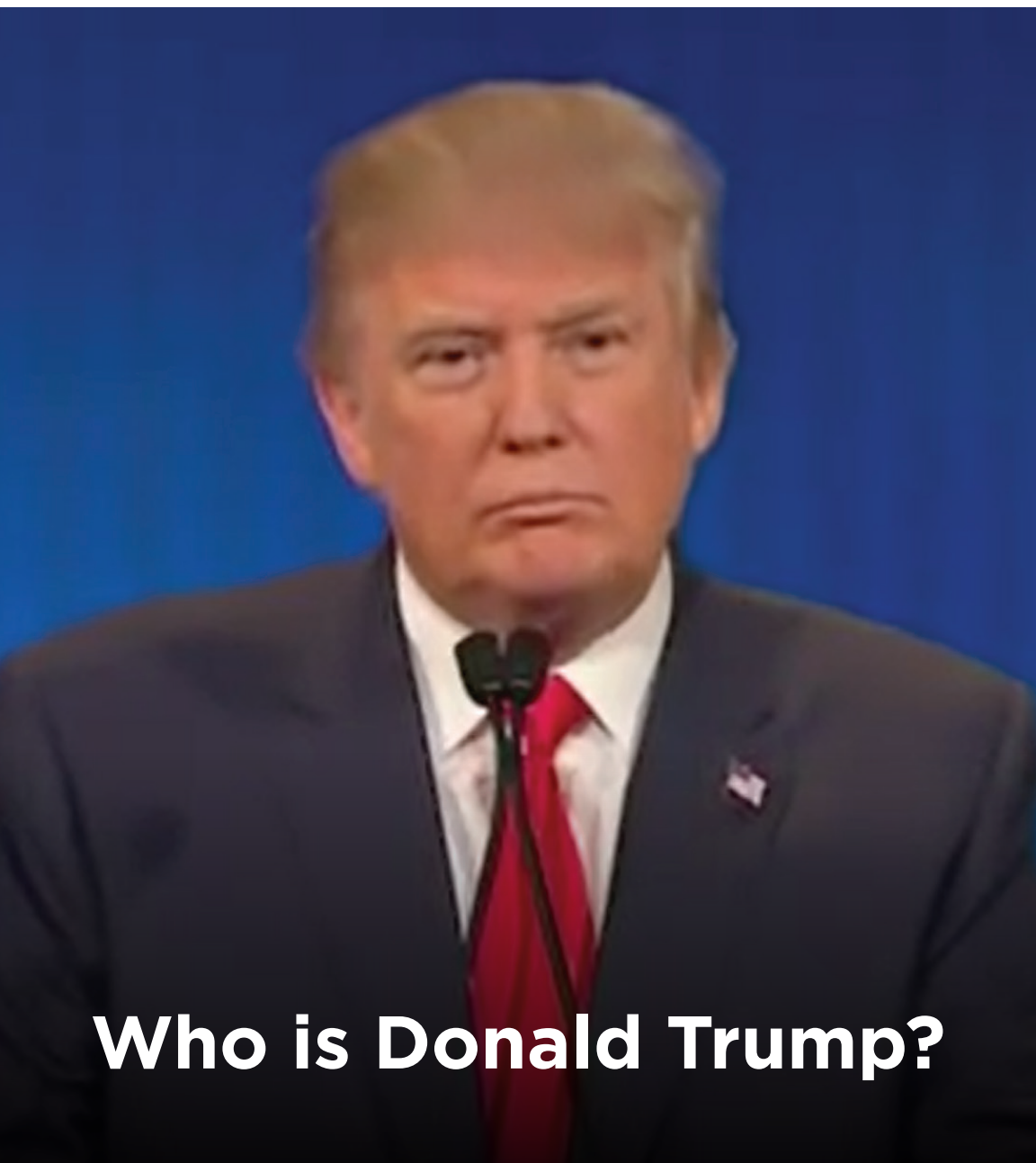

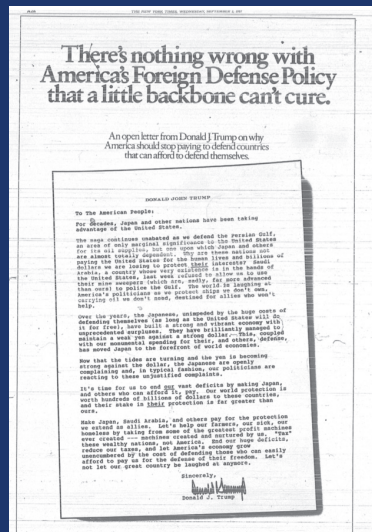

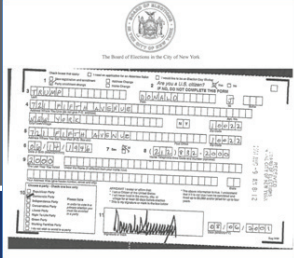
- ✘ After only a few months, Trump struggles to gain traction and drops out of the race for President.

2001-2008

August 2001 – Trump Registers As a New York Democrat.

✘ January 2005 – Hillary and Bill Clinton Attend Trump's 3rd Wedding.

✘ In 2008, Donald Trump sided with Nancy Pelosi and even called for President George W. Bush's impeachment!

Pelosi was going to "impeach Bush and get him out of office, which...would have been a wonderful thing," Trump said.

✘ "In 2009, Trump praised President Obama's trillion-dollar stimulus package, saying "I thought [Obama] did a terrific job." He added: "I think [his] taxes are very good."

✘ Trump gave hundreds of thousands of dollars to Democrats. "The Democratic recipients of Trump's donations make up what looks like a Republican enemies list" – including Hillary & Bill Clinton, Harry Reid, John Kerry, Chuck Schumer, Charlie Rangel & even Ted Kennedy.

2015-2016

Trump is running for President again – this time he says he is a “*Conservative Republican.*”

On the issues that matter, though, Trump can't hide from things like his support for universal healthcare, massive tax hikes, and amnesty.

- ✘ He praised Canada's single-payer, government-run healthcare. Trump said: **“as far as single-payer, it works in Canada. It works incredibly well in Scotland...”**

- ✘ In September 2015, Trump said: **“everybody's got to be covered...the government's going to pay for it.”**

- ✘ **Trump called for amnesty** for the 11 million illegal immigrants already in the United States – and **for a pathway to citizenship. Trump said:**
 - “It's very, very tough to just say: ‘you have to leave, get out!’”
 - **“You HAVE to give them a path [to citizenship] and you HAVE to make it possible for them to succeed.”**
