It was necessary to completely disassemble these thick books in order to scan them into electronic form. And so we have destroyed a rare (almost impossible to find) and expensive set of books to bring you this electronic version. But where there was but the one set of 'The History of Woman Suffrage' there are now thousands of sets that can be made available not only to Libraries and Universities, but to every individual who appreciates the value of this magnificent history of the Battle for the Rights and Dignity of all Women everywhere.

In converting these magnificent books into electronic form Bank of Wisdom has worked to keep the original format, it will be noted that the books open with a picture that is the first page of each book, the Title Page is therefore the second page. After some experimenting it was decided that pictures scanned with the 'Sharp Millions of Colors' setting was more "alive" than those scanned with the 'Sharp Black and White' setting, and so we used the color setting. In scanning the pictures we have not attempted to add color, the tenting comes from the slight yellowing of the old paper, we merely adjusted the brightness and contrast of each picture to get the best possible appearance; exactly as we would have done had we scanned with the black and white setting. We sincerely hope you agree that the pictures are acceptable as we have done them.
