## festivals in central europe

The Berlin Love Parade in June is the largest techno party in the world. Hordes of tourists come to **Germany** for the famous beer festival in Munich, the *Oktoberfest* – one of Europe’s biggest and most drunken parties from late September to early October.

The Prague Spring in May, one of Europe’s biggest festivals of classical music, kicks off the summer in the **Czech Republic**. The town of Prachatice goes fairly wild during the mid-June Gold Trail Festival with medieval costumes, fencing tournaments and fireworks.

People from all over Europe camp and party at the Sziget Festival in **Hungary**, a week-long world music bash in early August on Budapest’s Óbuda Island. The Gyula Theatre Festival has spectacular performances in the castle courtyard during July and August.

The Dominican Fair in Gdańsk is the oldest shopping fair in **Poland**, held in August and accompanied by street theatre, concerts, parades and races. The May Juvenalia in Kraków is a student carnival with fancy dress, masquerades and dancing in the street.

In July, artists from all over Europe come to Kežmarok for the biggest Craft Fair in **Slovakia**, with food, drinks and live music. Rumours that the Bojnice Castle is haunted are kept alive by the International Festival of Spirits and Ghosts, held in early May.

Kurentovanje, a rite of spring celebrated in February, is the most extravagant folklore event in **Slovenia**, held in Ptuj. Maribor hosts both the International Puppet Festival in July and August and a renowned theatre festival in the second half of October.
