Some Voodooists add a sprinkling of Black Mus oil for more power of hex. The paper is burned at midnight near an open window. After the fire has gone out, the ashes and remaining powder are thrown out the window.

### A "Gris-Gris"

#### Various examples:

A "gris-gris" is a magical charm that can have either a good or bad purpose depending on its content, use, and purpose of the maker.

For good luck shape hair in the form of a small nest. Tie to this two pieces of Devil's Shoestring root in the form of a cross. Place hair and roots (which are tied in form of a cross) in a red bag and sew the bag shut. This bag is carried in a pocket at all times.

Place salt, saffron, pulverized dried dog manure, and gun powder (taken from a bullet or firecracker) and wrap in black paper. The small parcel is hidden in an enemy's home or yard to bring bad luck.

Soak a piece of paper bearing the name of your enemy in a dish containing Four Thieves Vinegar. Take out the paper and put it in a safe place until it is dry. Roll the paper into a small piece and completely cover it with melted red wax. A red candle may be used. Hide or bury the waxed roll in the enemy's yard. After three days sprinkle War Water on his or hers front steps as you walk by at night. Two nights later Goofer Dust is thrown on the yard and steps. The following night is the final action. Damnation Water is sprinkled on the sidewalk.

### Easy Life Oil Spell For The Good Life

To make Life smooth and serene without strife and lack of money, a green candle is dressed with Easy Life oil and burned for ten minutes each day for five consecutive days. On the sixth day, put five drops of the oil on a piece of paper, light the candle after dressing it again, and light the paper with the flame of the candle. Put the paper aside to burn to ashes. Let the candle burn out. Then gather the paper ashes, wrap them in red cloth, and keep the packet in a charm bag. Repeat whenever needed. Charm bags grow old and should be renewed time to time.

### Guinea P Oil Protection Spell

Take the white of an egg, dry it, and grind into a powder. Add a small amount of Guinea P oil, and a drop of blood from the little finger of the left hand. Write these words on a piece of red paper, AGWE AGWE CA GAI. The powder is placed on the words and the paper is folded, each corner towards the middle. This packet is put in a red flannel bag which is kept near the bedstead to afford protection against hexes, evil spirits, and crossed conditions.

### Jezebel Root Hexing Spell

Named after the evil queen of Biblical times, and carried to gain revenge and put a curse or hex on someone. The root is believed to give power to thoughts regarding witchcraft. Concentrate deeply on the victim holding the root in the left hand. If summoned, evil spirits will gather to the left of the summoner. The root is put in a jug filled with warm water, sealed, and kept in a dark place for three days until the hex takes place and starts to work. At the end of the third day, the root is removed and thrown far away.

### High John Oil And Powder Spells

**THE OIL:** Anoint a green candle with High John (same as High John the Conqueror) oil, and burn completely. Repeat for seven nights. Said to bring money, love, and health. The ritual starts on a Sunday.

**THE POWDER:** Used for the same purpose as the oil. Anoint a green candle with the oil and sprinkle a very small amount of High John powder into the flame and onto the candle. Put some of the powder into a pot of boiling water. The hands are passed through the smoke of the candle, and through the steam rising from the pot. This is done each day until satisfaction is received.

### Conquering Oil Spell

voodoo lore says to put some Conquering oil on the shoes of one to be subdued, and he or she will bow to the will of the spell-caster. If the victim is not within reach, his or her name is written seven times on a piece of paper anointed with the oil. The paper is burned and the ashes spread in the victim's pathway. Whenever using the oil, the Voodooist should concentrate on whatever is desired of the other party. Psalm 65 is to be repeated three times and the three times repeated on a total of five separate occasions. When the Psalm has been said for the fifteenth time, the spell is in effect according to Voodoo belief.

**Voodoo "Holy" Water For Rituals And Spells**

A number of Voodoo rituals will call for sprinkling with Holy water. This water can be obtained in two ways. It can be water blessed and prepared by a Voodoo priest or priestess or it can be prepared by the user. Place two white crucifix-shaped candles on an altar or table. Between them place an incense burner and fill it with Blessed incense. Light the candles which have been previously anointed with Blessing oil. Light the incense. Pass a container holding water through the smoke of the incense four times; to the east, west, north, and south while chanting Voodoo words for success and invocation to the gods. Use the Voodoo chant shown at bottom of preceding page. When the chant is finished, place the container in front of the burner and leave it there overnight. Allow candles and incense to burn out. The next day, pour the water into new bottles. Cap firmly and label each bottle. Always use new bottles for newly blessed water.

It is said this water should never be used in black magic as this would reverse the spell and cause misfortune for its user. When used for good works it is said to strengthen any spell even if just sprayed about the room where a ritual is performed. It is sprinkled on 'lucky hands' and other charms to increase their powers. It is added to bath water to purify sinners.

