

This sorceress was once a favorite at the court of Triton, king of the sea. However, she was banished from Atlantica long ago and sent into exile.


About Ursula

Ursula's "little poopsies," Flotsam and Jetsam, lure Ariel back to the sea witch's dark domain.




Ursula has powerful magic, and she loves to use it on her foes. Poisonous potions are her speciality.


Maleficent

Maleficent commands Aurora to touch the spindle. The cursed princess does as she is told.


About Maleficent




Sir Hiss

Tick, tock, tick, tock... the crocodile that ate Hook’s hand (and his clock!) is still after him.


The Jolly Roger

Cannibal Cove





Big and brawny


Gaston loves no one more than himself. With his handsome good looks and athletic prowess, he has lots of admirers—but Belle is not one of them.

A potent potion transforms the Queen's appearance. The vain Queen thinks she looks like a kindly granny.


Red apple

Snow White does not recognize her stepmother in disguise. She believes the apple will make her dreams come true.


Go on! Have a bite.


