introduction

What do the fairy tales of Hans Christian Andersen and the existentialist philosophy of Søren Kierkegaard have in common (apart from pondering the complexities of life and human character)? Danish (*dansk dansk*), of course – the language of the oldest European monarchy. Danish contributed to the English of today as a result of the Viking conquests of the British Isles in the form of numerous personal and place names, as well as many basic words.

As a member of the Scandinavian or North Germanic language family, Danish is closely related to Swedish and Norwegian. It's particularly close to one of the two official written forms of Norwegian, *Bokmål* – Danish was the ruling language in Norway between the 15th and 19th centuries, and was the base of this modern Norwegian literary language. In pronunciation, however, Danish differs considerably from both of its neighbours thanks to its softened consonants and often 'swallowed' sounds. Among the foreign influences on Danish, German is the most notable: a consequence of both warfare and trade through centuries.

Writing in Danish starts with the runic alphabet – used mainly on stone for the common ancestor of all Scandinavian languages as far back as AD 200 – which flourished during the Viking age from the 9th century. The earliest examples of what can be considered Danish text date from that period, when Danish began to take shape as a distinct language. The Roman alphabet in which Danish is written today was first introduced by Christian missionaries. It started replacing the runic alphabet in the 12th century and was modified through a series of spelling reforms.

The current international status of Danish (with about 5.5 million speakers) is the legacy of its historical expansion. It's the official language of Denmark and has co-official status – with Greenlandic and Faroese respectively – in Greenland and the Faroese Islands, which are autonomous Danish territories. Until 1944 it was the official language of Iceland and today is taught in schools there as the first foreign language. Danish is also a minority language in the area of Schleswig-Holstein in northern Germany, where it has some 30,000 speakers. And if all that isn't enough, just think of the whole corpus of words for which English is indebted to its old Viking conquerors – one of those essential words thought to have Danish origin is 'smile', so whenever you're taking photos on your travels, remember to thank the Danes!

pronunciation

vowel sounds

The Danish vowel system has long and short versions of each vowel, and additional 'combined vowels' or diphthongs. Most of the vowels have equivalents in English – but as ever, it's best to listen carefully to native speakers and follow their lead. By using our coloured pronunciation guides, you're sure to be understood.

word stress

In Danish, stress often falls on the first syllable in a word. Compound words can have more than one syllable stressed. In this chapter, the stressed syllables are in italics.

consonant sounds

Most Danish consonants are also found in English, including the 'soft' sounds (such as *dh*). However, the consonants in Danish can be 'swallowed' and even omitted completely, creating, in conjunction with vowels, a glottal stop or *stød* *steudh*. Its sounds rather like the Cockney pronunciation of the 'tt' in 'bottle'.

In this dictionary, words are marked as **n** (noun), **a** (adjective), **v** (verb), **sg** (singular), **pl** (plural), **inf** (informal) and **pol** (polite) where necessary. Note that Danish nouns are either ‘common gender’ (masculine or feminine forms but never referred to as such) or neuter. Common gender takes the indefinite article *en* (a) while the neuter forms take the article *et* (a). Every Danish noun needs to be learned with its indefinite article (*en* or *et*). We’ve only indicated the neuter nouns with Ⓢ after the translation. Note also that the ending ‘t’ is added to adjectives for the neuter form (ie when they accompany indefinite singular nouns).