In addition to the Voodoo chant some initiates will add an old European invocation: "*O, most Holy Supreme Lord, my God, my savior, my life, I pray thee help me. Holy Father, God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, and Thou art also God of the Angels, and of the Archangels and of the Prophets, and Lord God, the Creator of all. In Thy Name, with all sincerity and humility, I pray that Thou will bless and sanctify this water through Thee, O Supreme Adonay, Who reigneth forever. Amen.*"

**"Graveyard Dust" Spell**

"Graveyard Dust" is one of three things; dirt taken from a cemetery, mullein powder, or patchouli powder. Or it can be a combination of them. It is usually used in any combination with such things as asoefitida, jezebel root, Lost and Away powder, Black Cat oil, Four Thieves Vinegar oil, Black Cat oil, Goofer Dust ( which is similar but not the same as Graveyard Dust ), Mummy oil, Damnation Water oil, Black Mus, and other powders and oils representing hexing powers. Any and all are mixed with Graveyard Dust together with something belonging to the enemy.

If some personal belonging cannot be secured, the person's name is written on a small piece of parchment paper. This and the mixture is put in a small bag and buried or hidden near the enemy's abode. Also, if the mixture is made only with powders, it is sprinkled on the doorsteps. If the mixture includes oils, it is smeared on the doorknobs. All of this is in addition to the hiding of the small bag. Such action is said to result in making a person sluggish and sleepy and eventually wasting away.

**Anger Powder Hex Spell**

Anger powder is used by Voodooists to cross or hex an enemy. They form an X with the powder before and behind the victim's home and on the front doorsteps. For permanency, a varnish or paint remover is added to the powder so that the marks of the cross will stay even though the powder be swept away.

### Magical Powers Attributed To Stones

The Voodooist believes certain stones have magical powers, and this is consistent with the beliefs of all mankind. Stones have been considered to be talismans and charms since the dawn of man. Possession of certain stones is believed by many to bring to the owner the legendary magical powers inherent in the stones. Such stones are set in rings, in pendants, or kept in their natural or polished shape without any setting or jewelry fittings.

**AGATE...***A black agate brings prosperity, success in games and gambling. A brown agate gives riches, long life and happiness. A red agate brings peace and protection from poisonous insects and lightning. A green agate cures eye diseases.*

**APACHE TEARS...***Brings good luck.*

**AMETHYST...***Brings good luck and love from the opposite sex and protection from drunkenness.*

**BERYL...***Brings hope, and protection against witchcraft.*

**BLOOD STONE...***Stirs the passions. Cures diseases. Makes one successful in court cases.*

**CARBUNCLE...***Protection from witchcraft.*

**CARNELIAN...***Brings friendship, protects against the Evil Eye, cures depression.*

**CAT'S EYE...***A charm against evil spirits, hexes, and any form of witchcraft.*

**CELONITE...***Held under the tongue to be able to foretell the future.*

**CHRYSOCOLLA...***Drives away fears. Brings wisdom and diplomacy in daily affairs.*

**CHALCEDONY...***Brings good luck, protects against Evil Eye, brings health and good disposition.*

**CORAL...***Chases evil spirits away.*

**CRYSTAL...***Enables a person to bend others to his will. Protects against Evil Eye and stops bad dreams.*

**DIAMOND...***Brings power, friends, riches. Drives away evil spirits, attracts help of spirit powers, cures diseases.*

**EMERALD...***Brings foresight, riches, defeats witchcraft, cures diseases.*

**GARNET...***Attracts devotion, loyalty.*

**GYPSUM...***Brings good fortune and protects against sorcery and black magic spells.*

**HEMATITE...***Sometimes called another form of Bloodstone. Brings fortunate end to lawsuits and judgments. Gives protection against all evil.*

**INDIA MOSS...***Cures illnesses, brings good harvests.*

**JASPER...***Drives away evil. Brings good fortune and happiness.*

**JACINTH...***Protects travelers from misfortune. Defeats magic spells.*

**JADE...***Brings good fortune and success. Drives away evil spirits. Prevents and cures diseases. Brings health and long life.*

**LAPUS LAZULI...***Brings supernatural powers. Wards off troubles of all kinds.*

**LODESTONE...***Drives evil away and brings good fortune.*

**MALACHITE...***Makes spells more powerful. Gives power over others. Protects against black magic.*

## FAMOUS VODOO RITUALS AND SPELLS

### Magical Powers Attributed To Stones

**MOONSTONE**...Brings good fortune if kept wrapped in a yellow cloth. Arouses tender passions in lovers.

**ONYX**...Protects against sorcery. If sent to someone it brings with it bad luck, and trouble in love and marital affairs.

**OPAL**...Brings luck. Cures diseases. Increases power of the mind. Its owner can put curses on others.

**PERIDOT**...Promotes friendships. Brings good health.

**RUBY**...Brings safety from all troubles. Helps with love and friendship. Assists the rise of passion.

**SAPPHIRE**...The regular sapphire helps witchcraft spells. The star sapphire defeats witchcraft.

**SARDONYX**...Defeats witchcraft and sorcery. Brings good fortune. Gives confidence.

**TOPAZ**...Exorcises demons. Defeats evil spells. Brings love and affection.

**TIGER EYE**...Defeats sorcery, witchcraft and Evil Eye.

**TURQUOISE**...See the reflection of the new moon on it and gain good fortune and freedom from evil. Brings love and courage.

**THUNDER STONE**...Stone shaped like an axehead that gives great power to any ritual.

### A "Bath" To Take Away Bad Luck

A Voodoo "Bath" means the ingredients added to bath water or wash water for the purpose of attaining some desire or for purification. In this instance, the purpose is to drive away bad luck which would naturally result in life being more pleasant. Basil, spearmint, Balm du Commandeur, Sesame seed, a pinch of flour, and juice of three and a half lemons are mixed together and kept in a jar or bottle. Three teaspoonsful are added to bath water. This bath should be taken once a week.

### For Getting Rid Of Witchcraft

Make three holes in a bar of soap and fill each hole with lamp oil and a wick. Light each wick and say,

*"Stop, evil, stop!*

*Death rides the sky,*

*Evil demons make me take the left path,*

*Stop, evil, stop!*

Sprinkle salt on the bar of soap and wave a burning match all around the soap. Allow the three wicks to burn out and hide the soap in a safe place.

### Brimstone Protection Ritual

Brimstone is another name for sulphur. Four squares of red paper and four metal plates or saucers are required. A pinch of brimstone is placed on each red square. The containers are placed in each of the four corners of the room, and the paper is placed on each. At midnight, with windows open regardless of the weather, the brimstone is lit. Each corner is spoken to in turn:

*"You, Grand Bois*

*You, Carrrefour*

*You, Baron Cemetiere*

*You, Damballah*

*In your all-powerful names which I have invoked with this offering, I command evil demons and hexes to flee this dwelling, never to return".*

When the brimstone has ceased burning, remove all traces from the dwelling and throw far away.



**Personal Pot-De-Tete**

In Haitian Voodoo, an initiate's gros-bon-ange (soul) is put in a red earthen vase-like container called a govi. The govi is wrapped in white cloth and becomes a pot-de-tete, a consecrated protective container of great significance. Various involved rituals such as the *canzo*, *chirer Ayizan*, *bruler-zin*, *retirer d'en bas de l'eau* can be required depending on circumstances. Such ceremonies are an integral part of the metaphysical side of basic Voodoo. However, American Voodoo uses a greatly simplified ceremony whose main purpose is for protection and is not concerned with *Mysteres*, death, and descendants.

The gros-bon-ange is not the soul as Western civilization understands it. In Voodoo context it is the shadow twin of man, and it can be attacked by evil forces. The *canzo* ceremony separates the gros-bon-ange from the body and the Americanized version follows:

Bathe every noon for three days in a row. On the fourth day bathe and anoint hands and forehead with American Voodoo oil. Wave a palm leaf, which has been split into many strands, to the four points of the compass. Place grains of corn, some strands of hair, nail cuttings, and chicken feathers into a red earthenware pot. Around these arrange a beaded necklace. This necklace is made of white and black beads on a red thread or cord and must have been strung by the Voodooist. On a piece of animal parchment write your secret Voodoo name and place the parchment in the pot. This name is chosen by yourself or with the aid of a Voodoo priest or priestess (a houngan or mambo). Rum is poured into a bowl or on the ground and lit. A white candle is anointed with the American Voodoo oil and lit. When the rum burns out, the candle is snuffed out. The pot-de-tete is now hidden in a safe place and no one is allowed to touch it. The gros-bon-ange is now safe from evil attacks.

**Goofers Dust Spell**

Goofers Dust is similar to Graveyard Dust in that it can be a mixture of graveyard dirt and a special powder. However, it can be the special powder alone as the dirt is just added for more power. One spell requires the powder to be put on the ground in the outline of a human figure representing the person to be hexed. The powder is lit and whoever it represents is said to become ill.

The term 'goofered' means hexed, crossed, or cursed, and countless items can be credited with causing such a condition. Goofers Dust is one of these, but certainly not the only one as witness the many ingredients of various rituals and spells. The most common usage of this powder is to sprinkle it on the doorstep of the one to be conjured, or to place some in a bag to be hidden close to or within a dwelling. It is also sprinkled on clothing to affect the wearer.

**"21" Herb and Root Ritual Candle**

A hand-fixed candle burned for any of a number of magical purposes. It is burned for love, power, good luck, protection, defeating witchcraft, gambling and financial success. Depending on the desired result, a Voodoo oil is rubbed on it. See Voodoo oil dictionary list. Usually this candle is burned for an hour and then snuffed out. In this way it can be used for a number of spells and rituals if anointed each time with the appropriate oil.

## FAMOUS VODOO RITUALS AND SPELLS

### Rattlesnake Root Money Ritual

Voodooists believe Rattlesnake root can help them find money in the following manner: Soak the root in a cup of boiling water for fifteen minutes. The water is strained and the root is thrown away. The liquid is put in a bottle and left for seven days. On the eighth day it is rubbed on the bottom of one's shoes. It is rubbed on each following day until money comes in some easy manner.

### Charm Against Evil

The most powerful root in American Voodoo is High John the Conqueror. It has many uses and will be mentioned in love, gambling, power, success, and protective rituals. For protection against evil, anoint a High John the Conqueror root with Van Van Oil and place it in a small red bag. The most powerful color in Voodoo is red and is used whenever possible. A bag and root should be kept in each room of the home. At night mustard seed should be sprinkled in front of outside doorways to further add to the protection.

### Uncrossing Powder Spell

Voodooists believe hexes and 'crossings' can be rid of by sprinkling this powder into the flame of a pink candle that is anointed with Uncrossing oil. This is done three hours after sunset and the powder is also spread outdoors before every door and window within reach. This is repeated for seven nights. This powder may be added to the following Uncrossing Oil Spell for more strength.

### Good Luck Garlic Charm

This is a famous charm that originated in Haiti. Stick nine pins half way into a garlic bulb so they encircle it. Put a tack into the bottom of the bulb and a nail half way into the top. Tie a white thread to the top of the nail and wind it around a pin and then to a second pin and back to the nail. Repeat this until the bulb is completely circled three times and the thread finally tied again to the nail. The garlic bulb is now a white wheel with a cone on top. Sprinkle Power oil on it and hang near a window.

### To Prevent Being Made A Zombie

Place a hen's egg, seven feet of white thread or cord tied with seven knots a bit less than a foot apart, in a white pot and keep under the bed.

### Black Coffin Death Spell

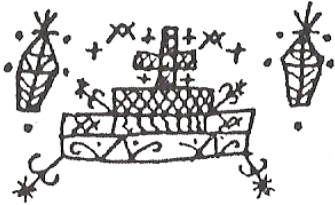
This spell requires no invocation. It differs in that regard from the Voodoo Coffin Spell shown elsewhere in this handbook. This is an old spell used mainly in the southern United States. A coffin, about two or three inches long, is made from wax, clay, wood, or any material easy to shape. It is painted black if the material is not black already. A small doll pierced with pins is placed within it. At night it is placed on the enemy's doorstep, and a burnt stump of black candle is placed at each end. Some Voodooists will sprinkle an oil such as XX Doublecross oil or Black Art oil on the coffin before placing it.

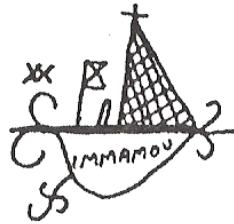
**Vevers Of Important Voodoo Loa; Voodoo Gods**

When invoking the aid of a Voodoo God, or loa as they are called in Haiti and other areas, a design, or vever as it is called, is formed by various means. In an elaborate ceremony, the vever is drawn on the ground using white flour.

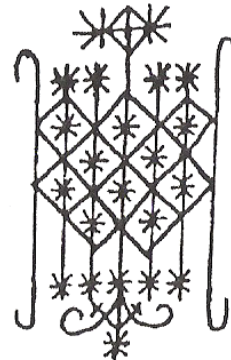
In the United States a vever is often drawn on parchment, or parchment paper, or it is engraved on metal such as silver and gold, or their substitutes. The purpose is to invoke the aid of the loa in gaining success with some ritual. It thus becomes a form of talisman. This is different from Haiti. There the vever is a public display in the loa's honor. And, also an invocation for the god's favor. Either way, both methods represent the same basic purpose.



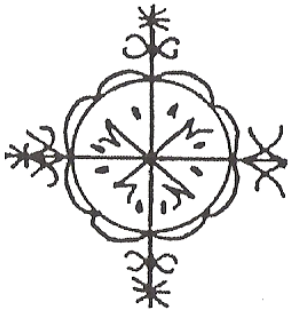

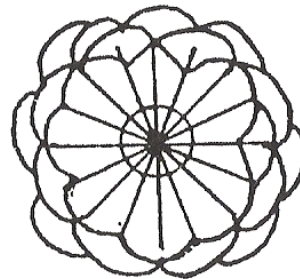
